While we are not technically affiliated with either diocese, Gabriel Project KC enjoys the full support of both Bishop Johnston and Archbishop Naumann.

In a nutshell, the Gabriel Project seeks to provide emotional, material and spiritual support to any pregnant woman in need...not just up to the birth of their child, but for as long as is necessary. Save the baby, save the mom... is our unspoken mantra.

The process of saving the baby begins when a woman calls the Gabriel Project 24/7 helpline. A trained volunteer on our end assesses the woman's immediate needs and assigns her to one of our angels. Gabriel Project angels are our special volunteers who have been trained to walk with these women one on one, hand in hand, from the day the case is opened, until the day the case is closed.

## From the Pastor's Pen

Because the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, celebrated each year on August 15, falls on Sunday this year, the celebration of this feast replaces the liturgy of the 20th Sunday in Ordinary Time this weekend.

No Biblical texts describe Mary's Assumption, but it has been part of the Tradition of the Church since earliest times and honored down through the centuries. It was not until 1950 that the Assumption of Mary was declared a doctrine of the Church. Pope Pius XII issued an apostolic constitution which stated: "We proclaim and define it to be a doctrine revealed by God that the immaculate Mother of God, Mary ever virgin, when the course of her earthly life was finished, was taken up body and soul into the glory of heaven." Even though we cannot fully understand all the details of this doctrine, we can appreciate the place of Mary as our intercessor with the hope that one day we will share with her a place of glory.

This week an important even is happening in our parish: the first day at St. James School beginning this Wednesday. We offer special prayers for our administrators, teachers, support staff, parents and students with every hope that it will be another successful school year. What a difference from last August when we were coping with COVID, scrambling to make plans for the school in the midst of a pandemic. We are so grateful for the cooperation of so many people that the 2020-2021 school year was a great success. We begin this year on a more positive note confident that our endeavors bear rich fruit.

Why should the parish put so much effort, so many resources, so much money into a Catholic school? In the early days of our country when anti-Catholic sentiment was strong, Catholic schools were a way of preserving and passing on our faith. Today there is not so much anti-Catholic expressions but rather a secular culture that dismisses the importance of faith and Christian \ Catholic values which motivates us to pledge resources for the sake of planting the faith for future generations. We ask that you continue to support our school which benefits not only school families but also the parish and Church. May God richly bless our efforts.

## Someone is Watching and Wondering

# CATECHESIS

Catechetical formation is an essential part of initiation into the Catholic church, and the **primary** minister of initiation in the RCIA is the **parish community**. The quality of lives within the community, their concern and interest for one another, the manner of worship, the commitment to social justice and outreach activities, all of this is the where and how of the RCIA. People come to St. James to become part of our community. It is our responsibility not only to welcome them, but to show these interested individuals what makes our community distinctive, warm, involved, and a strong Catholic Christian community. Therefore, it is essential that each of us understand our responsibility in the adult initiation process.

Catechesis is an echoing of the gospel. It is a ministry of all the baptized who proclaim and live the good word of God's grace; salvation in Jesus Christ. It is a full and robust action that invites each person to respond in faith, embodying charity and justice and mercy. The full person is called and challenged through good catechesis.

Catechesis is concerned with helping the catechumen name their experiences of God, and reflect on their responses. Additionally, the catechumen needs to come to know the story of the Catholic community and how, throughout the centuries, we have come to name the experience of God in our midst. If the period of the pre-catechumenate was a time for storytelling, the period of the catechumenate develops that story into a dialogue. We don't abandon the storytelling and faith-sharing, but expand it to include the particular story of our Catholic faith, and our parish community.

**Catechesis is not about passing information. It is about enlivening faith.** How can we incorporate the great symbols of our community, including the rich word symbols of doctrine, to empower and enliven their faith? The exciting challenge of catechesis is to make the word of God, in scripture and as articulated in the faith of the community, credible and meaningful. This is not a watering down of the word of God, but rather a raising up of that word so that it has a bearing on our ordinary, daily life experiences.

Therefore, catechesis in the RCIA is designed for adults, who after hearing the mystery of Christ proclaimed, consciously and freely seek the living God. Their journey of faith begins as the Holy Spirit opens their hearts, and leads them to the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist.

## Elementary RE - Grades K - 5

Join us this year as our families gather monthly for elementary faith formation. Families will enjoy a meal together as well as an interactive lesson. We offer a Wednesday evening session from 6 to 7:30 pm, and a Sunday afternoon session from 11:45 am to 1:15pm. Our initial sessions begin Wednesday, Sept. 8th and Sunday, Sept. 12th. We will enjoy family discussions about Mass, and the kids will spend some time touring the church and finding and naming the many things they see, as the parents listen to speakers who share their own passion for Mass, especially Mass with children. ## Middle School RE - Grades 6 - 8

### High School Ministry - Grades 9 - 12

Our Middle and High School students will be embarking on a journey that begins with discipleship – a great place to pick up our Catholic faith as Jesus has called each of us to go out and be disciples. These two programs share the same topic, but will be utilizing age-appropriate activities, materials and discussions to enhance their faith formation as they grow to be disciples. Both groups will meet after the 5pm Sunday evening Mass (6:15ish), approximately two times per month. The Middle School students will meet in the Social Hall (former church) while the High School students will meet in the Resource Center (former church offices). The first session of these programs begins Sunday, September 19th. Register today!



## Sacramental Preparation First Reconciliation / First Communion

Sign up today to register your second grade (or older) student in our sacrament prep program. Our families will utilize the Blessed program materials to present 6 lessons to their students (either utilizing their beautifully illustrated workbook or their fun and engaging video program. We will be supplementing the program with an initial Retreat and Parent Meeting (same time, same location), as well as a tour of the Church and a Practice. First Reconciliation will be celebrated in small settings yet still communal in nature. The student's parents and older siblings are invited to receive the sacrament as well. Register today, and plan to attend a Retreat and Parent Meeting on either Oct. 3 or 4th.



## Sacramental Preparation - Confirmation

Students who are in 9th to 12th grade are eligible to begin preparing to receive the sacrament of Confirmation. Be sure to register soon, pick up the materials packet, choose a sponsor, and bring your parent and sponsor to the Confirmation Kick-Off after the Sunday evening Mass (6:15ish) on September 19th. Our program meets 10 times, approximately twice a month on Sundays after the evening Mass. Half of those sessions will be students only, and half will include sponsors and/or parents – because peer-to-peer interaction is equally as important as a sponsor's or parent's participation. Service hours, Retreat and Pray With the Church requirements are all met in our 10 session program! Sign up today!

## Program Fees

To simplify registration, each family will complete only one registration (for all grades K12), excepting sacramental prep programs which require an additional form/fee. Registration fees are \$55 for one child, \$100 for two children, and \$125 for families with three or more children.


