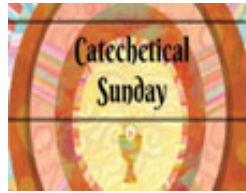

Someone is Watching and Wondering

HUMILITY
IS NOT THINKING
LESS OF YOURSELF,
IT IS THINKING
OF YOURSELF LESS.
-C.S. Lewis

Each day I try to read scripture and writings of a spiritual nature. Sometimes my reading come through an internet subscription, other times from a book in my library. One of my internet subscriptions is "Journey with the

Pope" which is a daily prayer from Pope Francis and a Psalm for reflection. Recently his prayer began "Humility does not consist in **belittling ourselves**, but rather in the healthy realism that makes us recognize our potentials as well as our misery [short comings and failures]. Humility makes us take our gaze off ourselves in order to turn it toward God." These works from Pope Francis seemed to resonate with the words above from C.S. Lewis. I must admit, the words of both of these men struck home in ways I find difficult to admit. Ironically in searching for a definition of humility I found this: "a modest or **low view** of one's own importance." For too many years, I understood humility as **thinking less of myself, belittling myself, or taking a low view of myself**. I missed the point of **thinking of myself less, recognizing my potential as well as my misery, or taking a modest view of my importance** in the general scheme of life. I also overlooked that humility is found in **turning toward God**. I think I began to discover the true meaning of humility when I first found myself in situations over which I had no control (eg when my husbands were diagnosed with cancer). I knew in my heart that finding a solution by myself was totally out of the question, and I believe it was at those times when I truly learned to pray. Although I prayed for healing, I also gave my loved ones to God's care. When they later received a terminal diagnosis, I discovered humility in surrender. I discovered that humbling myself to God did not require belittling myself or beating myself for past failures, rather humility required a reordering of my deepest thoughts, fears, and anxieties. Humbling myself required trusting in God and giving myself to unconditional love and mercy. I was able to seek God's love in the belief that God's promise of salvation for all humankind was the greatest gift of mercy and love; one which not even death could take away; God's gift is life, resurrection overcomes death.

In Chapter 4 of the Letter of James we find these words: "God resists the proud, but gives grace to the humble." I believe that to submit myself to God I must strive for humility. Believing that all things are possible with God also requires the realization that I cannot do all things by myself. Sometimes I do not have an answer, sometimes I fail yet I find comfort in Jesus' words: "Everything is possible to one who has faith" (Mark 9:23), to which I add and for those who live humbly.

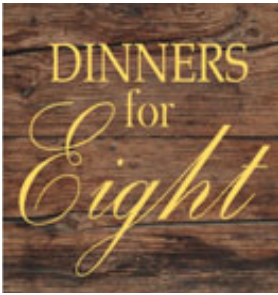

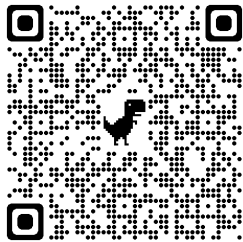

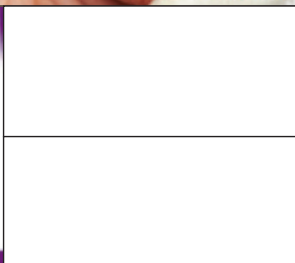
