## From the Pastor's Pen

This weekend I will be in Berlin, Germany. We celebrated the funeral Mass for my brother-in-law, Gianni VanDaalen, this past Friday. He was a native of Germany and was the manager of upper-class hotels in several large cities in Europe. Sadly, he was a victim of cancer at the age of 75. Though debilitated, he and my sister, Marylea, were at our annual family gathering in Nebraska City the first weekend of May. Thank you for your prayers and support.

In the gospel reading assigned for this weekend, Jesus poses the question to the apostles: "Who do people say that I am?" After the apostles report the words spoken about Jesus by different people, Jesus asks them: "But who do you say that I am?" It is Peter who gives that all-important answer: "You are the Christ, the Son of the Living God." But the question really is meant for every disciple of every age: "Who do you say that I am?"

Each one of us may ponder the question: "Why do I follow Jesus?" For some people, it may be a matter of the handing on of the faith. "My grandparents followed Jesus. My parents followed Jesus. So it is the way that I know: I follow Jesus." For other people, following Jesus is the result of deep study. They may read books on comparative religions. They may do a deep study of the Bible, searching the Hebrew Scripture for the background, especially the coming of the Messiah, and also the New Testament, doing a deep analysis of the gospel message. Still others may come to follow Jesus because of the faith of a spouse, friends, or other witnesses. However, it is one thing to say: "I follow Jesus," but quite another to act on His word and be truly committed by actions and lifestyle. True, given the weakness of human nature, none of us will ever be a perfect disciple. There will always be compromises, flaws, failures, disappointments. But the challenge of Jesus is to occasionally ask that question to ourselves: why do I follow Jesus? Do I take my discipleship for granted, just going through the motions? Or do I have that desire to make my commitment strong and genuine? Yes, it is easy just to go through the daily routine, focusing on all the activities that require time and attention. And yet our following of Jesus, our discipleship, should be a priority. Today we ask for that grace to be fully committed to this work of following Jesus, wholeheartedly and lovingly.

Please know that my prayers are with you each day.

## Someone is Watching and Wondering



Anyone who has interactions with me will confirm that I have a rather strong personality and am not afraid to express my understandings or opinions, especially regarding those matters which are important to me (such as my faith) and for which I am passionate. Given this reality, however, I find myself constantly battling

against my ego and my **NEED TO BE RIGHT**. This need to be right, unfortunately, draws us apart and is rooted in pride.

Recently I found the above inspirational picture/quote. Seeing it I had the strongest feeling that God was sending the message directly to me. Letting go of my need to be right is a daunting task. When I am "right" I have a sense of power over the less informed and a desire to have my own way. I do not believe, however, that being right is one of Jesus' teachings or commandments as to how his followers should live. Conversely, accepting that another individual has an understanding different from mine or a different vision of rightness does not mean that I simply acquiesce to their views. Rather such differences leads me to seek God's guidance and opens the door for listening and conversation. Open dialogue may subsequently lead to a more inclusive consideration of facts, understandings, and interpretations. Greater inclusivity, in turn, can lead to consensus, empathy, and service to one another. I know that I do not have answers to every question. I do not always have sufficient knowledge or understanding on which to base a realistic, inclusive opinion. In short, **I AM NOT ALWAYS RIGHT**. Yes, there are times when this statement is difficult for me to accept and follow. If, however, I am to live the message of Jesus, to love and serve others, I must put my ego at ease, and truly listen to different opinions, ideas, understandings, while also recognizing the background and feelings of the other individual(s). God did not send me forth to dominate and control. God did not put me on an intellectual or all-knowing plateau above others; God sent me forth to use my talents to share God's love.

Over the years I have come to accept that one of the talents God gave me was the ability to teach and share my gift of knowledge in such a way that encourages others to embrace the goodness of their being and their own ability to discern how to use their own specific gifts and talents. I believe God graces each of us with particular gifts for encountering, loving, and serving. Discerning our gifts, how to use them, and how to let go of the need for power, for always being right requires seeking God's presence, trusting in God's guidance, and placing the needs of others before my own. One thing which seems to help me is what may be called Centering Prayer. Simply stated this is a devotional practice of placing myself in God's presence, quieting my mind and heart, surrendering to God's loving embrace. The basis for centering prayer is found in *kenosis*, Jesus' self-emptying love, which is rooted in his self-understanding and life practice. In the gospels, Jesus invites us on the same journey, serving as our model, consistently reminding us to let go, don't worry, don't hang on to what is not important. Humility is concerned with what is right not who is right. Be assured, **GOD IS RIGHT ALWAYS/ALL WAYS**.

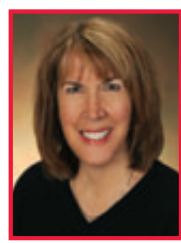
