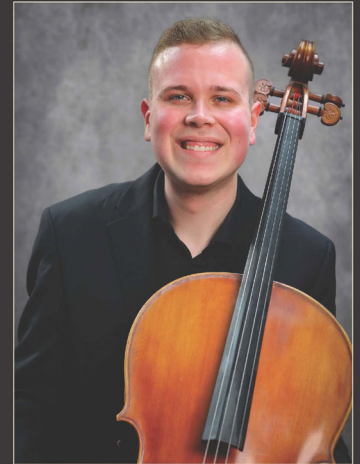

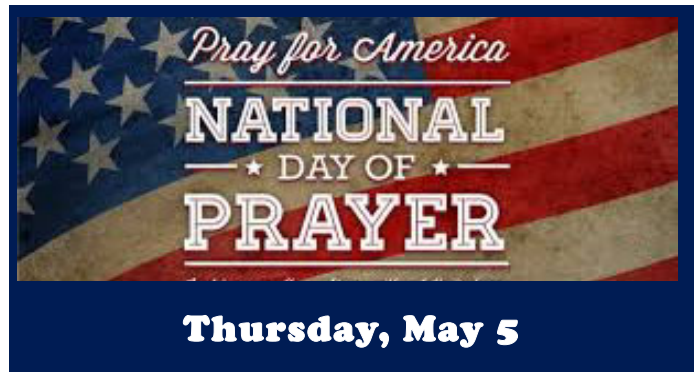

Someone is Watching and Wondering



Smithsonian Magazine - *The Daily's*— Picture of the Day on April 21, 2023, featured this photograph. Once again I was reminded not only of the beauty of our natural world, but of the promise of resurrection. If you have ever visited the southwestern desert region of our

country, you know it is a unique place. Seen through the eyes of a Midwesterner the scenery appears empty and desolate. If one takes the time to let go of the vision of rolling hills dotted with hardwoods, mixed pine forests, and delicate wildflowers, we can see a new diverse world filled with wonder, life, and beauty. Out of a seemingly dry, sandy, and rock strewn landscape, arises towering saguaro cactus, sentinels of the desert. Closer to the desert floor are prickly pear, chollas, beavertails, barrel cactus, and a plethora of wildflowers. One may also see wild sage, Joshua trees, desert willow, creosote, agave, yucca, and so much more. If you are fortunate enough to witness the desert after a rain storm, it seems to come alive within a few hours; birds sing, small animals scurry gathering seeds, and large mammals graze. Truly a marvelous witness to life arising from seemingly barrenness.

As I continue to meditate and look back on my life during this Easter season, I realize how often it has felt barren, filled with sorrow, disappointment, regret, and loss. Yet as one of my many mentors told me, "Sandra, look for the 'Golden thread' which connects the barrenness to life, the sorrow to joy, the disappointment to hope, the regret to forgiveness, and the loss to new life." I often remember his words whenever I face challenges and question the direction and purpose of my life. I believe my life is a witness to that "Golden thread" weaving my brokenness into a whole; the weaving is God's love and grace; the thread is Jesus, His teachings, forgiveness, and guidance. The thread is Jesus offering new life as He reaches out to lead me out of the darkness into His light. The thread is Jesus, telling me to let go and allow His healing touch to mend whatever is broken within me. For me, visiting the desert is yet another way God reassures and leads me toward resurrection. Blessed life to all this Easter Season,
