## From the Pastor's Pen

When you pray, say "Our Father," the instruction of Jesus. God, of course, has no gender. Yet how else can we speak of God? So in using the word "Father," Jesus was proclaiming God as a "life-giver." The God that we believe in is beyond human comprehension, beyond human words, and yet that is the only way we think and communicate. All those qualities of a good father come to mind as we address God in prayer as "Our Father."

For some people, their own fathers have not been good models of fatherhood. Some are abusive, some abandon their wife and family, some are indifferent and show no affection and love. When people have such a negative picture of a father, it is very difficult for them to appreciate God by using the word "father." They must look beyond their own experiences and see good role models in other men who stand out as loving and caring.

On Mother's Day, in my bulletin column I spoke about my mother and what a wonderful and exceptional lady she was. I must say that my father also had many virtues that made him a great role model. He grew up in the Great Depression, lost his father at the age of 16, had seven siblings and a mother who kept her brood together with hard work and good example. With that background, my father was a loving husband and father, a hard worker, a great provider, a man of deep faith. Though his education was only to the 8<sup>th</sup> grade, he expected all the children to excel in learning and get a college education. Mother died at the age of 53, making it all the more important that he keep the family together in loving relationships.

So we came back again to God, named as Our Father. The Gospel for this weekend relates the account about the stormy sea, the fear of the apostles in the boat, and the calming of the storm by Jesus. The story reminds us that storms beset all of us in different ways. When we encounter a storm in our life, we turn to the Lord. For young children who are frightened, a father's assuring words give comfort. For adults who face emotional storms and trials, Jesus teaches us to have confidence in God the Father's loving presence. How often in the gospels don't we hear the word of Jesus, "Do not be afraid." Today we shore up our trust, confident to call God "Our Father."

My prayers are with you each day.

## Someone is Watching and Wondering



Whenever I hear people address how to become a practicing Catholic I hear three words bantered around: **conversion, evangelization, and spirituality**

**Conversion** is defined as change in character, form or function, or a spiritual change from sinfulness to righteousness; **evangelization** means preaching of the gospel; and **spirituality** is that which pertains to the spirit or soul as distinguished from our physical nature, conscious thoughts, and emotions. If these definitions seem unsatisfactory for you as a follower of Christ, you are not alone. I have asked many people to define or describe these three words and frequently the answers seem to be a curvy path around the words that leads nowhere.

For me **conversion** is a profound, life changing event or events of the mind and heart, which lead to a desire for a relationship with God. Conversion is a process of personal transformation leading to an awareness of God's presence and grace in our lives. True conversion leads to a new way of assessing what is moral and fundamentally important, in which we no longer limit our ideas of what is real to what is seen or empirically verified. Conversion leads to making moral choices that transforms our behavior rather than making self-centered choices that give immediate satisfaction and gratification. Conversion requires honestly acknowledging feelings and emotions and accepting responsibility. Conversion opens us to new horizons through which we confront and challenge our slavery to sin. True conversion is a gift of grace which opens us to the promise of friendship, love and unity with God.

To evangelize is to live and proclaim the gospel teaching of Christ Jesus. Jesus clearly and definitely instructs his disciples, "Go into the whole world and proclaim the gospel to every creature" (Mark 16:15). Today we are still called to this mission. Through the proclamation of the gospel the Church "prepares the hearers to receive and profess the faith. . . incorporates them into Christ so that through charity they may grow into full maturity in Christ" (*Dogmatic Constitution on the Church*). Thus we must proclaim the kingdom that Jesus proclaimed, one of love, justice, peace, and holiness. Evangelization is about liberation from every form of sin and oppression, serving our brothers and sisters, giving hope to the hopeless, transforming humanity

Living as Christians who love and serve Christ requires on-going **conversion** and **evangelization**. Next week I will look at **spirituality**.

## Solemnity of the Nativity of St. John the Baptist Thursday, June 24
