

## From the Pastor's Pen

This Saturday, August 15, our universal Church family honored the Blessed Virgin Mary as we celebrated the feast of the Assumption of Mary. Ordinarily, it would be a holy day of obligation, but since this year the feast falls on a Saturday, the obligation does not apply. That does not mean that we ignore the feast and its meaning.

So what is the meaning of this feast? The teaching is that Mary, upon her death, was taken bodily into the glory of heaven. Actually, this did not become a doctrine of the Church until 1950 when Pope Pius XII invoked papal infallibility in his apostolic constitution, "Munificentissimus Deus," in which he stated: "We proclaim and define it to be a doctrine revealed by God that that immaculate Mother of God, Mary ever-virgin, when the course of her earthly life was finished, was taken up body and soul into the glory of heaven."

This does not mean that the doctrine did not exist until 1950. Already in the 4th century we can read about discussions and writings held about Mary's immortality. The belief was known as the "Dormition of Mary," that means Mary "fell asleep." A tradition states that "Mary died in the presence of the Apostles, but that when her tomb was opened it was found empty; whereupon the apostles concluded that the body was taken up to heaven." The question of whether or not whether Mary actually underwent physical death remains open in the Catholic view. Some theologians believe that it would not be fitting for the body of Mary to undergo any kind of decay.

Many pilgrims who go to the Holy Land would want to visit the Church of the Dormition in Jerusalem. It is also known as the "Abbey of the Dormition, that word "dormation" meaning "falling asleep." Tradition associates this as the spot of Mary's last day on earth. There is another site in Jerusalem called "The Tomb of Mary," believed to be the place of her final rest.

We honor Mary as the faithful disciple of Jesus who has gone before us to receive heavenly glory. We look to her to be our intercessor.

## Someone is Watching and Wondering



One of the daily Mass readings the last week of August was from the prophet Jeremiah. In this passage, the prophet is instructed to go to the potter's house and await instructions. Waiting and watching the potter work the clay, Jeremiah is struck by the artisan's persistence. Objects that appeared inferior to the potter were simply reworked, until the potter was pleased with his creation. Then the Lord spoke to Jeremiah: "Can I not do to you ... as this potter has done? Indeed like clay in the hand of the potter, so are you in my hand" (Jer 18:8).

Since I was first introduced to this scripture passage, I have thought about the words many times especially as a teenager and now as a senior adult. How is God molding me? What is He calling me to do? Does God remove my flaws or do they remain part of His creation? I wish I had the answers. Sometimes I wonder where or what is He calling me to do; is it not too late to make alterations or radical change?

I believe the process is slow and perhaps never complete until such time as I may become "one in the Lord." A few of you may have heard the following statement (or one very similar to it) from my late husband Gene: "This earthly body of mine is just a clay pot that has started cracking with age and the wear and tear of living as a sinful human being. Death is when my soul is finally free from this pot and is transformed by God into my glorified body in Christ." Many of you knew Sr. Vicki Eques, MMB, who expressed a similar idea when she told me that heaven is when we are fully, reunited with God.

Looking at a Bible commentary relating to this passage from Jeremiah I found that "the lesson of the potter is not that God deals arbitrarily with His people (the nation Israel), but that He is almighty to destroy or restore, accordingly as they disobey Him or fulfill His plans." This interpretation, seems somewhat heartless, however, it reminded me of Matthew 25:31-46. Each of us will be judged by our actions, how we treat or fail to treat our brothers and sisters, especially those on the fringes of society. In putting these two readings together, I am lead to conclude that while God continues to form me, like a potter with clay, I myself must chose the path to follow, one lead by Jesus, or one lead by my ego full of selfish, self-centered desires and fears. God always gives me a choice. Like every good parent He leads with love but do I chose to follow in love?


