We Welcome Madyson Roberts This Weekend

Madyson Roberts will be here with us at all Masses this weekend to speak about FOCUS (The Fellowship of Catholic University Students). FOCUS is a Catholic collegiate outreach whose mission is to share the hope and joy of the gospel with college and university students, inspiring and equipping them for a lifetime of Christ-centered evangelization, discipleship and friendships in which they lead others to do the same.

While she was a student at Northwest Missouri State College, she completed her student teaching here at St. James in the spring of 2020.

While in college she became involved with the Newman Catholic Center and FOCUS. After college she joined the ministry of FOCUS and became a missionary. Last year she completed her first year with FOCUS at Northern Illinois University and will be returning there to serve her second year.

Someone is Watching and Wondering



To begin where I left you last week, **spirituality** is defined as being spiritual, that which pertains to the spirit or soul as distinguished from our physical nature, or relating to con-

scious thoughts and emotions. One might ask, can a person be spiritual without believing in God? Give how you responded to this question, what defines your spirituality; how might you explain your spirituality to a nonbeliever or one of our Christian brothers or sisters?

The *Encyclopedia of Catholicism* states: "Christian spirituality is the daily, communal, lived expression of one's ultimate belief characterized by openness to the self-transcending love of God, self, neighbor, and world through Jesus Christ and in the power of the Spirit." To express this complex definition simply, **spirituality** is the lived encounter and experience of Jesus Christ. Spirituality is not so much concerned with doctrines as with the ways Jesus' teachings shape us as individuals, living in the larger world. Another aspect to Catholic-Christian spirituality is our rich tradition from the apostles and the early church. Scripture refers to this tradition as "so great cloud of witnesses" (Heb 12:1). The apostles experienced Jesus in real time and space, yet they did not come together as a community until Christ's ascension into heaven and reception of the Holy Spirit at the first Pentecost. Strengthened by the Spirit, they evangelized and lead others to conversion. We too must experience the real presence of Jesus in our lives (although unlike the experience of the apostles), accept His gift of the Holy Spirit, and acknowledge that everything we are and have is graced. It is experiences of grace which lead to on-going conversion and development of our unique spirituality. During the twentieth century our understanding of spirituality grew holistically. Rather than seeing ourselves separate from the world, our physical body and our sexuality, we view the entire world and the human person as sacred. Nature and God's grace build on each other in a mutual and reciprocal way. Our spiritual life is dynamic, going through stages of development and growth as our physical body experiences birth, childhood, adolescence, adulthood, and old age. Our spiritual growth cannot be divorced from our physical and intellectual growth. With openness to the Holy Spirit, our spirituality can embrace the global community and our planet, demanding a reorientation of our thoughts and actions toward all people and our environment. We must embrace Jesus' commandment to identify with the poor, seek justice, and inclusivity, and authentic stewardship. I invite you to reflect on your conversion, evangelization and spirituality and possibly invite another person to join you in our shared faith.

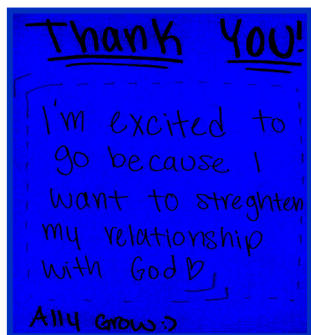

Saints Peter and Paul Feast Day - June 29



These two saints are the founders of the See of Rome, through their preaching, ministry and martyrdom there.

Peter, who was named Simon, was a fisherman of Galilee. Jesus gave him the name Cephas (Petrus in Latin), which means 'Rock', because he was to become the rock upon which Christ would build His Church.

St. Paul was the Apostle of the Gentiles. His letters are included in the writings of the New Testament, and through them we learn much about his life and the faith of the early Church.

In the year 395, St. Augustine of Hippo said of Saints Peter and Paul: "Both apostles share the same feast day, for these two were one; and even though they suffered on different days, they were as one. Peter went first, and Paul followed. And so we celebrate this day made holy for us by the apostles' blood."

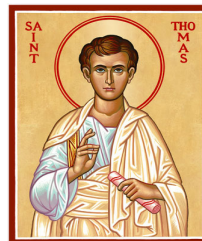

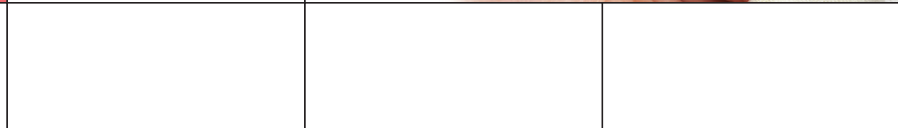
