## From the Pastor's Pen

On this Second Sunday of Easter we celebrate "Divine Mercy Sunday," focusing of God's loving mercy as proclaimed by Jesus.

This is a celebration that is of recent origins. Most of you are aware of the background and the story of Sr. Faustina and her role in promoting this devotion.

Born Helen Kowalski in 1905 in Poland, she came from a very poor but devout family. Growing up, she had a strong prayer life and was sure that God was calling her to religious life. In 1920, in Warsaw she entered the novitiate program of the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy. After her years of preparation, she received the religious habit and was given the name Sr. Maria Faustina of the Blessed Sacrament. In 1931, she had a vision of Jesus. As she noted in her diary, Jesus was wearing a white garment with red and pale rays emanating from his heart. She was given the instruction that she should paint an image according to the vision with the words, "Jesus, I trust in you." Jesus told her that he wished the image to be venerated.

Sr. Faustina, not a painter, gave instructions to an artist and the image was rendered. It was to be known as the "Divine Mercy Image," to be blessed and venerated on the first Sunday after Easter. Her visions continued, and she received guidance from her spiritual director, Fr. Michael Sopoco. In her diary she wrote of a threefold purpose for venerating the image: (1) To obtain mercy; (2) to trust in God's mercy; (3) to show mercy to others. The Divine Mercy prayer was published and spread among the people. Sr. Faustina's visions continued, though her health was declining. She died at the young age of 33. Her remains rest in the Krakow, Poland, Basilica of Divine Mercy. Pope John Paul II approved of this devotion and declared that the Second Sunday of Easter be observed as Divine Mercy Sunday.

Of course the Church teaches that private revelations are not a matter of dogma, but still can enrich the Church and the devotional life of the faithful. Certainly the message of divine mercy is very Scriptural and the comfort of our faith.

May God bless you with a joyous Easter Season. My prayers are with you.

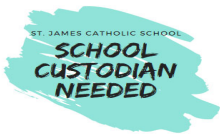

**Someone is Watching and Wondering**



As part of my prayer and meditation to prepare for the liturgies of Holy Week I read a series of articles by Fr. Richard Rohr on “Scapegoating.” I felt as though the articles were written to me directly and they hit a

sensitive cord when I reread and reflected on the gospel for Palm Sunday of the Passion of our Lord Jesus and participated in the *Sacred Triduum*. I find the gospel accounts of Jesus’ passion emotionally disturbing and each year I am forced to ask myself “How do I still crucify Jesus in my day to day living.” This year the answer was obvious: “I have yet to fully break my old pattern of judging others who disagree with my thoughts and beliefs.” I also had to ask, in finding scapegoats for what is wrong in my life, our church, society, and the world, do I not continue to reject Jesus and His teaching? – crucifying Him with my words, actions, and inactions.

Fr. Rohr suggested that we see scapegoating when we read or listen to the daily news: “hating, fearing, or diminishing someone else holds us together for some reason. . .we compare, we conspire, we condemn, and we crucify” others with our words and actions. . .[we] imagine that [we] are fearing and hating on behalf of something holy and noble: God, religion, truth, morality, [our] children, or love of country. It [scapegoating] takes away all guilt, and [we] think [we are] representing the moral high ground or being responsible and prudent. . it never occurs to [us] that [we] are becoming what [we] fear and hate. Fr. Rohr’s words struck a nerve and I realized as I looked upon the cross that I am guilty of blaming others for evil in the world while whitewashing my participation in the environment which continues to promote suffering and evil. While I strive to live a moral life, aware of needs of others I also feel trapped and frustrated when I witness unkind, selfish, and self-centered acts; this is when I am likely use the scape-goat mechanism.

This past year, missing family, friends, and social activities due to COVID, I realize how interconnected I am with people I do not even know personally. My actions, inactions, or words can effect grocery workers, fellow church goers, my neighbors, workers who provide services in and around my home, doctors, nurses, lab technicians, gas station attendants, co-workers and so many others, even my own family members. I felt such shame and lack of worthiness as I participated in our Holy Week liturgies, especially as I look upon Jesus crucified. At the same time, I continue to feel the joy of Easter and the promise of the resurrection. God’s love and grace is almost incomprehensible. I know He continues to gift me in spite of my failings. I do not need a scapegoat, all I need is God’s love to lead me.

## #BEAPARTOFTHESOLUTION

The Pennsylvania grand jury report, published in August of 2018, brought the scandal of clergy sex abuse in the US to the forefront once again. In the following months, headlines about abusive priests, indifferent bishops, predatory cardinals and Vatican corruption ensued. Pope Francis held a world-wide summit in Rome in February, the "Protection of Minors in the Church" ([www.pbc2019.org](http://www.pbc2019.org)). A number of issues have been identified with strong calls for reform including more leadership by laity in the handling of clergy sex abuse. Now, more than ever, we have an opportunity to change the way the world and our Church responds to sexual abuse and to help those who have been harmed. Since each of us make up the Church, how will you impact this movement?

## #JOINTHECONVERSATION

### DID YOU KNOW?

- 1:4 girls and 1:6 boys will be sexually abused by the age of 18
- Abusers of children are people we know and trust
- 73% of child sexual abuse victims do not tell anyone for at least a year
- 45% of victims do not tell anyone for at least 5 years
- Some victims wait decades to disclose while some never disclose their abuse
- The residual effects of having been abused can last a lifetime
- Predators entice children online through games, apps and sites they frequent

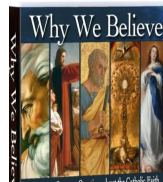

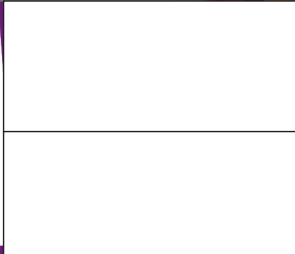

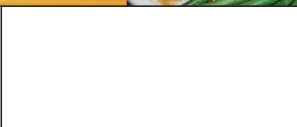
