Someone is Watching and Wondering



Two weeks ago, at our Ministry Fair, I reintroduced my new ministry “Sharing our Love of Jesus.” St. Francis of Assisi is often noted to have said “Share the love of Jesus everyday, and when necessary, use words.” In this ministry at St. James, you have the opportunity to express your love with words, in a safe environment where your thoughts, ideas, and opinions matter and are valued. At each gathering we explore the scripture readings for the coming Sunday. We read the scriptures, discover something of the culture of the first century where Jesus taught, and consult Catholic teaching(s) and documents (such as the catechisms of our church and writings of the Second Vatican Council, which were developed from scripture and tradition). Most importantly, during our gatherings we share how we are challenged and impacted by readings from sacred scripture. I believe that the statement “The Bible/Holy Scripture is the living word of God” only has meaning when we as individuals understand and embrace how the words are directed toward our day to day living in a complicated, complex, multicultural society, world, country, and church. Embracing and understanding scripture and how it connects to our lives, brings a beauty and richness which may have gone unnoticed if we simply hear the words proclaimed during Mass. Sharing experiences may also result in new understandings related to real revelation, a true in-breaking of God into our lives. Perhaps we are shocked, surprised, or shaken from routines that are not life giving to ourselves or to others. Scripture reveals how to make a special place in our lives for the unfamiliar, the stranger, the foreigner, the person who is utterly different from us. Father Ron Rolheiser states that one of the hallmarks of true revelation is that it stretches us, takes us into new territory, and opens us to realities we have never before imagined. True revelation may fracture our previous images of God, which we created to resemble ourselves or to what we imagine God should be (jealous, legalistic, feared, vengeful, or unforgiving.) For me, truly exploring and embracing scripture helps me fall deeper and deeper in love with our gracious God who is revealed in scripture, the natural world, others around me, and is the one who Jesus addressed as *abba*.

Please visit us if this ministry interests you. We gather on the 2nd and 4th Wednesday of each month at noon or 6:30 PM in the office conference room. Hope to see you there.
