From the Pastor's Pen

When I was in Berlin for my brother-in-law's funeral Mass, I stayed in an apartment across from the sister's place. I enjoyed walking for blocks in different directions in the neighborhood. It was a great opportunity to observe the lifestyle of the people there. Even though the people live in a cultural lifestyle similar to ours, still there are differences. And, of course, there are differences in the lifestyles of people within our Western culture.

In the area where I was staying, all the dwelling places were six-story apartment buildings with shops on the street level. It appeared that anything a person needed could be found in the neighborhood. There were lots of people on bicycles and scooters. It appeared that the people were upper middle class. The restaurants seemed to be full in the evenings. There was an atmosphere of prosperity. There was a Catholic Church, St. Ludwig's, just a couple of blocks from where I was staying. At the Sunday 12:00 Mass which I attended, most of the folks were older. No children were there. It felt like a very secular atmosphere. There certainly didn't seem to be a religious spirit pervading among the people. The majority of Christians in the north of Germany are Protestant, with Catholics being more in the majority in the South.

But my experience there made me wonder: what is the future for religion, at least in the areas that I saw. What is the future for the Catholic Church? Is the faith being passed on? I did observe that there was a Catholic school associated with St. Ludwig's and perhaps neighboring parishes. But will these young people have a spirit of faith and devotion when they grow up and have their own families? Will the faith survive? Perhaps this is being negative, but some of these questions could be posed about our Catholic future in our own country.

The challenge is there. People are very much influenced by secular ways and values. Though these are not all bad, still our faith assumes values and lifestyles that are different from and can oppose totally secular ways. That's the challenge for all of us: to live in this culture with these ways of thinking and acting, but still to be strong in living the values of the gospel. May we never abandon and may we pass on the rich traditions and teachings of our faith



Someone is Watching and Wondering

I may seem presumptuous in asking the following ques-
tion: "When have you lost faith?" Perhaps this question
makes you uncomfortable because you feel strongly rooted
in your faith and believe practicing the faith has always
been enough and central in your life. If this is the case then
perhaps you are more comfortable with this question: "When
has your faith been challenged?" At least for me, I can hon-
estly state: "Although I have never surrendered my belief in
the existence of God, there have been more times than I
wish to admit when I felt God was on sabbatical leave, dis-
tant from my life; I felt lost, confused, and alone. At such
times I struggled to find meaning in my life and with my faith.
Conversely at the same time I felt a strong desire for God's
presence and love. Subsequently I believe these feelings of
doubt and fear, longings, and searching, have strengthened
my faith and increased by ability to trust in God's love and
mercy. This strength helps me move out of the quagmire I
created within my life.

Strangely, I find images of myself and my doubts in scrip-
ture. A profound example is Matthew 14:22-33 and illus-
trated so beautifully in this picture. The story begins with the
disciples, alone in a boat, when they are caught in a great
storm on the Sea of Galilee. Watching in fear, the disciples
see a figure walking across the
sea towards their boat. Peter's
response is also a test: "Lord, **if it
is you**, command me to come to
you on the water." Jesus' simple
reply is "Come." Initially Peter be-
gins the journey walking in faith,
with his eyes on Jesus. However,
as we know all too well, Peter's fear gets the best of him;
looking away toward the wind and turbulence of the water,
Peter's faith falters and he begins to sink. Unabashed,
Jesus, once again reaches for Peter but also rebukes Peter
saying: "O you of little faith, why did you doubt?"



As I reread this story in Matthew I am forced to confront my
own fears and reflect on Jesus' words: "why do you (Sandy
G.) doubt." Honestly, I wish I possessed a simple answer but
I do not. What I know to be truth, however, is that when I
face fear, self doubt, confusion, and feelings of uncertainty
best expressed by "What can I do?", it is those times I des-
perately need Jesus. It is those times when my faith falters
that I need to refocus and allow Jesus to be my guide and
my strength. It is those times when I realize how weak I am,
unable to confront, let alone deal with and solve my fears
and problems that I need his hand. Only with Jesus in the
lead, do I find hope, peace, and joy within myself. Only with
Jesus do I move from sadness and sorrow into the light.
Only with Jesus are the clouds lifted and the storm within me
calmed. Only with Jesus do I return to the refreshing waters
of renewal. Only with Jesus is my faith strengthened. I sim-
ply cannot move from fear to hope, doubt to focus and di-
rection, weakness to strength, or from feelings of being lost
and alone to recognizing great love and mercy without him.
Jesus continues to reach out, no matter how much I resist,
he never abandoners me, He simply says: "Come, follow
me!" Jesus is always within reach; take his hand.







Operating Income \$3,495,128




Operating Expense \$3,064,472




2021-22 Budget Operating Income and Expense For the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2022

The Parish Finance Council functions as an advisor to our pastor, Father Mike. On behalf of Fr. Mike, the staff and the Finance Council we would like to say Thank You for your faithfulness to our parish family. Despite the very challenging year we have had, you continued to support our parish and our efforts to put action to the Corporal Works of Mercy. It was a wonderful year despite the obstacles we have dealt with and that continue to challenge us. We are very proud of the fiscal responsibility we have established as a parish, and we thank you for your commitment to keeping us on this path.

The new church mortgage is not included in the above operating results, because those funds are treated as capital funds and held in reserve accounts that are segregated from the operating accounts. Nonetheless, the capital funds and related mortgage for the new church represent significant elements of our overall financial operation. Key elements of the new church capital accounts are summarized below:

Loan balance on July 1, 2020	\$4,207,642.05
Loan Principal paid in the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021	\$1,451,491.01
Loan balance as of June 30, 2021	\$2,756,151.04



The Advent Giving Tree is coming!!!




We are happy to announce we will be kicking off the Advent Giving Tree, a well-loved St. James Parish ministry, the last weekend in October.
