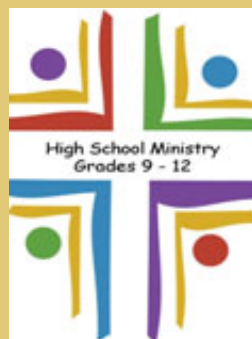

## Someone is Watching and Wondering



What do you see when you look in a mirror? Are you pleased with your image? Do you wish for an image of yourself that isn't there; perhaps younger or older, thinner or more filled out, darker or lighter skin, straight or curly hair, anything other than what you see? I

feel confident in saying that most of us have had similar thoughts at some point in our life. Perhaps more importantly, however, than any of our desires of how we physically appear in the mirror, is the question: "Do I see God's beloved child in my reflected image?" While it may be easy to see my flaws, do I see anything worthwhile? Do I see who God created? Sad but true, seeing ourselves as beloved, just the way we are can be difficult.

Recently I watched a documentary on Fred Rogers of Mr. Rogers-PBS fame. I became aware of a consistent and evolving message in every episode of this children's program; each human is loved and accepted by God and as Christians we are called to love as Jesus taught, to accept and respect one another, "just they way we are." We are called to protect and cherish all that God creates. We are called to be united in Christ Jesus, to recognize the universality of his message. Pope Francis echoes this theme and warns of the danger of falling into hypocrisy, speaking words from the Gospels while failing to live the simple message Jesus proclaimed: "you will be known as one of my disciples by your love."

Fr. Richard Rohr has written: "A mirror by its nature reflects impartially, equally, effortlessly, spontaneously, and endlessly. It does not produce the image, nor does it filter the image according to its perceptions or preferences. Authentic mirroring can only call forth what is already there. . .the Christ mirror [by contrast] fully knows and loves us from all eternity." Realistically then my question should be, "do I see an image of myself (and others) distorted by my mind, or do I view the world through the Christ mirror? Am I willing to reflect Christ in my daily work and leisure time, to family and co-workers, to strangers, through social media posts, in my thoughts, words, and actions? Do I share God's love as perfect and total gift, a love which I can do nothing to either increase or decrease? Do I accept that I cannot decide who has or does not have God's love? In 1 John 3:1-2, we read, "You must see what great love the Father has lavished on us by letting us be called God's children. . .we are already God's children but what we shall be . . .has not yet been revealed." I feel God's love yet I do not always see that love reflected when I look at my mirror image. I am called, however, to reflect not only the person God created, without concern of my mirror image, but also to reflect Christ's love through my life without concern of what is yet to be. I, therefore, ask you my brothers and sisters to walk with me in God's *agape*.

## Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary September 8



The Church has celebrated Mary's birth since at least the sixth century. A September birth was chosen because the Eastern Church begins its Church year with September. The September 8 date helped determine the date for the feast of the Immaculate Conception on December 8.

Scripture does not give an account of Mary's birth. However, the apocryphal Protoevangelium of James fills in the gap. This work has no historical value, but it does reflect the development of Christian piety. According to this account, Anna and Joachim are infertile but pray for a child. They receive the promise of a child who will advance God's plan of salvation for the world. Such a story, like many biblical counterparts, stresses the special presence of God in Mary's life from the beginning.

Saint Augustine connects Mary's birth with Jesus' saving work. He tells the earth to rejoice and shine forth in the light of her birth. "She is the flower of the field from whom bloomed the precious lily of the valley. Through her birth the nature inherited from our first parents is changed." The opening prayer at Mass speaks of the birth of Mary's Son as the dawn of our salvation, and asks for an increase of peace.

## Celebrating The 100th Anniversary Of The Founding of the Legion of Mary September 7, 1921 - September 7, 2021



The Legion of Mary is an international association of members of the Roman Catholic Church who serve it on a voluntary basis. It was founded by Frank Duff on September 7, 1921 at Myra House, Francis Street, in Dublin, Ireland. His idea was to help Catholic lay people fulfill their baptismal promises to be able to live their dedication to the Church in an organized structure, which would be supported by fraternity and prayer.

The spirituality of the Legion of Mary is essentially based on the approach of Louis de Montfort, as put forward in his *True Devotion to Mary*. The book promotes a "total dedication" to Christ through devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary, which later influenced popes such as John Paul II, who mentions it in an apostolic letter, *Rosarium Virginis Mariae*.

Today, active and auxiliary (praying) members make up a total of over 10 million members worldwide, making it the largest apostolic organization of lay people in the Catholic Church.

Membership is open to those who belong to the Catholic Church and believe in its teaching. Its stated mission is for active members to serve God under the banner of Mary by the corporal and spiritual works of Mercy.

The main apostolate of the Legion is activities directed towards Catholics and non-Catholics encouraging them in their faith or inviting them to become Catholic. This is usually done by encouraging them in prayer, attending Mass and learning more about the Catholic faith. The members of the Legion are engaged primarily in the performance of spiritual works of mercy, rather than works of material aid.

The Legion first started out by visiting women with cancer in hospitals, but it soon became active among the most destitute, notably among Dublin prostitutes. Duff subsequently laid down the system of the Legion in the Handbook of the Legion of Mary in 1928.

The Legion soon spread around the world. At first, it was often met with mistrust because of its then unusual dedication to lay apostolate. After Pope Pius XI praised it in 1931, the Legion had its mistrust quelled.

On March 27, 2014, the Secretary of the Pontifical Council for the Laity, Bishop Josef Clemens, delivered the decree in which the Legion is recognized by the Holy See as International Association of the Faithful.

The basic unit of the Legion is called a Praesidium, which is normally based in a parish. The Praesidium, usually a group of 3–20 members, meets weekly in its parish.

The Chaplet of Divine Mercy is recited at 6:20am.

The Legion of Mary provides a way for Catholics to live out the Marian Devotion in a lay apostolate.
