## Do You Know?

We woke up one morning and we found our lives turned upside down by the Pandemic, called a monster event, and it has turned out to be just that.



With the objective that the safety of all of our parishioners is our first priority, our St. James staff met and developed a plan for the facilities on our campus that would keep it simple, accentuate what we already had in place and build on it.

Our new church is capable of adapting to the Pandemic arena. It contains hard surfaces conducive to sanitizing, modern air handling systems capable of turning over the air on a regular basis, and a large sanctuary designed to seat 1,200 people that is conducive to maintaining social distancing requirements.

In our school we recently completed stripping and waxing 28,000 sq. ft. of flooring to simplify sanitizing and cleaning our classrooms and hallways.

The missing ingredient was to identify and employ someone to lead us in developing and writing cleaning protocols and implementing the training to accomplish it. We extended an offer to Ms. Suzanne Keisling and have hired her as Supervisor of Custodial Services to lead us in this effort and ensure that programs for cleaning are properly introduced and documented so that sanitizing becomes a way of life for our custodial staff. Suzanne comes with 22 years of experience in the field of cleaning, documenting and training of the processes to enable constant sanitizing.

As you can imagine, this book of knowledge is in great demand in the current environment. We are very fortunate to have her aboard; she is currently working hard to achieve these objectives. Suzanne also brings a "hands-on" style – leading by example is always the preferred course of action. People in the Quality Assurance business attest to creating a life style as a necessity to making significant change.

We have accomplished a great deal in a short time. Thanks to all who have been instrumental in this effort.

## Someone is Watching and Wondering



In 1939, shortly after England declared war against Germany, C.S. Lewis gave a sermon entitled *Living in War Time* at the Anglican Church in Oxford, England. He began with these words: "What does the Christian do in a world falling apart? A world like ours." As you might ex-

pect, since the gathering was in Oxford, Lewis was speaking to his fellow academics. He continued: "Why should anyone keep studying [philosophy] when the world is in such a horrible shape. Why sit in comfort with your books when you or your friends. . .[may] die? How can you justify studying. . .when you could be fighting. . .or working. . .making fighter planes and tanks?" I think perhaps Lewis' questions apply equally to us today, if we change "making fighter planes," to working for justice and doing our part to minimize the further spread of Covid19. I must confess reading his words about what Christians

should do when it seems that the world is falling apart, hit home. Since the beginning of this pandemic there have been so many times when I have felt that the world is truly falling apart. So many people are suffering and struggling, not only with this illness but with the broader consequences to our society as a whole. People have lost jobs and income, family members and friends have died, educating our children and young adults has and will continue to change dramatically, we are asked not to gather in large, crowded groups, many have not seen extended family for months, and certainly our Mass looks very different on the surface. Hospitals and nursing homes cannot permit visitors. People are feeling anxious and depressed about the future. Yet, time passes, basic needs still require attending to, seasons continue to progress, and for many our ordinary, day to day lives continue much the same.

C. S. Lewis, however, did not leave his listeners without an answer of hope. He said: "Keep doing what you're doing, as long as you're doing something worth doing. Do it better and do it as your service to God." We are each called to serve God and part of serving God is through living as humans and doing whatever we have been called to. We follow Jesus through taking up our cross in and through our everyday, ordinary living. We must continue do what we are called to do, and we must do it to the best of our abilities. God created and honors humanity and it is in our life as humans that He meets us, sustains, comforts, loves, and leads us into loving service to one another. So do not feel little for doing what you are called to do and recognize your life and work as service to God.
