

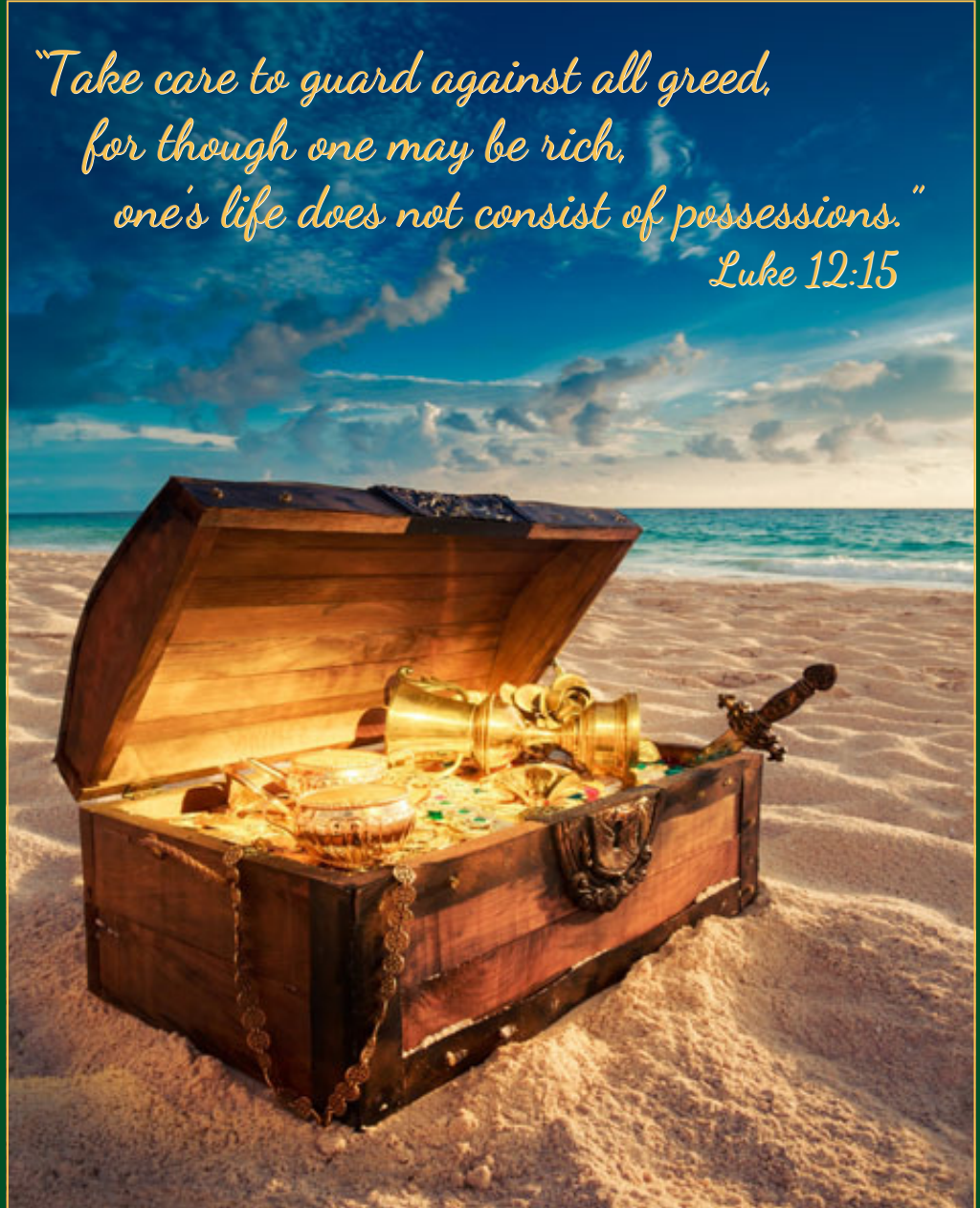

## From the Pastor's Pen

Last Spring I was surprised when my grandniece invited me to preside at her up-coming wedding. Holly and Brian will be married at St. Aloysius Church in Washington, DC, on October 1. I was so pleased that they made the decision to have the marriage in the church with the Catholic Rite of Marriage. So many young couples today choose of option of a "destination wedding," usually a beach or resort or some exotic place. It's not much about the place but more about the preparation and understanding the meaning of the Sacrament of Matrimony.

Recently Pope Francis said that "superficial marriage preparation programs leave many couples at risk of having invalid marriages. They may be unprepared to cope with the struggles that arise in every marriage." He endorsed suggestions for a year-long "marriage catechumenate." Often with a weak foundation, marriages fall apart after a short time and cannot withstand even the first inevitable crises. A document was released at the Vatican in June called "Catechetical Itineraries for Married Life." Pope Francis said he hoped that that the document would be followed by another which would provide guidance and clear suggestions for accompanying couples who have experienced the failure of their marriage and live in a new relationship or have been married civilly. The newly issued document is designed to help young people understand the sacrament, prepare engaged couples to celebrate their marriage, and support newlyweds in the first years of their married life.

