## From the Pastor's Pen

The bishops of our country have asked that each diocese observe "Safe Haven Sunday," a weekend to address the harms of pornography and to offer resources to support and protect individuals, marriage, and families from this danger. Bishop Johnston has asked that here in our diocese we observe "Safe Haven Sunday" this weekend.

What is pornography? It is printed or visual material containing the explicit description or display of sexual organs or activity intended to stimulate erotic rather than aesthetic or emotional feelings. There is no doubt that pornography is a great danger to our country and world family. About 200,000 people in the United States are classified as porn addicts. About 40 million regularly visit porn sites; 35% of internet downloads are related to porn. Every second \$3+ million dollars is spent on porn. Every second 28,300 Internet users are viewing porn sites. Every 39 seconds a new pornographic video is being produced. In our country alone, porn revenues exceed \$13.3 billion.

According to the National Center for the Protection of Children and Families, 47% of families reported that pornography is a problem in their home. Porn use increases the marital infidelity rate by more than 300%. Statistics don't lie. Obviously, porn is a huge problem and great evil. The Catholic bishops of the United States want to raise the awareness of the dangers of porn and offer ways to help families to be healed of this plague. The theme for this year's Safe Haven Sunday is "Equipping the Family: Safety Through Connection." A resource book is available called "Connected: How Strong Family Relationships Lead to Internet-safe Kids."

Bishop Johnston has instructed all parishes in the diocese to read his letter regarding Safe Haven Sunday. He reminds us of the seriousness of this issue, of parental responsibility to protect children, cultural hazards to the moral and spiritual health of our children, and asks all people of the diocese, especially parents, to enter into the spirit of this Safe Haven Sunday. Pornography is a terrible evil and a threat to the physical and spiritual well-being of the family and individuals. Please take seriously your responsibility to respond.

## Someone is Watching and Wondering



As I took time to sit with last Sunday's readings, (Wisdom 9:13, Psalm 9:10-17,28, Philimon (read the entire letter, it is short), and Luke 14:25-33) I was struck by the true meaning of my words when I state: "I am a disciple of Jesus and I give myself to

Him." I felt forced to answer, "What is the cost of my discipleship? Am I prepared and willing to sacrifice in giving myself to God?" Although the scriptures clearly addressed these questions, I also realize that acceptance of the idea of discipleship and giving myself completely to God, are very different.

In Luke, Jesus tells his followers to detach themselves from preconceptions of themselves, relationships, and worldly ideas of righteousness, and to plan carefully before agreeing to follow him. I understand Jesus is telling me that God alone must be the center of my existence and life. Moreover when I place my ego, family, friends, position, pleasure, fame, or wealth, at the center of my day to day living, I am neither truthfully giving myself to Him nor serving as His disciple. Ironically, I commit idolatry when I give any of these things top priority and fail to allow God to be the center from which everything radiates.

While meditating on these passages from scripture, I was also reminded of a question I am asked every year just before or at the beginning of Lent: "What are you giving up for Lent?" Honestly, I cannot answer this question because for me the question trivializes the more significant question: "What am I giving up for God?" Each time we profess the creed, or answer our baptismal questions, we are both stating the foundational beliefs of our faith while also professing to give control of our lives to God. We are surrendering our hearts and minds to God's will. We are asking for God's grace to embrace us not only in times of need for forgiveness and hope, but also each time we are faced with a decision, challenged to "figure things out on our own," when we slip into the pattern of putting ourselves and our wishes before God, or when we find detachment difficult. Putting God at the center of our lives is the cost of discipleship, the challenge of detachment, letting go of control, and letting God be God.

When I find myself having a personal pity party, feeling alone, prideful, full of myself, or holding on to hurts, wants, emotions, desires, or self-centeredness, Psalm 46 pops into my mind: "Be still and know that I am God." My reply must be: "In you I place my love, my trust. You, Lord are the center of my life."

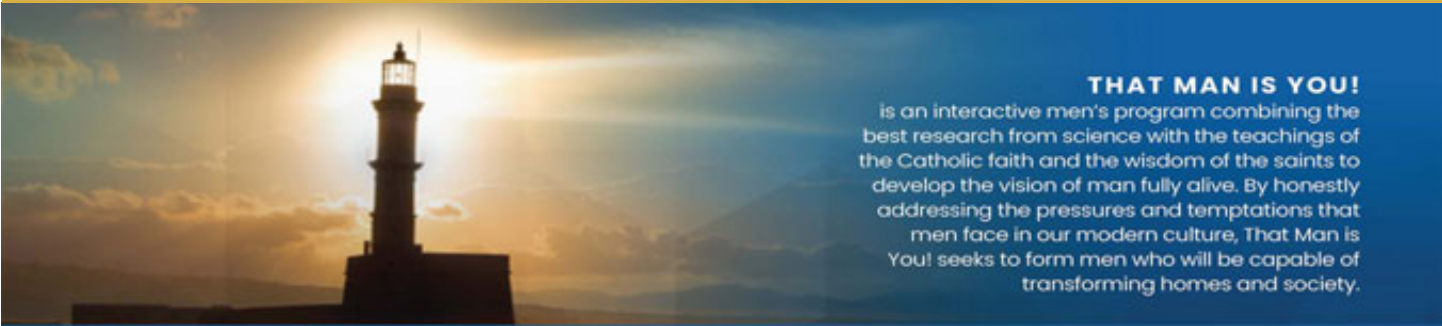

### Ann Puck Honored at Veteran's Convention



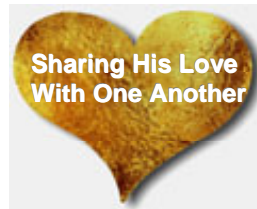
At the Catholic War Veteran's National Convention in Baltimore MD on August 27, Ann was inducted into the Order of St. Sebastian.

and how we are each individually called to share God's gifts through our daily lives.

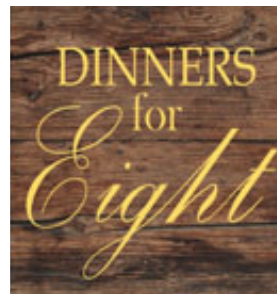
When: 2nd and 4th Wednesday of the month
