To better accommodate the numbers we are seeing, beginning with Sunday, March 7th, we will once again be offering a 5pm Sunday evening Mass.

For our scheduled ministers, our MSP schedule will reflect the resumption of that Mass, and you will receive an email with instructions about how to sign up. You can and should check your account on the MSP app to be sure it accurately reflects your preferences.

We will continue to live-stream our 8am Sunday Mass for home viewing, and Bishop Johnston has not rescinded the dispensation for in-person Sunday Mass, so you are not obligated to return before you determine it is safe for you.

With some folks getting vaccinated, and the prospect of more on the horizon, while some things will happily get easier, we want to stress a few vital procedures to keep in mind:

We rely on all of us to continue to maintain social distancing of 6' between families. Our ushers do a fine job of helping everyone find a seat, but it's up to each of us to be sure that we are holding that 6 foot distance and not encroaching into another family's space. And though it may seem okay to stand in the back in the aisle along the wall, that does not allow us to maintain the social distancing that we need.

Masks must still be worn at ALL times when in the church building, must cover the nose and mouth and must be attached to your face, not just held or draped. If you need a mask, let us know and we will get one to you. That requirement is waived for infants, toddlers, and children under 5 years of age.

A Thank You From The Knights of Columbus



The Knights of Columbus Council 6780 would like to thank everyone who supported us by coming to our Curbside/Pick Up & Go Lenten Fish Fry on Friday, February 26th. The response was well beyond our expectations.

Historically, we have served 900 orders at our Fish Fry in the school gym. Thinking that fewer people would show up at a curb-side dinner, we planned for 700 meals. Obviously we underestimated the response. We served 707 dinners before we "sold out" (way before our closing time of 7:00pm) and unfortunately had to turn away 50 vehicles.

We apologize to all who were turned away, but be assured that we making changes for the next fish fry on March 12 to make sure that everyone gets served.

Changes For Future Fish Fries

- Obviously, we will plan for more meals. It looks like curbside vs. dine does not affect the turnout.
- Because our 2 remaining fish fries will also be on evenings when Stations of the Cross are taking place, we will have separately marked entrances for each of these events.
 - Those coming for the Fish Fry will be directed to enter the South Drive.
 - Those coming for Stations will be directed to enter the main entrance.
- To minimize the back up on Stewart Road, there will be a different traffic pattern once you enter the St. James property.
- We will have additional traffic coordinators in the parking lot who will direct you. Our goal is to have everyone on our property.
- We are increasing the number of food preparation lines from 2 to 3 so that we can serve everyone more quickly and efficiently.

Again, we thank everyone who came out and hope that we will see you again on March 12.

Someone is Watching and Wondering



This week our Lenten Retreat/Reflection, "**A Journey for Seekers**" focuses on another pillar of Lent, **fasting**. I think most people would agree that when hearing the

term fasting our minds are immediately drawn to doing without food or at least minimizing what or how much we eat. In fact there are many religions that practice withholding food for a holy fast (e.g. Judaism, Islam, Buddhism, and Hinduism). Surprising, the practice of Catholics, participating in the "Lenten fast," has deep roots in ancient pagan cultures and religions. While I am not suggesting that we abandoned this practice (I know my health would improve by eating less), I would like to suggest a different idea of fasting for our Journey as Seekers. Is it possible to fast from ourselves, from pre-formed attitudes and concepts which lead to angry outbursts, generalizations, and judgments which do not reflect the teachings of Christ?

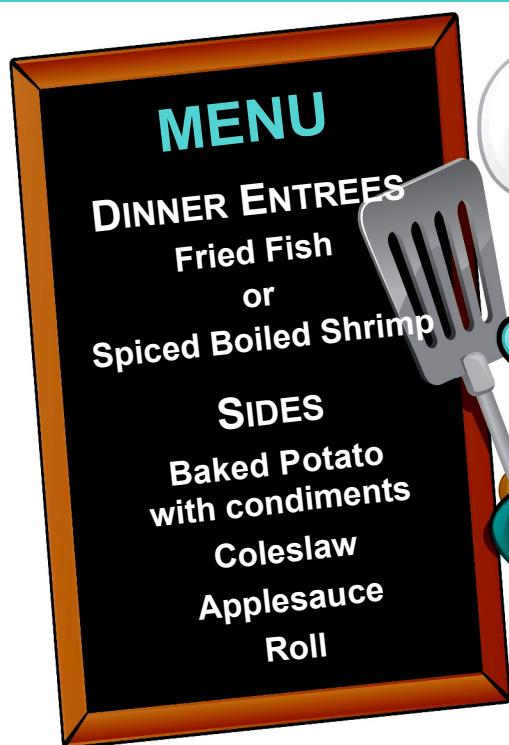
In Matthew's gospel we read: "You have heard that it was said to your ancestors, 'You shall not kill; and whoever kills will be liable to judgment.' But I say to you, whoever is angry with his brother will be liable to judgment, and whoever says to his brother, '*Raqa*' will be answerable. . ." (I suggest reading all of chapter 5 and meditate on Jesus' preaching). The term *Raqa* or *reka* in Aramaic is believed by scholars to have meant an empty-headed, foolish, or vain individual. *Reka* was used as a word of reproach by Jews in Jesus' time and carried the meaning of being worthless. As I reflected on this gospel passage and the term *reka*, I was faced with the grim reality that there are and have been many people or groups with ideas and understandings different than my own, to which I applied this term. Trusting in my own knowledge and strongly held beliefs of right and wrong, I fell into the habit of brushing off these people, groups, and ideas as foolish and worthless. Over the last year, however, I have been confronted by the fact that I have acted and reacted contrary to Jesus' insightful words in Matthew, chapter 5. I had forgotten what it meant to see with the "eyes of a child, innocent and pure, to become a 'holy fool' who loves and trusts in the Lord. Paul wrote "Let no one deceive himself. If anyone among you considers himself wise in this age, let him become a fool so as to become wise. For the wisdom of this world is foolishness in the eyes of God. . ." (1 Cor 3:18-19). Pope Francis recently challenged us "Love, following in the footsteps of Christ. . . compassion is the highest expression of our faith and hope. . . **love is a leap of the heart; it brings us out of ourselves** and creates bonds of sharing and communion." I challenge each of us, therefore, to a fast from ourselves, as we look to others with the loving eyes of Christ.
