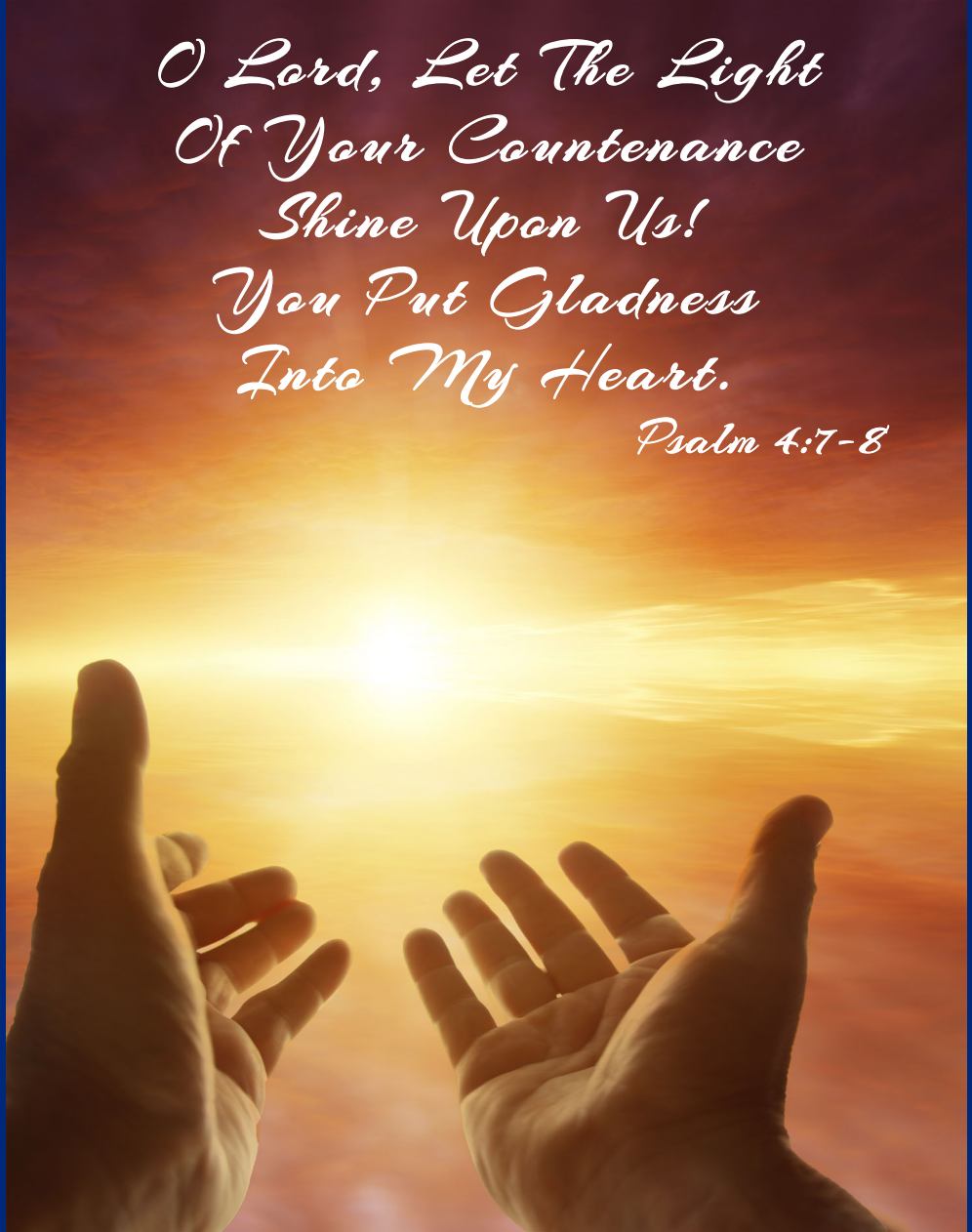

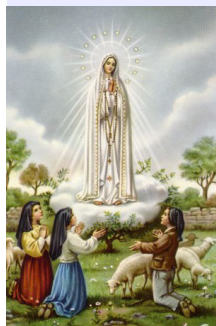

In 1930, the Church declared worthy of belief, the visions of the shepherd children in Fatima, Portugal from the May 13 to Oct. 13, 1917. Pope John Paul II exhibited his approval of Fatima many times. He visited Fatima 3 times – in 1982, 1991 and 2000. During his 2000 visit made the Feast day of Our Lady of Fatima universal by ordering it to be included in the Roman Missal.

