This weekend we celebrate our patronal feast. St. James (the Greater), Apostle. On this Sunday, July 25, we have the opportunity to celebrate his Feast Day, with the Readings of the Feast, and prayers praying for the intercession of St. James on our community.

BLOOD DRIVE - July 27

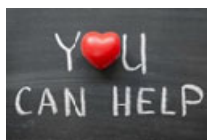


Calling all healthy individuals, age 16 and over, willing to roll up your sleeve and help a neighbor, friend, or family member!

No, this doesn't involve hard labor or anything like that. You actually get to put your feet up and have snacks afterwards. It does involve a small sacrifice though; a pint to be exact.

St. James is hosting a Community Blood Center Blood Drive on Tuesday, July 27th from 12:30-6:30pm in the Social Hall.

If you can find an hour to spare and donate blood, the lives you save could be that of someone you know. Did we mention that every presenting donor can get a KC Royals t-shirt or hat? You will have the option of redeeming one of these items online after the blood drive.



Our area is seeing a major blood shortage and finding donors now is critical. There are 25,000 donors in the greater KC area alone that have yet to return to donate since

before the pandemic. Donating blood is safe. Masks are still required for all donors. Sanitizing takes place after every donor and distancing is practiced whenever possible.

Someone is Watching and Wondering

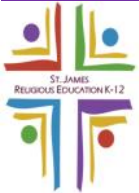
On the feast of the Epiphany, 1972, the Catholic Church reinstated the Rites for Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA). Bishops recognized the Rites as a tool for missions in developing countries, and a way to revitalize faith in de-Christianized Europe. No one believed the RCIA would make much difference in the post-conciliar church, especially in the United States. In October 2000, however, the U.S. bishops reported that the RCIA "is renewing the life of the Church in the United States." Since RCIA is a journey of conversion, by extension it is a journey for all the faithful. When the Rites are well implemented, the RCIA is a source of energy and new life.

Initiation rites are about identity. They define the community and what it holds dear. Yet along with identity, initiation also involves change. While identity sounds firm and comforting, change is an occasion of risk. The rites are joyful, yet filled with awe and perhaps fear; they ritualize an acceptance of stepping into a new, unknown future. As the parish celebrates, the baptized faithful are called to redefine social values and re-evaluate what it means to be Catholics who remain faithful to the teachings of Jesus. The complacent may become unsettled, and the jaded refreshed as they witness changes in the heart and soul of the community.

Christian initiation is centered in catechesis, however, many people mistakenly assume that catechesis refers to teaching doctrines or theologies. Catechesis, however, is much more than teaching; it is a life long process involving a radical relationship with Jesus. Catechesis explores and recognizes God's action and presence in our natural lives, in scripture, and in the life, faith, and worship of the Church. Initiation is both catechetical and the work of the faithful: evangelization, ministry to the alienated, hospitality, accessibility, and the face the parish presents to strangers. The RCIA has turned the church outward and invited the faithful to recognize themselves as people who embrace their identity and mission as baptized disciples. Thus it is the entire community who bring new Christians to birth. The *Rite* states that those requesting initiation "seek the living God and enter the way of faith and conversion." People come to St James seeking God, and a community of fellow believers. Our parish as witness to the faith, experience Christ more deeply by sharing experiences, praying with and for the catechumens and guiding them along their journey. We invite them into a wondrous process where they develop, deepen and enrich their relationship with our loving God in Jesus Christ through the Holy Spirit. Likewise when we witness catechumens giving up old ways of doing/being, and committing themselves to Jesus, it makes us want to recommit ourselves to Christ, to renew and refresh our faith lives, enrich our prayer, and trust in God's love to guide us through life-long *mystogogy*.

Preparation for First Reconciliation is required before receiving the Sacrament of First Communion

First Reconciliation prep begins early October, and First Communion prep begins in February.

Sunday July 25 Feast Day of St. James the Greater The Patron Saint of Our Church



The son of Zebedee and Salome, "our" St. James is called "the Greater" to distinguish him from the Apostle James "the Less", who was probably shorter of stature. He was the brother of John, the beloved disciple. Zebedee, his father, was a fisherman of the Sea of Galilee. Salome, his mother, was one of the pious

women who afterwards followed Christ and ministered unto him of their substance.

James is described as one of the first disciples to join Jesus. When he first encountered Jesus, there probably was no indication that this was the day that his life would change. The dawn for him was not the bright beginning of a new day, but the end of long fruitless night of fishing. As James sat mending his nets in the boat with his brother John and his father Zebedee, he must have watched in wonder as his partner Simon brought in nets loaded with fish he had caught at the command of Jesus.

As Jesus walked towards James, followed by Simon and Andrew, He didn't pass him by. He stopped by their boat and called James and his brother John to do just what Simon and Andrew had done - follow Him. Without argument or discussion, James and John left their boat and even their father behind, and followed Jesus.

James was one of only three apostles whom Jesus chose to join to join him in prayer at the Garden of Gethsemane for his final prayer before his arrest and whom Jesus selected to bear witness to his Transfiguration.

Following Christ's Ascension, James spread the Gospel across Israel and the Roman kingdom as well. He traveled and spread the Word for nearly forty years in Spain.

The Acts of the Apostles records that "herod the king" (traditionally identified with Herod Agrippa) had James executed by sword. St. James is the only apostle whose martyrdom is recorded in the New Testament.
