## From the Pastor's Pen

Rodney Dangerfield was an American stand-up comedian best remembered for his self-deprecating one-liner humor. He is best remembered for his catch-phrase "I don't get no respect." For Dangerfield, it was a line that led into humorous situations. But for some people in our world and national families, they literally get no respect. Because of their state in life, they are ignored, ridiculed, victimized, taken advantage of and forgotten.

The word "respect" means giving due honor, recognition, esteem and thoughtfulness. In our Catholic/Christian understanding, every human being deserves respect because each person is made in the image and likeness of God. Sometimes their actions are hurtful and destructive. Sometimes their personalities turn people off. But still out of the great law of love we respect them as children of God and seek what is best for them.

October is celebrated as national Respect Life Month by our Catholic Church family. Yes, much of the stress is on the life of the unborn. It is our belief and teaching that an unborn child is deserving and demands the protection of his/her life just as a born person does. So we continue to witness to the belief as we oppose abortion and stand ready to protect and defend the unborn child no matter what others may think or how they may act.

But we must also be concerned for the born child, the child who may need protection, love, and nurturing, physically, emotionally, and spiritually. At the other end of the spectrum, we stand for the honor and reverence of the life of the elderly, that they are protected from abuse and neglect and are treated with dignity.

So also we call upon all people to respect the life of the handicapped and disabled, treating them as we would want to be treated. As a Church we oppose capital punishment, teaching that God gives life and only God can take a life. We respect the lives of the needy and impoverished, the refugees and the homeless. There, but for the grace of God, could be any of us.

Yes, giving all others due respect is the way of living the great law of love.

Know that my prayers are with all of you each day.

## **Someone is Watching and Wondering**



In the early 19th century Karl Marx wrote: "*Die Religion ... ist das Opium des Volkes*," which is translated "Religion is the Opiate of the People." Marx believed that religion provided a disconnect from reality and a

disengagement from societal problems, providing a calming uncertainty over humanities role in the universe. He believed that religion "is the sigh of the oppressed creature, the heart of a heartless world, and the soul of soulless conditions." I studied the writings of Marx many years ago and I do not agree with his political views, yet I sometimes wonder if we use religion as a kind of escape, a way of removing ourselves away from individuals we see as different, outside our circle of faith or political realm. It saddens my heart when I hear fellow Christians arguing and divided over what belongs in our churches, hymns sung during liturgy, what is or isn't brought into the environment of our worship space, etc. Maybe Marx wasn't so far off with his ideas that we use religion to dull our senses to anything that makes us uncomfortable, that we stand on our individual religious ideas to create division between different groups, cultures, and even between our ourselves and our Christian brothers and sisters.

Earlier this year, on the Feast of Sts. Peter and Paul, the Vatican released an Apostolic Letter from Pope Francis entitled *Desiderio Desideravi* (I Have Earnestly Desired), concerning the liturgical formation of the people of God. Quoting from this letter: "**Christian faith is either an encounter with Him alive, or it does not exist.** . . . I am Nicodemus, the Samaritan woman at the well, the man possessed by demons at Capernaum, the paralytic in the house of Peter, the sinful woman pardoned, the woman afflicted by hemorrhages, the daughter of Jairus, the blind man of Jericho, Zacchaeus, Lazarus, the thief and Peter both pardoned." Reading these words I am drawn to the Pope's idea that our faith is either an encounter with Jesus [living among us] or Christianity doesn't exist at all. Quite different from Marx's idea of religion that moves people into a kind of stupor, an escape into other-worldliness. I think Pope Francis is saying that we must encounter Jesus in one another, in all those people needing acceptance, healing, charity, and love. Our faith must lead us to service of one another, not into hiding. Our religion is not a protective armor, shielding us from disappointments, tragedy, or loss. Our religious faith, through liturgy and the sacraments is meant to transform every dimension of our life, conforming us more and more to Christ. Do we truly welcome "all" into our lives as Jesus did, or do we shut the doors of our hearts and minds, allowing entry only to those who think as we do. "The Lord Jesus who dies no more, who lives forever with the signs of his Passion continues to pardon and to heal **all God's children.**"

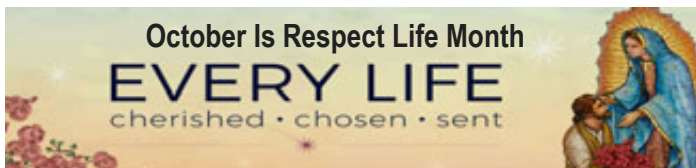
## The Advent Giving Tree is coming!!!

### Thanks For Supporting the Holy Smoke BBQ Contest



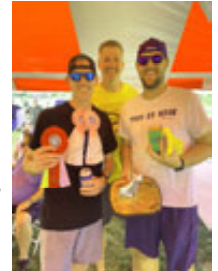

Congratulations to Grand Champion Jonesing for BBQ and Reserve Champion This is Nice (parishioner Ben Herzig) on their showing at this year's contest.



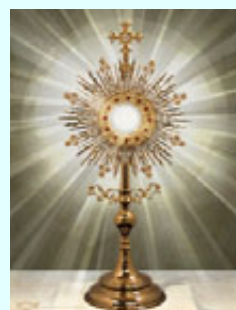

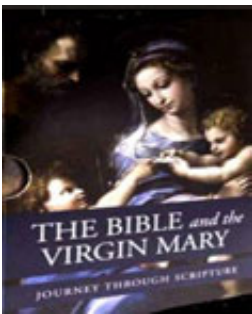
