Someone is Watching and Wondering

"Space, the New Frontier!" Scientists believe the universe is approximately 13.8 billion years old and based on current knowledge 93 billion light years across (just to give some perspective one light year is nearly 6 trillion miles). For the first time we are privileged to see images, released in July, taken from the James Webb space telescope, that reveal not only the vastness and beauty of the universe but also never before seen galaxies, stars, and planets.



The light from the orange-red galaxy in the center of this picture travelled 8.4 billion years before the image was captured by the James Webb space telescope. This means formation of the galaxy occurred 5.4 billion years after the birth of the universe. My mind cannot even begin to understand these calculations, yet my ignorance does not prevent the amazement I feel at the infinite wonders of God's creation. Viewing this image and realizing that I am looking at the past, makes me think about the time I am given each day.

Imagine a bank that credits your account every morning with \$86,400. There is no carry-over balance from day to day, as whatever amount you did not use will be



deleted at the end of the day. Fantastic, not really. We have such a bank named TIME. Every day we are given 86,400 seconds. If we fail to use the

daily deposit, the loss is ours; there is no going back or drawing from tomorrow. We must live in the present. In thinking about time and the value of one year, ask a student who failed a grade; one month, ask the parents of a premature baby; one week ask the editor of a weekly newspaper; one hour ask lovers waiting for one another; one minute ask a person who missed a plane; one second; ask someone who avoided an accident; one millisecond, ask the athlete who won a silver medal in the Olympics. Time is precious; treasure every moment; treasure it more when you share it with another person. Time simply doesn't wait. Yesterday is history, tomorrow is mystery, today is pure gift from God — that's why we call it present. Don't waste your daily deposit in the bank of Time and never forget to thank God for this precious gift.

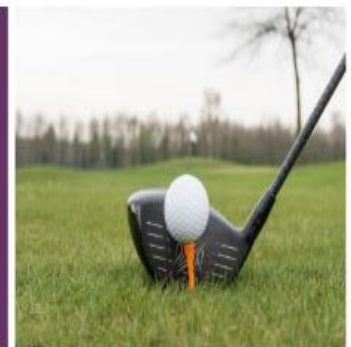

By praying for us, Saints help us strengthen our relationship with God. We like to think of Saints as our "Role Models". Their lives are excellent examples of living out our Faith. When choosing a Confirmation Saint, you want to pick one that inspires you, one that you want to emulate (and of course, ask to pray for you!).
