Someone is Watching and Wondering



Although we at St. James have recently completed one yearly cycle of Christian Initiation, I would like to take this opportunity to remind you that at our parish, journeying with, preparing, and welcoming adults through the reception of the Sacraments of Initiation is an on-going, year-long ministry. As such I wish to invite anyone interested in becoming a Christian, practicing their Christianity in the Roman Catholic tradition, or assisting in this ministry contact me for information to begin the journey.

The Summer 2001 issue of *Lighting Light* focused on the catechumenate as "the model and inspiration for catechesis and faith formation." The catechumenate has also been acknowledged as a way to nurture (incorporate into a community of faith) individuals through ritual, symbol, and story; to challenge each member in terms of living a Christian life that gives witness to the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

I believe that formation in the faith is a lifelong process that affects both the community of faith and the individual. A focus on adult catechesis is essential to have parishes and faith communities that can pass the faith and its traditions to our future generations. The *catechumenate* and its accompanying rite are about transformation, formation, incorporation, and initiation. The experience clearly demonstrates the importance of a community of faith, sharing, the journey, and the strong relationship between catechesis and liturgy. The image of journey is very popular in spiritual writings and not confined to Christian or Catholic spirituality. Such a journey is gradual, lifelong, and filled with ups and downs, twists and turns. In the *Rite (Order) of Christian Initiation of Adults* it states, "The initiation of *catechumens* [and candidates] is a gradual process that takes place within the community of the faithful. By joining the *catechumens* [and candidates] on reflecting on the value of the paschal mystery and by renewing [our] own conversion, the faithful provide an example that will help the *catechumens* [and candidates] to [follow] the Holy Spirit more generously. The rite of initiation is suited to a spiritual journey of adults that varies according to the many forms of God's grace, the free cooperation of the individuals, the action of the Church, and the circumstances of time and place." Formation is not an educational program; it is rooted in the Pascal mystery. We, the Body of Christ, are not simply dispensers of information. We are disciples, witnesses to the gospel message of Christ Jesus in all dimensions of our lives. We are called to a deeper relationship with Jesus, to celebrate our faith communally, familiarly, at work, and within our society. Please contact me for more information regarding this ministry.

mercy, and how we are each individually called to share God's gifts through our daily lives.

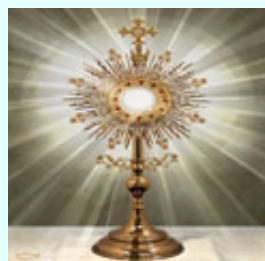

Trinity Sunday, officially called "The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity," is one of the few celebrations of the Christian Year that commemorates a reality and doctrine rather than a person or event. On Trinity Sunday, Christians remember and honor the eternal God: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

The Trinity is one of the most fascinating - and controversial - Christian teachings. The Trinity is described as a "mystery." By mystery the Church does not mean a riddle, but rather the Trinity is a reality above our human comprehension that we may begin to grasp, but ultimately must know through worship, symbol, and faith. It has been said that mystery is not a wall to run up against, but an ocean in which to swim.

Essentially the Trinity is the belief that God is one in essence (Greek *ousia*), but distinct in person (Greek *hypostasis*). The Greek word for person means "that which stands on its own," or "individual reality," and does not mean the persons of the Trinity are three human beings. Therefore Christians believe that the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit are somehow distinct from one another (not divided though), yet completely united in will and essence. How can this be?

Well, think of the sight of two eyes. The eyes are distinct, yet one and undivided in their sight. Another illustration to explain the Trinity is the musical chord. Think of a C-chord. The C, E, and G notes are all distinct notes, but joined together as one chord the sound is richer and more dynamic than had the notes been played individually. The chords are all equally important in producing the rich sound, and the sound is lacking and thin if one of the notes is left out.

Each person of the Trinity interpenetrates one another, and each has distinct roles in creation and redemption. For instance, God the Father created the world through the Son and the Holy Spirit hovered over the waters at creation. The Trinity is not pointless metaphysical speculation, but about the heart of our salvation.

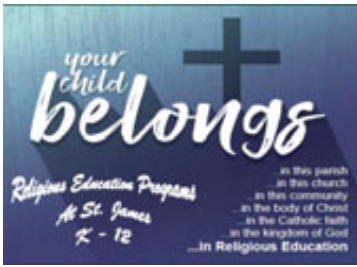