I know from experience that a document and proposal like this might be a hard sell. Often young couples choose to marry in the Church according to the Catholic rite because they want to please their parents. They will jump through whatever hoops they have to just to be approved to celebrate the Sacrament. It can be very difficult to motivate a couple to take seriously the preparation program and to cherish the spiritual aspect of their marriage. It's difficult to resist the powerful influence of the culture which is often at odds with the Catholic understanding of the Sacrament. Good programs of marriage preparation may help, but it takes a serious effort to make them work. My hope is that more couples will want to celebrate their marriage in the Church, fortified by the grace of the Sacrament.

Let's pray for engaged couples as I pray for you each day.

## Someone is Watching and Wondering



Last week I presented a picture of the changing face of Christians in our global world. I also mused on what it means to profess my faith as a Christian in 2022. In my quest for answers I found two different ideas.

The first stated: "the foundation of Jesus' [teachings] is what I call non-idolatry, or the withdrawing of our enthralment with all kingdoms except the Kingdom of God. . .[thus supporting] a much better agenda than feeling the need to attack things directly. Nonattachment (freedom from loyalties to human-made domination systems) is the best way I know of protecting people from religious zealotry . . .there is nothing to be against (Fr. Richard Rohr). He further suggests that we must keep focused on what we are truly for. To my way of thinking I should be truly for following Jesus command to love and serve God and one another.

The second vision of being a Christian came from Pope Francis: "The Lord is **not** looking for perfect Christians; the Lord is **not** looking for Christians who never doubt and always flaunt a steadfast faith. . .the adventure of faith. . .consists of lights and shadows. Otherwise, what kind of faith would that be? It knows times of comfort, zeal and enthusiasm, but also of weariness, confusion, doubt and darkness. . .Crises are not sins, they are part of the journey, we should not fear them. . .they [may] make us humble. . .strip us of the ideal that we are fine, that we are better than others. . .[crises help us to recognize] that we are needy; rekindle [our] need for God. . .enable us to return to the Lord, to touch his wounds, to experience his love anew as if it were the first time."

For myself, the statement by Fr. Rohr presents a challenge; what should I let go and what must embrace as I look at the world I live in, the people, conflicts, and urgent needs. I must acknowledge my prejudices, bias, and attitudes which do not align with the gospel message of Christ. The words of Pope Francis give me hope in my humanity. God does not ask for perfection; God asks for love. Trusting in God's love, believing God placed the Holy Spirit within me to guide my thoughts and actions is not only the greatest gift but what enables me to change, to become more understanding, compassionate, hearing even those voices which seem so different and even strange. God still works miracles. I must become a beholder of God's mercy, forgiveness, place, availability, and actions in my daily lives.

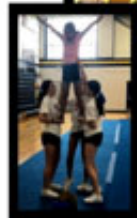

## Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord Friday, August 6



The feast of the Transfiguration of Christ celebrates the revelation of Christ's divine glory on Mount Tabor. After revealing to His disciples that He would be put to death in Jerusalem, Christ, along with Sts. Peter, James, and John, went up the mountain. There, Saint Matthew writes, "he was transfigured before them. And his face did shine as the sun: and his garments became white as snow."

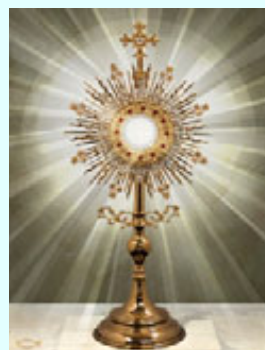
For Peter, James, and John, it was also a glimpse of the glories of heaven and of the resurrected body promised to all Christians. As Christ was transfigured, two others appeared with Him: Moses, representing the Old Testament Law, and Elijah, representing the prophets. Thus Christ, Who stood between the two and spoke with them, appeared to the disciples as the fulfillment of both the Law and the prophets.

At Christ's baptism in the Jordan, the voice of God the Father was heard to proclaim that "This is my beloved Son". During the Transfiguration, God the Father pronounced the same words.

*EDITOR'S NOTE: Each time we enter our Sanctuary, we are reminded of the glory of the Transfiguration as we see the large mural (33 feet 2 inches in height and 14 feet 7 inches in width).*

*Looking closely, we see Christ at the upper center with Moses and Elijah at His right and left. The three disciples are on the mountain: Peter at the lower left in a kneeling posture, John at the upper or summit of the mountain, and St. James, further down the mountain.*
