You've been hearing about blood shortages for months, and the CBC is currently down to less than a 3-day supply of blood products. This shortage represents a dire need for your help. If you're a regular donor, thank you for your continued support and please reach out to others to donate too. If you've never donated before, now is the time! Take a friend or family member with you for support, or to double your efforts.

Donating blood takes less than an hour and is relatively easy and painless. Drink plenty of water two days before the drive, eat a good supper the night before and don't skip breakfast the day of your appointment. ## Someone is Watching and Wondering



Before you read this article get a sheet of paper and a pencil or pen and take some time to: 1. in your own words define community, 2. list the communities to which you belong, 3.

name specific members of the communities you listed, being sure to list yourself, and describe each individual's role or function, and 4. give each community a number, ranking its importance or significance in your life. (You may wish to refer to this list after you finish reading my thoughts and during your prayer time this week, adding to it or reconsidering your ordering of significance.) Once you develop your initial list here are a few thoughts you may wish to consider before altering the list.

As human beings we share a basic need to form and embrace communities. I believe that during the lock-down of 2020 many of us realized the significance of community and felt some degree of loss as we lived in isolation. Without gatherings of family and friends, conducting business and schooling over the internet and through ZOOM meetings, even ordering groceries and having them delivered to our homes was stressful and less than satisfying to our basic need to gather in person. Yet, perhaps as you peruse the list I suggested you develop, you feel frustrated at the state of your communities. If you listed family as a community perhaps you are concerned that family relationships are less than desirable and fulfilling. Maybe you listed a business or civic community; does it meet your expectations? If you listed a religious community, such as our parish, does it meet your spiritual needs? Do you expend energy complaining about the lack of intimacy, involvement, or sharing of responsibilities within your communities? My suspicion is our concerns/complaints are similar.

Now consider Christ's description of community: an apostolic community, sharing life in the Holy Spirit. A Christian community is not based in mutual compatibility of like-minded individuals gathering because they like one another. It is not huddling together in fear or loneliness, nor is it people rallying around a common task, cause, passion or ideal. A Christian community does not require sharing blood lines, a common roof, or a mutual physical or psychological attraction. Although each of these traits may be desirable, a Christian community is defined as gathering around the person of Christ, replacing our selfishness with charity, hope, peace, patience, goodness, faith, constancy, mildness, chastity, and perhaps suffering which makes possible living with others, embracing God's love that surpasses differences, fears, and incompatibilities. Dare I say, Christian community means staying together even when we do not like each other and we struggle with differences. Jesus told his disciples, people will know you are my disciple (a member of my community) by your love. Of course the word that describes this basic concept of love is *agape*; love which is perfect self gift directed toward the other. There is no place in a Christian community for over inflated egos, personal satisfaction when others give into my wants, demands or desires, and certainly no place for pushing a personal agenda reflected in the attitude "My way or the highway." For me, the bigger question is how do I bring this understanding of Christian Community into my daily life and relationships; how do I reflect Christ's love; Are my actions true and faithful to Christ's community? Do I share that I have given my life to Him, without speaking the words, "I am a Christian."




