

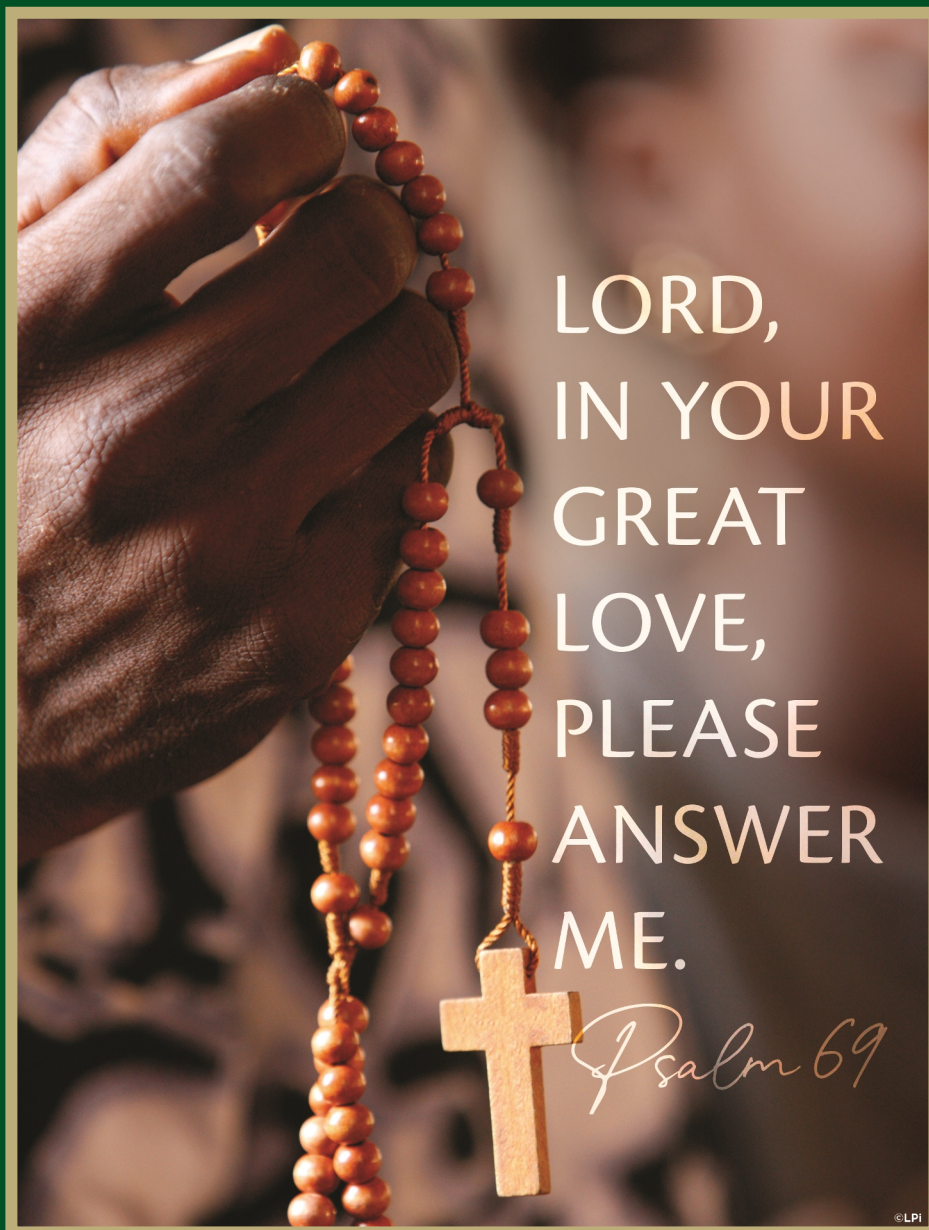

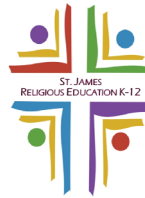

Someone is Watching and Wondering



At a recent meeting of Sponsors for Christ (those who volunteer to walk with our catechumens and candidates) we discussed how art, literature, music, drama, and social media play a role in defining, un-

derstanding, and strengthening our faith. Most people will agree that sacred writing, art, and music fulfills these roles, but what about those works classified as secular/popular art, literature, music, drama, and topics posted on social media. Let your imagination explore this idea for just a moment. When was the last time you watched a movie which brought Jesus' teachings to mind? What book have you read which caused you to explore your faith through new eyes? Is there a particular piece of music which draws you closer to God, or defines your faith journey? Have you recently read a social media post which made you think, lovingly and unselfishly about others? If I have caught your attention, let me share a few ideas that our sponsors mentioned: two paintings by Carravaggio, *John the Baptist* and *the Calling of Matthew*, the book *The Shack*, *Ode to Joy* by Beethoven, the *Lord of the Rings* Trilogy by J.R.R. Tolkein, the *Peanuts* comic strip and movies such as *Charlie Brown's Christmas*, works by C. S. Lewis, the song *The Prayer* made famous by Celine Dion, photographs by Ansel Adams, *Honey in the Rock* by Brooke Ligertwood, quotes or words to live by on Facebook or other social media sites, and I would add one of my favorites, the song *We are the World*. I know there are others and perhaps as you read this list your favorites come to mind. My point: we should never close our eyes, minds, ears, and hearts to God's presence, daily revealed in unexpected places, through unexpected voices, words, music, literature, or the visual and performing arts. I believe that whatever charism God gives to humankind, can be used to evangelize people, strengthen and bring clarity to their faith, share God's love, and bring glory to God's name. According to the Rule of St. Benedict, monastic life represents the sanctification of the ordinary, offers an incarnational vision of seeing Christ in others (particularly the sick and guests), and calls the monks to treat work tools. . .as they would treat sacred vessels. Think how different our world could be if we embraced these concepts: sanctification of the ordinary, saw Christ in others, and treated all work as sacred. Just imagine what new direction your faith could take by embracing the many wonders of God in the ordinary, especially through humankind's creativeness as co-creators with God.

Saints Peter and Paul Feast Day - June 29



These two saints are the founders of the See of Rome, through their preaching, ministry and martyrdom there.

Peter, who was named Simon, was a fisherman of Galilee. Jesus gave him the name Cephas (Petrus in Latin), which means 'Rock', because he was to become the rock upon which Christ would build His Church.

St. Paul was the Apostle of the Gentiles. His letters are included in the writings of the New Testament, and through them we learn much about his life and the faith of the early Church.

In the year 395, St. Augustine of Hippo said of Saints Peter and Paul: "Both apostles share the same feast day, for these two were one; and even though they suffered on different days, they were as one. Peter went first, and Paul followed. And so we celebrate this day made holy for us by the apostles' blood."

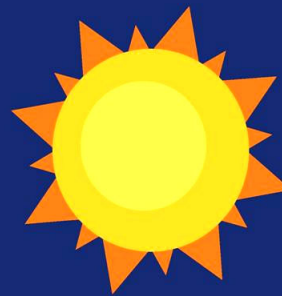

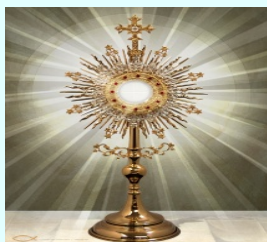
