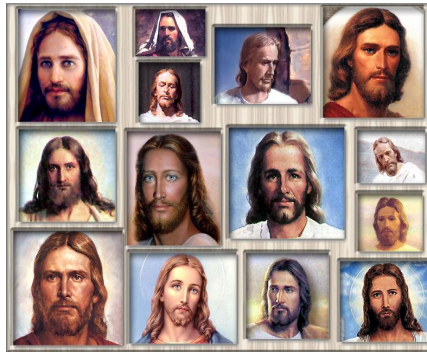

Someone is Watching and Wondering



Today we celebrate the second Sunday of Easter, also known to Roman Catholics as "Divine Mercy Sunday," which concludes the Octave of Easter. As such this Sunday is a reminder

of the Mercy of God which, when embraced in faith, guides us to trust in God and brings the **real presence** into our ordinary lives. God's grace, understood through the love and teachings of Jesus, is our guide for living fully and richly as human beings, being Jesus' presence in the world, sharing His light, and living in hope.

Previously I shared that I am a visual learner. Words without pictures only make sense and have meaning in my life, when I form a visual image in my brain. Forming a visual image of the Holy Trinity, however, has presented difficulties and remains part of my ongoing journey of faith which I now share. In my mind I visualize God as a wise, sage to whom I can turn for seeking knowledge. The Spirit is the wind that blows on my face, the air I breath, the passion I feel in my heart, but has no physical form. My image of the Son, however, is more complex because to me Jesus is eternally changing. Sometimes I visualize one of the classical paintings where Jesus has a kind face, long hair, and beautiful eyes. Other times Jesus is dressed in blue jeans, open neck shirt, and wind breaker jacket, walking our streets or seated on the sand playing with children. At times my image of Jesus is a man filled with sadness, pleading for all those who hurt to come to him for comfort. In my office, at St. James, I have a picture of Jesus that is only his callused hands reaching out for me to touch. At times I picture Jesus kneeling on the ground in prayer; praying for all humanity. The image above presents a few diverse faces of Jesus. I think it is reasonable, therefore, that you may have a different image of Jesus, which brings you comfort. I hope, whatever image of Jesus forms in your mind, that you see his love and mercy when you look into his eyes. If you find condemnation or disappointment, look again. Jesus is truly the reflection of God's love and mercy, not someone to fear. In Jesus I place my trust, devotion, and love. Jesus help me to reflect your love and mercy.

Is Easter Really Over?

Not Yet!! Easter Sunday is only the beginning!

Easter for Christians is not just one day, but rather a 50-day period. The season of Easter, or Eastertide, begins at sunset on the eve of Easter and ends on Pentecost, the day we celebrate the gift of the Holy Spirit and the birth of the Church.

These Fifty Days are a celebration of the Resurrection of Christ. This extended season gives us time to rejoice and experience what it means when we say Christ is risen. It's the season when we remember our baptisms and how through this sacrament we are, according to the liturgy, "incorporated into Christ's mighty acts of salvation." As "Easter people," we also celebrate and ponder the birth of the Church and gifts of the Spirit (Pentecost), and how we are to live as faithful disciples of Christ.

Why fifty days? It's actually quite simple. After the resurrection, Jesus spent forty days on earth before he ascended, and then there were ten more days after that before the Day of Pentecost.

The Feast of the Ascension the Lord falls on the 40th day, which is always falls on a Thursday. However, because this is a weekday, we observe the Ascension the following Sunday, the Seventh Sunday of Easter.

This sacred season of fifty days comes to an end the following Sunday, on Pentecost, as we commemorate the giving of the Holy Spirit to the apostles, the beginnings of the Church and its mission to every tongue and people and nation.

The Pennsylvania grand jury report, published in August of 2018, brought the scandal of clergy sex abuse in the US to the forefront once again. In the following months, headlines about abusive priests, indifferent bishops, predatory cardinals and Vatican corruption ensued. Pope Francis held a world-wide summit in Rome in February, the "Protection of Minors in the Church" (www.pbc2019.org). A number of issues have been identified with strong calls for reform including more leadership by laity in the handling of clergy sex abuse. Now, more than ever, we have an opportunity to change the way the world and our Church responds to sexual abuse and to help those who have been harmed. Since each of us make up the Church, how will you impact this movement?

#JOINTHECONVERSATION

DID YOU KNOW?

- 1:4 girls and 1:6 boys will be sexually abused by the age of 18
- Abusers of children are people we know and trust
- 73% of child sexual abuse victims do not tell anyone for at least a year
- 45% of victims do not tell anyone for at least 5 years
- Some victims wait decades to disclose while some never disclose their abuse
- The residual effects of having been abused can last a lifetime
- Predators entice children online through games, apps and sites they frequent

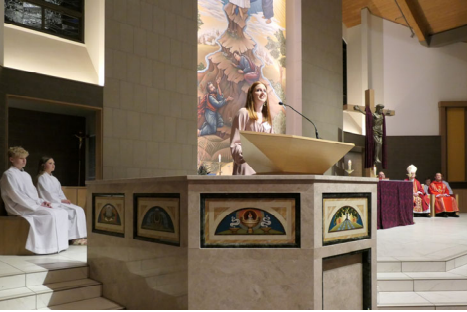
