
Filling out and returning the 2021 Tithing Pledge Card helps us plan our budget for 2021.

New Parish Guide Book and Directory On Its Way





Someone is Watching and Wondering



As many of you know my daughter Julie is fighting COVID-19. She was hospitalized the weekend before Christmas and continues to struggle and fight for recovery from this infection. She is my second adult child to require hospitalization; my youngest son Ross was diagnosed in September and continues his recovery. As a mother, I can only say I feel helpless in caring for them, however, I have

not, nor do not feel hopeless. My hope is centered around trusting that God will continue to care for not only my loved ones but all those and their families who suffer because of the pandemic.

Julie's birthday is the 18th of this month and I have spent many hours recalling her dad and I waiting through the Christmas season for her birth. We were living in Germany, without any extended family, but we were surrounded and embraced by another family (other military families and our German hosts – there was almost no base housing and most of us lived with German families in small apartments). Reflecting back on that time, I once again realize the "family" is so much more than biology. Family for me includes any person who offers unconditional love and compassion, those who allow me to be myself rather than who they want me to be. Family are those individuals who challenge me and help me grow more loving, patient, and kind. Family are people I trust who never betray that trust, who refrain from gossip and harsh comments. Family are men and women who are always there, reaching out to help, to pray, and to offer words of empathy and compassion. I can honestly say my family, defined in this manner, is very diverse. They are from different cultures and religious traditions. There are individuals who look very different from me.

There are some who are older and some much younger. I must confess there are many who are wiser, more patient, and with greater humility than I possess. I am not sure how I would have gotten through the many trials and crises of my life without this family. I firmly believe their love and compassion are Christ's light shining, through them, into my life. They give me hope and strength especially at times when I feel so helpless.

There are a few things I have certainly learned from this family, especially in 2020: As long as Christ is the center of my life I have hope; I experience His love in so many ways when I open my heart; the love of family gives me encouragement and strength; I am grateful for all He provides; and I know that my sadness will always be replaced with that joy which I experience through His love and the love of family.

Thank you to all my St. James family. You are a gift and continue to lift me up. I pray for all of you and trust that Christ will continue to shine light into your lives this year, 2021.

Sacrament of Confirmation


