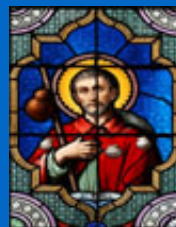

Someone is Watching and Wondering



As a mother, grandmother, and the Safe Environment Coordinator at St. James, focusing on safety has and is a matter of importance to me. I taught my children to wear their seatbelt and bicycle helmet; never to play with matches or fire; and as they got older I taught them

not to take drugs, or drink alcohol and drive. Of course there were many other lessons about keeping themselves safe, and this pattern continues with my grandchildren. As the Safe Environment Coordinator I monitor all programs at St. James that minister to minors, manage compliance of adults according to policies of our diocese, and facilitate training of Protecting God's Children and Circle of Grace. Sometimes, however, I wonder if I am so focused on personal safety that I am reluctant to step out of my comfort zone, and allow God to lead me to places, into situations, or ministries where I feel unprepared or reluctant to follow. Am I afraid? Do I live too safely?

When I was considering writing this article, I thought about the older brother in the story of the prodigal son. He followed the rules, did what was expected of him, and seemingly never took a chance. His younger brother was totally opposite. When the prodigal realized his failings and where he was headed, he returned home and sought forgiveness. The father was filled with joy, welcomed his younger son, and arranged a celebratory feast. The elder son, refused any involvement with his brother's return and welcome. He who had always followed the safe, faithful, rigid path was judgmental, jealous, bitter of heart, and morally uncompromising. Stuck in his cautious center, the older brother could not forgive or rejoice at his brother's return. I found myself asking if I have become like the older sibling, safe and internally paralyzed, unable to rejoice, to metaphorically dance with my brothers and sisters. Do I have courage to honestly look at my inhibitions, jealousies, and "religiously-sanctioned" anger? Am I judgmental, driven by fear more than love? Do I truly forgive; is my life about self-protection rather than love and generosity? In 2011, Fr. Ronald Rolheiser wrote: "the danger in living too safely is that sometimes when we think we are defending life we are really defending the poverty of our own lives, when we think we are defending virtue we are really defending our inhibitions and fears, and sometimes when we think we are speaking for God's healthy concern for the world, we are, like the older brother. . .really speaking of our own hidden jealousy."

Perhaps, God is pleading with me to step out of my safe zone and join the dance.

Monday July 25 Feast Day of St. James the Greater The Patron Saint of Our Church



The son of Zebedee and Salome, "our" St. James is called "the Greater" to distinguish him from the Apostle James "the Less", who was probably shorter of stature. He was the brother of John, the beloved disciple. Zebedee, his father, was a fisherman of the Sea of Galilee. Salome, his mother, was one of the pious women who afterwards followed Christ and ministered unto him of their substance.

James is described as one of the first disciples to join Jesus. When he first encountered Jesus, there probably was no indication that this was the day that his life would change. The dawn for him was not the bright beginning of a new day, but the end of long fruitless night of fishing. As James sat mending his nets in the boat with his brother John and his father Zebedee, he must have watched in wonder as his partner Simon brought in nets loaded with fish he had caught at the command of Jesus.

As Jesus walked towards James, followed by Simon and Andrew, He didn't pass him by. He stopped by their boat and called James and his brother John to do just what Simon and Andrew had done - follow Him. Without argument or discussion, James and John left their boat and even their father behind, and followed Jesus.

James was one of only three apostles whom Jesus chose to join to join him in prayer at the Garden of Gethsemane for his final prayer before his arrest and whom Jesus selected to bear witness to his Transfiguration.

Following Christ's Ascension, James spread the Gospel across Israel and the Roman kingdom as well. He traveled and spread the Word for nearly forty years in Spain.

The Acts of the Apostles records that "herod the king" (traditionally identified with Herod Agrippa) had James executed by sword. St. James is the only apostle whose martyrdom is recorded in the New Testament.
