Mission Statement

We, the community of St. James, are a prayerful and Eucharistic people who treasure our Catholic traditions.

We strive to grow in our faith by being good stewards of the gifts God has given us; sharing God's truth with all.

As the Body of Christ, we are called to love and serve everyone, especially the marginalized, with joy and hospitality.



In June of every year, we honor fathers. Mother's Day became an official U.S. holiday in 1914, but a holiday honoring fathers did not become official until 1966, when President Lyndon Johnson issued the first presidential proclamation honoring fathers, designating the third Sunday in June as Father's Day.

Six years later, the day was made a permanent national holiday when President Richard Nixon signed it into law in 1972. But this doesn't mean that the holiday was not celebrated before this time.

The idea for Father's Day is attributed to Sonora Dodd, who was raised by her father after her mother's death during childbirth. While listening to a sermon at church on Mother's Day, she thought about all her father had done for her and her siblings and decided fathers should have a day, too.

Because Dodd's father was born in June, she encouraged churches in her area, Spokane, WA, to honor fathers that month. The first Father's Day was celebrated in Spokane in 1910.

Over the years, the idea spread, and people lobbied Congress to establish the holiday. In 1914, President Woodrow Wilson, who had signed the proclamation establishing Mother's Day, approved the idea, but never signed a proclamation for it. In 1924, President Calvin Coolidge made it a national event to "establish more intimate relations between fathers and their children and to impress upon fathers the full measure of their obligations."

From the Pastor's Pen

This Sunday Fr. Mike and I wish all fathers, stepfathers, grandfathers, Godfathers, and foster fathers a blessed celebration of Father's Day. We greatly appreciate your vocation and ask God to bless you abundantly in responding to God's call to be life-givers and leaders by your good example and loving fidelity.

For Catholics, the greatest gift to the Church is the Eucharist. When Jesus gathered with His apostles at the Last Supper, taking bread, he blessed it, broke it, and said to his friends: "Take and eat; do this in remembrance of me." Likewise he took the cup of wine, blessed it, saying "This is my blood; take and drink; do this in memory of me."

In our memorial, the Mass, we do what the Lord Jesus asked us to do. Our participation, our eating and drinking, is not merely play-acting history, what Jesus did at the Last Supper. Rather our faith tells us that we are receiving the very presence of the Lord. In this action, we enter into the Paschal Mystery, the dying and rising of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Probably all of us know and believe in the teaching about the Eucharist. Perhaps we could use this Feast to do an examination on the way we receive the Eucharist. Sometimes it is easy to lose concentration and just go through the motions. Receiving the Eucharist can easily become casual without a genuine spirit of reverence. When the Eucharist touches our hand or tongue is there a sense of devotion? When we eat (and drink when a healing from Covid allows it), do we concentrate on what we are doing and why we are doing this action? When we return to the pew, do we keep focus on the presence of Christ with a spirit of devotion and gratitude? For some, it may just be watching other people come and go in the Communion line, or thinking about what we are going to do this day, or leaving after Communion without much thought about what we have just done.

The celebration of the Eucharist is a treasure, our highest and best prayer, and a time of intimacy with the Lord. Let's all strive to cultivate a spirit of genuine devotion and reverence.

My prayers are with you each day.

A New Opportunity to Share Our Faith and Love of Christ

According to Sandy, "this will be an on-going, year-round ministry. You may begin and/or end attending at any time, or just participate for a shorter time and that's okay. We will meet one another where we are as pilgrims on a journey of faith".

Someone is Watching and Wondering



Over the past few weeks I have invited participation in two faith sharing opportunities: "*Sharing His Love With one Another*" and "*Christian Initiation of Adults.*" Both of these ministries meet throughout the year, on the 2nd and 4th Wednesdays (either from noon to 1:00 or 6:30-8:00pm), or Sunday from 9:15-10:15, respectively. Today I would like to introduce another ministry: *Sponsorship for Catechumens and Candidates* in the initiation process. Sponsors serve as companions, guides, role-models, and witnesses, during the period of formation leading to reception of the Sacra-

ments of Initiation into the Catholic Church. As a **companion**, sponsors are available to the catechumen or candidate to offer support, comfort, and understanding, in a safe space of trust and confidentiality. As a **guide** the sponsor leads the catechumen or candidate to understand that the Holy Spirit is their ultimate guide. Therefore, it is important for a sponsor to support the individual by attending Mass and praying with them, as well as openly sharing their own personal faith, catholicity, and unique story. As a **model**, the sponsor lives his/her faith through daily life, ordinary actions, relationships and encounters with others. As a **witness** a sponsor is willing to testify to the spiritual growth of the catechumen or candidate, acknowledging any problems or concerns, and assuring that the desire for receiving the sacraments is a free choice and not due to pressure from another individual.

A sponsor should be a person of prayer, a good listener, respectful and accepting, a loving servant of Christ, and open to the Holy Spirit's guidance. A sponsor must also be willing to continue their own formation, with other sponsors. Sponsor faith sharing and formation gatherings are the 1st and 3rd Wednesday evening of every month, from 6:30 to 8:00pm in the conference room behind the reception desk in the Office Complex at the rear entrance of the Church. I will offer an informal gathering on June 29th (same location and time) for anyone who is interested in this opportunity for sponsorship and growth in our faith. I can honestly say that each year as I journeyed with catechumens and candidates, serving as a sponsor and catechist, I have been challenged, grown, and strengthened in my faith. For me, faith formation is centered in learning to love God more and more deeply.

Sponsorship is yet another opportunity to share and grow in that love, to trust more deeply, and surrender more completely to living in and through our relationship with God. Sponsorship allows us to journey with another individual as their companion, friend, and fellow Christ lover. I feel serving as a sponsor is a gift of pure grace from God as we are entrusted to share His light and love, His peace and joy, and His hope for all creation.

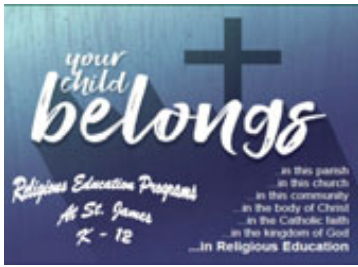
