Roses for Mother's Day



Once again, we will be doing the Roses for Mother's Day project to honor all Mothers, Grandmothers, and/or Mom figures, living or deceased, on Mother's Day, May 8.

Envelopes for your donations and to list the names of those you wish to honor can be found in your packets and on a table in the Gathering Place. They can be placed in the collection basket or in a designated box in the Gathering Place now thru May 1.

On Mother's Day, beautiful arrangements of roses and a scroll listing all names will be displayed around the altar. However, this year, there is a change. Because of virus restrictions, roses cannot be taken from the altar by individuals after the Mother's Day services.

Proceeds from the project are used to maintain the Prayer Garden and other church campus landscaping.

From the Pastor's Pen

I am somewhat suspicious of "visions." People claim to hear voices or see images that may be the result of some kind of mental issue. But I don't want to dismiss visions entirely because the Scripture mentions people who have had such experiences. Some of the saints of the church claim to have had visions. One of these is St. Maria Faustina Kowalska.

Helena Kowalska was born in Poland in 1905, the third of 10 children. In 1924 she experienced her first vision of Jesus, asking that she join a convent. Obedient to the message, she joined the Congregation of the Sisters of Mercy and received the habit, taking the name "Mary Faustina." In 1931 she had another vision from Jesus, presenting Himself as "King of Divine Mercy." She was asked to be an apostle and model of divine mercy. A pattern was given to her as to how the image of divine mercy was to be displayed: Jesus in a white garment with red and white rays coming from His heart with the words "Jesus, I trust in you." In another visit, Jesus asked that this image of divine mercy be publicly honored. St. Faustina died in 1938 and was canonized as a saint in 2000 by Pope John Paul II. He declared that the Second Sunday of Easter should be observed throughout the Church as "Divine Mercy Sunday."

Of course the message of divine mercy is not something new. Jesus himself was a man of mercy, showed mercy, proclaimed mercy, and entrusted the Church with the message of mercy. Mercy is not only a matter of mind and heart but is a virtue that should shine forth in the lives of all disciples of Jesus.

Sometimes it is very difficult for us to practice mercy, especially mercy toward people who have committed horrible crimes. Mercy doesn't seem to be an attribute of our human nature, but rather a spiritual gift that comes to those with true faith and an open heart. When we say, "Jesus, I trust in you," we have confidence that His words of forgiveness apply to each of us and a gift he gives to us so that we may also practice the virtue of mercy. On this Divine Mercy Sunday, we ask that the Church may be an instrument of God's mercy, and that we ourselves be models of mercy for one another.

May this season of Easter continue to bring blessings to the Church and to each one of us.

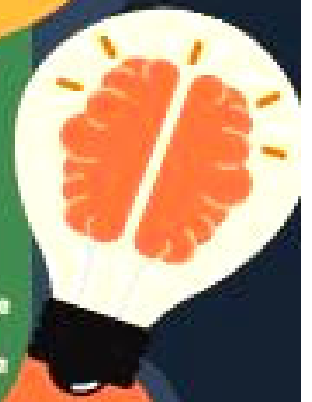
