## Someone is Watching and Wondering



Last week I reflected on a portion of my personal story and journey toward a richer, fuller life in Christ. Answering the question "Who I am?" has been both a struggle of letting go and trusting God as well as a blessing of ongoing discovery. Last week I also referred to the concept of *ubuntu* which describes how each of us are formed in relationship to one another.

As part of my personal faith journey I read many spiritual writings from different traditions. In his work *No Future Without Forgiveness*, Desmond Tutu wrote: "A person with *ubuntu* is open and available to others, affirming of others, does not feel threatened that others are able and good, for he or she has a proper self-assurance that comes from knowing that he or she belongs in a greater whole and is diminished when others are humiliated or diminished." His granddaughter, referring to her grandfather's belief, stated that "*ubuntu* is a way of life. . .[a] philosophy [that encompasses] all aspirations about how to live life well, together." In my thinking, this concept seems to follow Jesus' teachings of loving service to one another, pure self gift. We are greater working together, than separate. Failing to treat other humans with dignity, respect, striving to share God's grace and mercy seems the very root of Christianity.

As I further reflected on these concepts, I thought of the word "mindfulness." To be mindful is to be aware of who I am, which as I mentioned is a life-long journey of discovery, but also requires that I am present in the moment (the present which has not occurred before and will not happen again)—*carpe diem*—embrace this moment with gratitude and love. While mindfulness leads me to self-knowledge, it also requires that I accept who you are and how we are related in time and space. To understand our relatedness I must listen to your story with patience, aware of the trust placed to honor your confidentiality. Providing a safe place to share feelings, fears, aspirations, sorrows, and uncertainty also opens the door for greater understanding, respect, and acceptance of our commonalities and interrelatedness; a discovery of our *ubuntu*. As I have stated so many times, we are **ALL** created in the image and likeness of God and are **ALL** God's beloved sons and daughters. If I believe this truth of our shared faith, then I must strive to live in peace and harmony with **ALL** my brothers and sisters. I believe God provides these encounters as part of my formation. I feel the need to recognize and accept that I cannot pray for the good of only those like me, but as Jesus commanded I must also pray for those whom I do not understand or recognize as my brother or sister.
