Someone is Watching and Wondering



Over the past several years the terms fake news, misinformation, and hoax, have been repeated over and over, yet I wonder how I respond and deceive myself? Who

am I listening to; who do I follow; who influences my decision making; how am I deceived by those outer voices continually bombarding my senses?

Recently I reread *A New Look at Prayer – Searching for Bliss* by Bill Huebsch. One of the chapters is titled "The Outer Voices." I thought how interesting that a book on prayer would address outer voices when for me prayer is listening to the inner voice of God. In this chapter, Huebsch describes God creating humankind to live in paradise – in harmony, peace, mutuality, and with the energy of love, a balance between light and dark, male and female, life forms and the inanimate environment; human beings who are filled with imagination and awe. God brought life to humans through the Holy Spirit, gifting us with an inner voice, God's voice and word. (Gen:1-2). Yet we humans, not believing in our innate goodness chose to listen to and believe the promises of outer voices, no longer trusting the inner voice of truth and love. (Gen:3). The outer voice promised a false paradise and listening to that voice humanity first experienced shame, guilt, fear, anger, and darkness, succumbing to deception and blaming "the other" for bad choices. (You may also read Mark 4:1-20 where Jesus speaks of listening and responding to God's word.)

Rereading the above passages brought memories of the many ways I have been enticed to follow outer voices. Voices which offered what appeared to be a path toward fulfillment and happiness. Unfortunately I discovered the opposite. Poor decisions left feelings of darkness, shame, guilt, regret, anger, and a sense of loss. Looking at our modern culture it is easy to recognize many outer voices that try to lead me away from truth and light, from my inner voice, God's spirit. For example: money and wealth, advertising, social media, nationalism, partisanship, and yes, even religion may be deceitful. Voices which lead me away from God's truth, harmony, peace, mutuality, balance, and love should be a warning of deception, lies, sinful attitudes and behavior. For instance a beneficial ad may help me find an individual providing a needed service such as a plumber, electrician, mechanic, or HVAC professional. Conversely, there are also ads promising a youthful appearance, better social life, or massive wealth. As I age I know I can still live a rich, active, fulfilling life, but a youthful appearance is unrealistic at best, and suggests that natural aging is unnatural and undesirable. Trusting God, I know I am accepted and loved regardless of my physical appearance. I think God asks for my heart not for an ageless face. Remember the story of the "rich man" in the gospel who asks Jesus what he must do to have eternal life. Jesus tells him that following the law is good, but listening to the outer voice of money and wealth is deceitful. What voices do you hear and follow?

St. Mary's Food Kitchen Ministry Needs Help

After 32 years, Don Ollier is scaling back his involvement at the St. Mary's Food Kitchen. As the leader of this ministry, Don has been the mainstay of ensuring that the thousands of meals that St. James provides and serves are "ready to serve" on the Fourth Sunday of every month.

At St. James we feel that it is imperative to continue our presence at St. Mary's Food Kitchen and the Parish Council has been working on a plan to ensure that this tradition can be continued into the future.

Many tasks are required to serve this meal every month. These include menu planning, food inventory, meal preparation and transportation to the food kitchen.

All of the aforementioned tasks have been filled except for one – **FOOD PREPARATION** – and this is where we need the help of our parishioners.

We are looking for parishioners to "step up to the plate" and serve on a Cooking Team.

Job Description:

- Prepare the main entree for up to 200 people.
- This meal should be prepared in the St. James School Kitchen ensuring that all safety standards are met. The parish will pay for at least

one person on the team to attend food health safety classes, if needed.

- The school kitchen must be scheduled but usually is open Friday evening through Saturday evening.
- The meal must be prepared by 9:00am on the Fourth Sunday of the Month.

Supplies Available:

- The menu will be known at least one week beforehand. We hope to rotate the menu through nine choices.
- The ingredients will be available, either in the school kitchen or other designated areas.
- The ministry has its own serving pans. The cooked entrees are to be stored in the school kitchen refrigerator in those pans. Others will pick and deliver to the food kitchen on the fourth Sunday of the month.

We are trying to put together at least three teams of cooks. If we achieve this then every team would only cook once per calendar quarter. By having nine menu choices we would ask each team to master 3 recipes each which they would then rotate.

Cooking teams can be made up of a family or a group of people who are willing to serve on a team.
