Someone is Watching and Wondering



COMING SOON! "Sharing His Love With One Another"

I am happy to offer a time of fellowship and sharing with any adults who wish to enrich their faith and understanding of God's infinite love and mercy, and how we are each individually called to share God's gifts through our daily lives. This is not a scripture/bible study, per se, although the roots of sharing will be lectionary based, looking toward each Sunday's readings. It will not be a historical presentation of our Judeo-Christian beliefs, although looking at first century understandings and traditions will provide a foundation to understanding our twenty-first century life as Catholics. This will not be a re-examination of the history of our church, although an understanding of church teachings is essential for bridging the gap between a holistic view of our world and culture through the eyes of faith, and the tensions we face in a divisive/derisive world.

As a child in Sunday School I memorized many Bible verses. One of my favorites was: "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten son. . ." (John 3:16). As an adult, many years later I find myself more deeply drawn to this passage: "Jesus said to his disciples: 'As the Father loves me, so I also love you. Remain in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commandments and remain in His love. I have told you this so that my joy might be in you and your joy might be complete. This is my commandment: love one another as I love you. No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends. You are my friends if you do what I command you. I no longer call you slaves, because a slave does not know what his master is doing. I have called you friends, because I have told you everything I have heard from my Father. It was not you who chose me, but I who chose you and appointed you to go and bear fruit that will remain, so that whatever you ask the Father in my name he may give you. This I command you: love one another.'" (John 15:9-17) For me, surrendering to God's love, known so completely through the life, death, and resurrection of Christ Jesus, is the first step of faith. If receiving the Father's love is the first step of falling in love, it must be followed by the second step, giving that love away. My hope is that my new offering of life-long mystogogy, "**Sharing His Love With One Another**" will be an opportunity to enrich our understanding of Jesus words to love one another, through the sharing of our experiences, understandings, and relationship with Jesus as we walk together in faith.

I am planning on offering gathering times both during the afternoon and evening, on the 2nd and 4th Wednesday of each month. I would like to begin after Pentecost, with actual times and locations provided soon. I look forward to beginning this ministry of sharing with both old friends and new acquaintances. As this will be an on-going/year round ministry, some may wish to participate for a shorter time. That's okay. We will meet one another where we are as pilgrims on a journey of faith. 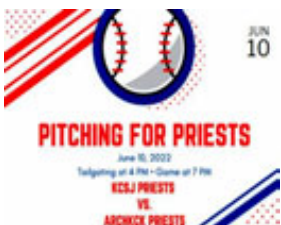
