



## Someone is Watching and Wondering



As a child I remember my mother quoting many different phrases and rarely did I know the original sources. One, however, I learned came from the Bible: “O you of little faith.” These words, or a variation of them are found in the gospels of Matthew (chapter 8 verse 26), Mark (chapter 4 verse 40), and Luke (chapter 8 verse 25). Thinking about where I am today, in light of the continuing pandemic and rising deaths, social unrest, peaceful protests and violence across our nation, and changes in my life to prevent even further spread of the Covid19 virus, this phrase came to mind and elicited my need for personal reflection.

The following words from a Buddhist monk Thich Nhat Hanh, helped focus my reflection. In his words he compared our world to a small boat. He wrote: “*Compared with the cosmos, our planet is a very small boat. We are about to panic because our situation is no better than the situation of the small boat in the sea. . . Humankind has become a very dangerous species. We need people who can sit still, be able to smile and who can walk peacefully.*” Reading these words I thought about the disciples reaction to a storm at sea, Jesus’ action to calm the sea, followed by His words, “O you of little “faith” (found in Matthew’s gospel). I felt compelled to ask myself, “SLG, where is your faith?” Now I confess to you, there are times when my faith waivers. Oh, I still believe in and try to follow the teachings of Jesus and I know He is always present. As many of you know, I am a person for whom patience is not my best attribute. When I see a problem I look for solutions, then work to implement fixing the problem. (Certainly my idea is best.) It is difficult for me to sit back and wait for others to act, or to rest in “God’s time.” I know I am not that person who can sit calmly doing nothing. I am blessed, however, with people around me who fit Thich Nhat Hanh’s description. They calmly offer advice, suggestions, possible actions, and remind me to have faith and trust God. These individuals encourage me to be patient, while also encouraging me to use my gifts and talents, which God’s grace has provided, for the good of others. I know that Jesus is in our small boat, and in time will calm our turbulent seas. I must not surrender to my fears that I am alone and about to drown. My answer, to “O you of little faith” seems to be to relax, calm down, and surrender to His love.

Ready for something new and stress-free? ### 'Prayer, Bible Stories & Jamming'!



### St. Maximilian Kolbe Feast Day August 14



St. Maximilian Kolbe, born January 8, 1894, in Poland, was a Polish Conventual Franciscan friar and a martyr in the German death Camp of Auschwitz during World War II.

He was very active in promoting the Immaculate Virgin Mary and is known as the Apostle of Consecration to Mary. He organized the Militia Immaculata after witnessing demonstrations against Pope St. Pius X and Benedict XV. In 1941, Kolbe was arrested by the German Gestapo and sent to Auschwitz. When a prisoner escaped in July of that year, ten men from his barracks were picked to suffer death by starvation as both punishment and deterrent. Fr. Maximilian offered to take the place of one of the men; Franciszek Gajowniczek.

It is said during the last days of his life Kolbe led prayers to Our Lady with the prisoners. He died on August 14, 1941, and his remains were cremated on August 15, the same day as the Assumption of Mary feast day.

Kolbe was canonized as a saint by Pope John Paul II on October 10, 1982. There was one extraordinary man in attendance at St. Maximilian's canonization.


