Helping Hands Ministry Begins September 12



Sometimes it can be a challenge for parishioners who are older and/or have mobility problems to attend weekend Mass easily. The walk from the car may be too long or the stairs difficult to navigate.

Beginning at the 5pm Mass on Saturday, September 12, volunteers from our new HELP-

ING HANDS MINISTRY will provide assistance to those needing some extra help reaching the sanctuary on the upper level of the building to attend Mass.

To use this service, please make a reservation. This ensures that we have enough volunteers available.

Please follow the steps below.

- 1 A few days before you plan to attend the 5:00pm Saturday Mass, make a reservation by calling Daryl Sweetland in the parish office, 781-4343, extension 200, by 4:00pm on Friday. Leave a message on her voice mail if you are unable to talk with her personally.
- 2 When arriving at the church, please park in one of the spaces on the south side of the church or behind the church as close to the south side as possible.
- 3 Enter the lower level of the church through the south door (near the dumpster). There will be a HELPING HANDS ENTRANCE sign near the door.
- 4 Please take a seat in one of the chairs near the door and a volunteer will be available shortly to assist you to your seat in the church; wheelchairs are available if needed.

After Mass, a volunteer will assist you in returning to the lower level.

Currently this service is available only for the 5:00pm Saturday Mass. We hope to be able to extend this service to other weekend Masses in the future.



Someone is Watching and Wondering



Although there is nothing **usual or normal** this year, I continue to receive inquiries and questions regarding our faith and the Catholic Church. Also, as in previous years, there are many questions for which I do not have a clear answer, so I hit the books.

Many of you know I am an avid reader and I have a large library of reference materials related to my interests in the sciences and travel, as well as many books related to religion and in particular our Christian roots and catholic traditions. Recently, I reread the documents of the Second Vatican Council and what I discovered was exactly what I needed as I continue to face the pandemic, systemic racism, unemployment, frustrations related to attending church services and children re-entering schools across the United States, and the continuing politicization of social distancing and wearing masks. Over the next few weeks. I would like to share some of my new insights (or re-discovered insights) from Vatican II. I am also taking a reverse approach by beginning with Gaudium et Spes. - "The Pastoral Constitution on the Church in the Modern World."

The preface to this document refers to the joy and hope. grief and anxiety of today's people. Although this document was promulgated in 1965, I find these words very much in line with our current situation both in the United States and throughout the world. There are so many who feel fear, anxiety, and grief, especially the poor and those without a voice and many without joy and hope. Yet my belief in Christ calls me to remain hopeful and joy filled. Indeed the preface to this document restates that nothing genuinely human should fail to raise my consciousness and heart to the voices and emotions of all my fellow human brothers and sisters. As part of the Christian community I am linked to all humankind and human history and called to bear a message of hope and salvation. The preface continues to explain that the world was created and is sustained by God; that we are all freed from the slavery of sin by Christ; and that the world is being recreated and brought to its destiny through the Holy Spirit. As members of the Body of Christ, we are called to give witness to these truths, revealed by Christ Jesus, and to serve others rather than to be served.

In today's world we are troubled and often perplexed by questions about our lives, the meaning of individual and collective work, and the purpose and nature of being human.

Gaudium et Spes attempts to clarify some of these questions in light of the Gospel. Further reflection next week.
