From the Pastor's Pen

Anyone who reads the history of the Catholic Church is well aware that for the Church there are times of lightness but also of darkness, time of success but also of failure. The Church is not perfect; no church is perfect. Church members are human, subject always to weaknesses and failures. We are alarmed today because of abuse scandals by priests and religious and by people leaving the Church family. Still we trust that the Holy Spirit guides the Church and the Lord Jesus will always be with us.

Historically, one of the issues that has been a problem down through the ages has been the role of leadership and decision-making in the Church. Where does the authority lie? Is it primarily with the Pope and advisors in the offices in Rome (called the "Curia")? Is it from top to bottom? Or should leadership include a broader vision, especially including input from the Bishops and the dioceses throughout the world? In practice, often the Pope and Curial officials have been reluctant to share decision making with the college of Bishops. The challenge has come out of the documents of the Second Vatican Council, especially the Document on the Church. How can the spirit of these documents be implemented and affect the practices of the world-wide Church?

On March 19, Pope Francis promulgated a new "Apostolic Constitution on the Roman Curia." The Constitution is not just the Pope's personal opinion but the result of a great deal of consultation over several years. It will go into effect on June 5. Underlying the spirit of this document is the teachings of Vatican II. The emphasis is on evangelization. Every baptized Christian is called to be a missionary disciple. It's not the work of a select Curial officials but every disciple can be and should be involved in the roles of government and service. Not just bishops and priests are called to serve in Church offices, including the Curia in Rome. Another item in the Constitution is that there are to be term limits, so that officials cannot become entrenched in these offices. The point is that Church leadership is not about power and prestige, but about service and ministry. So it is with all Church organizations and parishes.

My prayers are with you each day.

Someone is Watching and Wondering



May is the month of graduations which are understood as a time of transition, for new beginnings. We face many transitions in life, yet one important transition is often overlooked, childhood to adulthood.

We accept puberty as a sign of this transition, but have few celebrations. Thinking of this transition, I would like to share two poems, which my mother shared with me: “If” by Rudyard Kipling and “If for Girls” by J. P. Mc Envoy.

“If” – If you can keep your head when all about you are losing theirs and blaming it on you; If you can trust yourself when all men doubt you, but make allowance for their doubting too; If you can wait and not be tired by waiting, or, being lied about, don't deal in lies, or, being hated, don't give way to hating, and yet don't look too good, nor talk too wise; If you can dream – and not make dreams your master; If you can think – and not make thoughts your aim; If you can meet with triumph and disaster, and treat those two impostors just the same; If you can bear to hear the truth you've spoken, twisted by knaves to make a trap for fools, or watch the things you gave your life to broken, and stoop and build 'em up with worn out tools; If you can make one heap of all your winnings and risk it on one turn of pitch-and-toss, and lose, and start again at your beginnings, and never breathe a word about your loss; If you can force your heart and nerve and sinew to serve your turn long after they are gone, and so hold on when there is nothing in you except the Will which says to them: “Hold on”; If you can talk with crowds and keep your virtue, or walk with kings – nor lose the common touch; If neither foes nor loving friends can hurt you; If all men count with you, but none too much; If you can fill the unforgiving minute with sixty seconds' worth of distance run – Yours is the Earth and everything that's in it, And – which is more – you'll be a Man, my son!

“If For Girls” – If you can hear the whispering about you and never yield to deal in whispers, too; If you can bravely smile when loved ones doubt you, and never doubt, in turn, what loved ones do; If you can keep a sweet and gentle spirit in spite of fame or fortune, rank or place, and though you win your goal or only near it can win with poise or lose with equal grace; If you can meet with unbelief, believing, and hallow in your heart a simple Creed, If you can meet Deception, undecieving, and learn to look to God for all you need; If you can be what girls should be to mothers: Chums in joy and comrades in distress; and be unto others as you'd have the others be unto you – no more and no less; If you can keep within your heart the power to say that firm, unconquerable “No”; If you can brave a present shadowed hour rather than yield, to build a future woe; If you can love, yet not let loving master, but keep yourself within your own self's clasp, and not let dreaming lead you to disaster, nor pity's fascination loose your grasp; If you can lock your heart on confidences nor ever needlessly in your turn confide; If you can put behind you all pretenses of mock humility or foolish pride; If you can keep the simple homely virtue of walking right with God - then have no fear that anything in all the world can hurt you and – which is more –You'll be a Woman, dear.

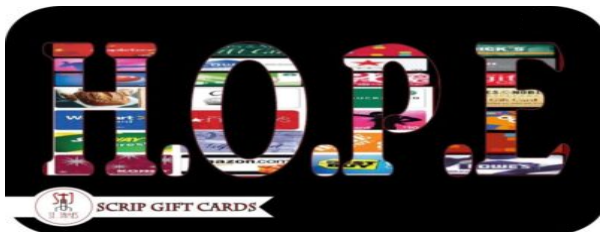
