## From the Pastor's Pen

Today I would like to focus on two important events happening this week. The first is the opening day for our St. James School. There is no doubt that maintaining a Catholic school in any parish is a high budget item. Some people may say that the Liberty Public School System is excellent and that there is no need for a Catholic school. So why should our parish have a school? Excellence in academics is one obvious answer. But more important answers are rooted in our Catholic faith. The students have opportunities to learn about the faith, see examples of how the faith is lived in everyday life, participate at Mass and prayer services, do works of service and ministry, and live the great law of love. Attention is given to individual needs. Students learn to work together to promote the common good. Here at St. James we have an excellent staff. So we begin the school year with great confidence, knowing all the benefits the school brings to our parish.

The other event is the Ministry Fair. We are reminded again and again that to believe and pray, though at the root of our faith, is not all that is necessary. As St. James says in his letter to the people of the early Church, "What good is it, my brothers, if someone says that he has faith but does not have works?" We are called to be good and generous stewards of our time, talent, and treasure. Some folks, like the elderly or disabled, may be limited in their response, though the desire may be there. They contribute through their prayers. Many others have talents and gifts to share. Perhaps in the liturgy as readers, servers, music ministry, sacristans, laundering linens, or decorating. Others may assist by serving on committees. Still others may help maintain the grounds, mowing, or tending to the flowers and trees or volunteering as an office assistant. The purpose of the Ministry Fair is to feature the ministries of the parish, answer questions about needs, and give an opportunity to continue or begin a ministry. These ministries are ways of living out our faith. We hope that you will find the time to come to the Ministry Fair, meet and greet fellow parishioners.

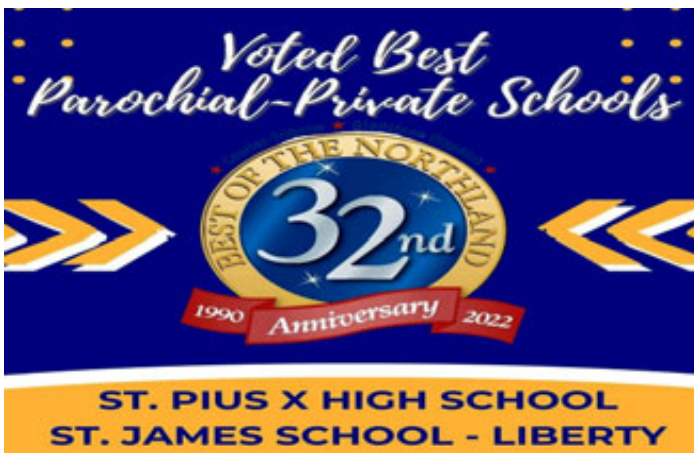
## Just A Reminder: The School Mass Has Been Moved To Wednesday

Bishop James Johnston will preside at each Mass honoring the Golden Wedding couples.

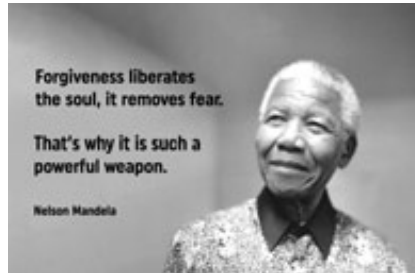

## Someone is Watching and Wondering



Recently I was asked to give a reflection on the Lord's prayer. Looking in my file on prayer, I rediscovered a dialogue between an individual praying the "Our Father" and God.

Perhaps you have come across this same reflection. This dialogue is truly challenging. What strikes me is how often I pray the Lord's prayer, without thinking about what I am actually attesting to and affirming. There are two phrases, in particular, in this prayer, with which I struggle: "Thy will be done," and "as I forgive those that trespass against me." When I pause to think about what I am praying, I am forced to ask myself: "Do I submit myself to the Father's will and am I truly willing to forgive?" Today I only wish to address forgiveness.

Jesus is very clear on this topic: "If you forgive others. . . your heavenly Father will forgive you. But if you do not forgive others, neither will your Father forgive your transgressions" (Matthew 8:14-15). Later in Chapter 18, Jesus answers Peter's question regarding how many times to forgive, with these words: "not seven times but seventy-seven times," (verse 22). Again I question myself, "Have I ever truly forgiven another one, seventy-seven times" (in other words, without limit)? Honestly, I don't know! I want to believe I do, yet there have been hurts in my life, which go so deeply that it is hard to let go and forgive.

Psychiatrists describe forgiveness as a conscious, deliberate choice to release feelings of resentment or vengeance toward a person or group, without judgement as to whether such forgiveness is warranted. Furthermore, there is an understanding among clinicians that forgiveness may lead to feelings of understanding, empathy and compassion for those who have caused hurt and pain. Conversely, forgiveness does not mean forgetting or excusing the harm done, and forgiveness does not necessarily re-establish a close relationship or trust. Yet forgiveness does bring a peace which enables me to go on with life, to love unconditionally as Jesus taught, and to serve others as He leads.

To restate the words of Nelson Mandela: forgiveness liberates the soul, removes fear, and is a powerful weapon as I struggle with hurts and transgressions against me, as I seek to offer forgiveness, as I desire to heal and move forward in faith, trusting my Heavenly Father.

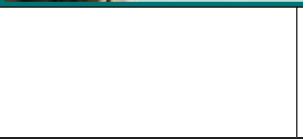
