Someone is Watching and Wondering



How many times have I prayed for guidance, asking the Lord to lead me and help me choose the right path or make the correct decision? How many times have I echoed the words of Eli to Samuel: "Speak Lord for your servant

is listening" (1 Samuel 3:9) but instead of listening with my heart allowed my mind to continue trying to figure everything out for myself. How many times have I uttered the words, "Lord not my will but yours?" The Psalmist writes: "Happy those who trust in the Lord. . . Here I am" (Psalm 40: 5, 8) yet I am forced to ask myself, "Where is that trust in my life; am I truly happy?"

There are so many examples in scripture which illustrate individuals who trusted in the Lord and opened themselves to the will of God. There are, however, also many examples of individuals who continued to act in ways which they thought would satisfy their own ego, greed, pride, or selfish desires. While immediate desires appeared to be met, long term fulfillment and peace seemed lost without God's presence. I know this has been true in my life. When I tried to satisfy my own selfish desires, acting with the thought that I knew what was best for myself, my actions met with failure or feelings of remorse and guilt. Yet, letting go and trusting that God "knows best" is difficult for me as I was raised with the idea that hard work would lead to success. And fulfillment. Perhaps this idea was also part of your life experience. The question for me now seems to be, "How do I trust God?" Do I believe my words, "Here I am Lord, I desire to do your will?" While the answer may be obvious, listening to and following God may not be easy.

As I continue to search for answers there is one path I feel confident to follow. While I feel blessed in so many ways, I also believe God has graced me with unique talents and abilities which I am called to embrace and use not only for myself but especially for others. At times I feel called to use my intellect for solving problems or explaining different concepts. At times I feel called to draw on past experiences to help another person navigate through a difficult situation and began the healing process. At times I am called to simply listen with compassion and empathy, allowing God to give guidance and healing. I must confess, however, what is most difficult for me is to be patient, letting God move me in the direction of understanding and love, trusting in God's time and God's ways. Especially at this time in my life, I want to fix things, yet I must ask myself, "Whose will am I following, God's or your own?" Have a blessed week and allow God's love to flow through you.
