



## **Someone is Watching and Wondering**



Perhaps last week my message felt dark. My hope was that you might experience the last supper and passion liturgies as the disciples, without already experiencing

the resurrection. I also hoped you might walk through your personal experiences of the past year, sharing as you walked with Jesus His final days. Today, however, we experience the fullness of the resurrection, leading to the light of hope and joy filled resurrection from our personal darkness and despair. Today, we rejoice and once again sing "alleluias." Joan Chittister in *The Search of Belief* writes: "The Spirit of God is a wild thing, breathing where it will, moving as it pleases, settling on [both] women and men." Sr. Joan continues with her creed: "I believe in one God who made us all and whose divinity infuses all of life with the sacred... expressed in every culture, and found in all the wisdoms [truths] of the world. I believe that Jesus Christ, the unique son of God, is the face of God on earth in whom we see best the divine justice, divine mercy, and divine compassion... I believe in the Christ who is One in being with the Creator and who shows us the presence of God in everything that is and [who] calls out the sacred in ourselves. I believe in Jesus, the Christ, who leads us to the fullness of human stature. . . Through Christ we become new people, called beyond the consequences of our brokenness and lifted to the fullness of life. . . He rose again in those He left behind. . .to live in hearts that will not succumb to the enemies of life. He changed all of life. . . I believe in the Holy Spirit, the breath of God on earth, who keeps the Christ vision present to souls yet in darkness, gives life even to hearts now blind, infuses energy into spirits yet weary, isolated, searching and confused. The Spirit has spoken to the human heart. . . gives meaning to the Word. . . I believe in One holy and universal church bound together by the holiness of creation and the holiness of hearts forever true. I acknowledge the need to be freed from the compulsions of my disordered life and my need for forgiveness in face of frailty. I look for eternal life in ways I cannot dream and trust that creation goes on creating in this world and in us forever. Amen" Her words (although I omitted many) have become a refreshing voice, this past year, for my faith which I felt diminished and my life which I felt disordered. Today, this Easter 2021, I feel hope in the resurrection, a new love for God, and courage to face each new day, acknowledging my blessings and praying for the strength to give myself in trust and loving service God and to His children, in whatever way God leads me. My continued prayers seek healing for our brokenness this Blessed Easter.

### A Special Promise of Mercy

Our Lord's promise to grant complete forgiveness of sins and punishment on the Feast of Mercy is recorded three times in the *Diary of St. Faustina*:

I want to grant a complete pardon to the souls that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion on the Feast of My mercy (*Diary* 1109).

Whoever approaches the Fountain of Life on this day will be granted complete forgiveness of sins and punishment (*Diary* 300).

The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion will obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment (*Diary* 699).

*It's allowed for one to go to confession up to 20 days before or after Divine Mercy Sunday*





**April 6 - May 18, 2021**

On the Sunday after Jesus' death, two disciples left Jerusalem despondent. On the road to Emmaus, they encountered a stranger who asks them for the news. They tell him about the crucifixion of the man they had hoped would be the Messiah. The stranger reviewed for them the scriptures, from Moses and through all the prophets, that foretold the Messiah and his suffering.

As the stranger opened the scriptures to them, the disciples said, "our hearts were burning within us."

Later as they broke bread at the end of the day, the disciples recognized the stranger as the Resurrected Jesus, and he vanished. Jesus had helped them "put two and two together" and see reality as it is.

The disciples returned to Jerusalem where their testimony strengthened the community.

People continue to have similar experiences of finding Jesus in surprising situations and unexpected circumstances — even today.

In this video series, Fr. Ron Will, CPPS, and guests will explore times that Jesus has made surprise appearances in their lives. They will recall encounters during service, pieces of art, current events and other ways and times, Jesus made himself known in their lives.






