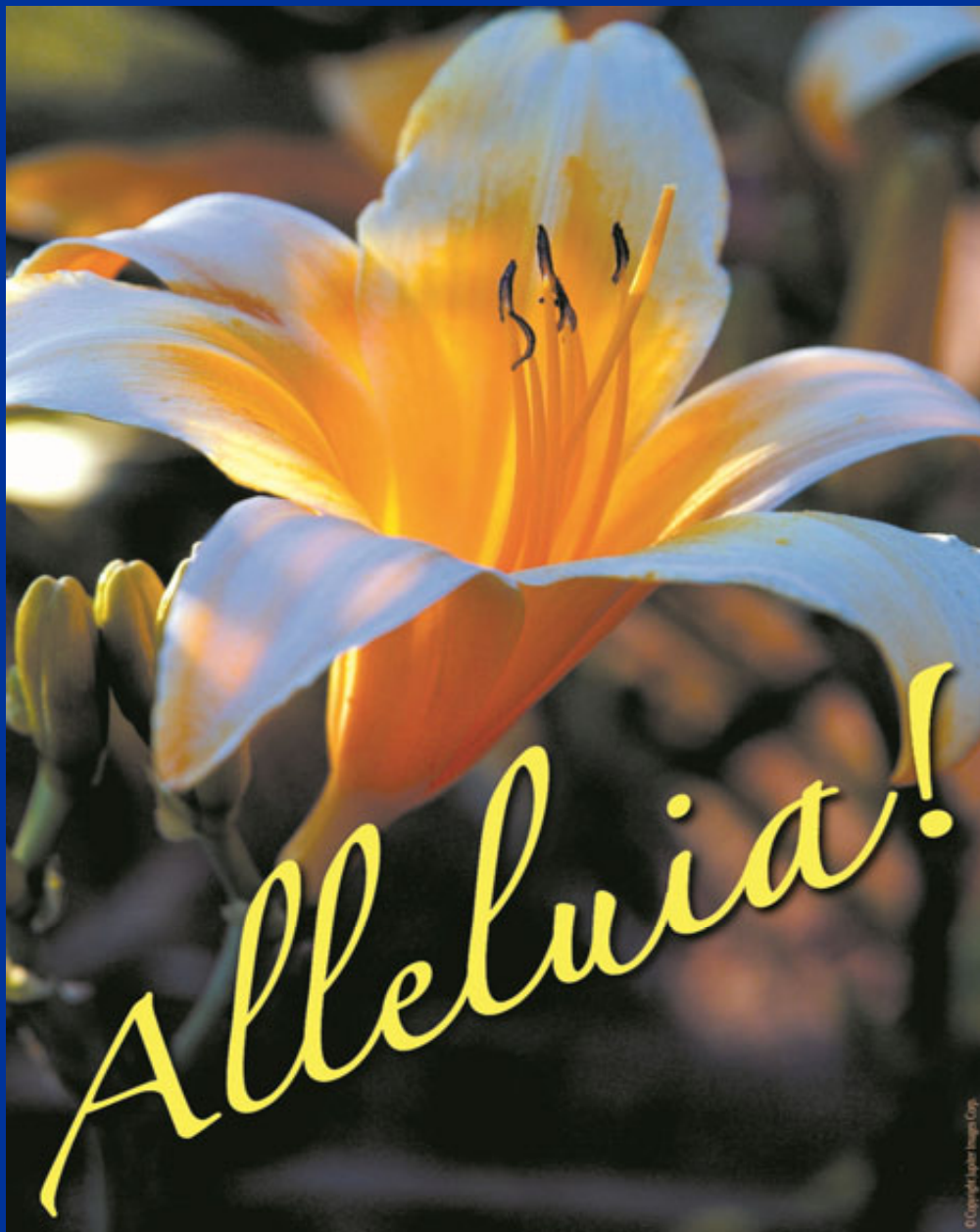

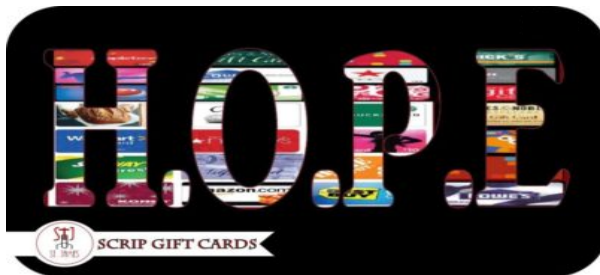

Someone is Watching and Wondering



What does the empty tomb mean? I ask for your indulgence as I try to answer this question on a personal level.

The empty tomb changes everything for me: darkness gives rise to light; dread turns to hope; death is conquered by life; hate is overcome by love. All meaning for my life is rooted in the fullness of the incarnation (including human doubt, suffering, and death), which finds fulfillment in the resurrection of Christ Jesus. The emptiness of the tomb signifies God's mercy, love, and omnipresence in all creation, but especially for and in our humanity. There is hope in the emptiness which leads me to trust and surrender to the will of God as I am guided by the light God's love.

I find comfort in the empty tomb and in these words: "If there is any encouragement in Christ, any solace in love, any participation in the Spirit, any compassion and mercy, complete my joy by being of the same mind, with the same love, united in heart, thinking one thing. Do nothing out of selfishness or out of vainglory; rather, humbly regard others as more important than yourselves, each looking out **NOT** for his own interests, but [also] everyone for those of others. Have among yourselves the same attitude that is also yours in Christ Jesus, who, though he was in the form of God, did not regard equality with God something to be grasped, rather, he emptied himself, taking the form of a slave, coming in human likeness, and found human in appearance, he humbled himself, becoming obedient to death, even death on a cross" (Philippians 2:1-8). For me the joy and hope of the empty tomb is embracing the reality and fullness of my humanness embraced by Jesus. The empty tomb gives me courage to live each day in gratitude for God's gifts of life, mercy, compassion, love, and forgiveness. The empty tomb moves me toward the light of Christ Jesus, knowing that the Holy Spirit will guide me in a life of service, not out of any misconceived expectation that I can earn a "gold star" on my way to eternal union with God in heaven, but rather a belief that I am called to "do nothing out of selfishness or out of vainglory" but rather serving as a result of my love of God. The empty tomb is the fulfillment of God's promise of salvation for those who love one another. Although we may feel surrounded by anger, hatred, condemnation, and bitter disagreements, seeking the truth of the empty tomb I have found God's sacrifice of love and mercy that I may give to others.

A Special Promise of Mercy

Our Lord's promise to grant complete forgiveness of sins and punishment on the Feast of Mercy is recorded three times in the *Diary of St. Faustina*:

I want to grant a complete pardon to the souls that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion on the Feast of My mercy (*Diary 1109*).

Whoever approaches the Fountain of Life on this day will be granted complete forgiveness of sins and punishment (*Diary 300*).

The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion will obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment (*Diary 699*).

It's allowed for one to go to confession up to 20 days before or after Divine Mercy Sunday