Roses for Mother's Day



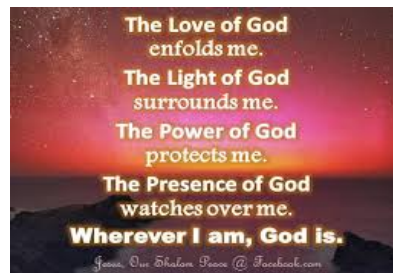

Someone is Watching and Wondering



During Lent I participated in a forty day Ignatian workout/retreat. Each day there was a scripture to read, a meditation, a prayer, and a personal action (e.g. practice forgiveness) for the day. Each day as I

tried to complete the particular action I was continually brought back to the scripture, meditation, and prayer, forcing me to evaluate my life. I found myself truly seeking God's help, especially when the action required seemed foreign to my thoughts, desires, and capabilities. I came to understand how much I depend on God, His love and mercy. I gained a greater understanding of God as a parent; always present to hold me up and help me through life's challenges. I also found one who does not fail to help me understand my short-comings, selfishness, and sinfulness. I grew in understanding that God's mercy is much greater than my failures. God is forever present to lift, embrace, and enfold me in love, to offer unconditional forgiveness. Tragically throughout my life there have been many times when I rejected God's guidance. In my stubbornness to get by and figure things out on my own, I failed miserably. I do not know whether the peculiar circumstances of Lent 2020 and 2021 (due to the Covid pandemic) forced me into a deeper, inner contemplation or whether this forty-day retreat brought clarity to what it means to love and serve God. What I do know, without any reservation, is that I need to open myself to the profound presence and love of God, most clearly revealed in the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus, if I am to be true to the faith I profess. I cannot love and serve unless I first accept God's love and mercy, God's presence in my life, not simple when it is convenient, but everyday and always.

St. Paul tells us that nothing can separate us from the love of God. Believing this statement, however, requires that I must open myself freely to that love, trust in that love, and allow God's love to flow through me. Only then can I share His love with others. At times during my workout/retreat it was difficult to face myself, expose my limitations, and ask for God's help. There were also days I found difficult to focus my spiritual journey toward the good of others, as opposed to what I previously understood as a spiritual journey centered on personal growth in the faith. I came to realize what is continuously emphasized in Jesus' teachings that spiritual development is not about struggling in some divine competition in which only the strong survive and gain heaven. Rather, spiritual formation is about removing obstacles to God's grace so that God can draw me closer to Himself which enables me to love and serve others.

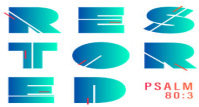

April Is Child Abuse Protection Month

What's happening in our diocese to protect the most vulnerable ?

- We report all allegations of abuse directly to law enforcement and cooperate with civil authorities on all investigations.
- Our diocese has a designated Victim Assistance Coordinator whose primary role is to accompany survivors and provide resources for their healing journey.
- We also have an independent review board, consisting primarily of lay members. The role of the review board is to review allegations and make a recommendation to the bishop regarding the suitability for ministry.
- We train adults on how to maintain a safe environment and how to report concerns.
- We train minors in parish religious education programs and in Catholic schools to identify warning signs of abuse and inappropriate behavior, as well as how to report abuse.
- By following all of our diocesan policies and procedures to create safe environments, we can maintain a culture of protection and healing.

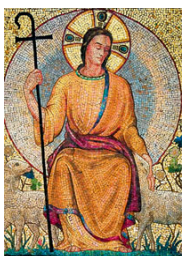
