

## From the Pastor's Pen

Have you ever gone to a restaurant and observed half-eaten meals taken out to be thrown in the garbage? Have you ever seen pictures of people living in dire poverty, hungry and even starving? The contrast should trouble us and make us conscious of the sin of waste in our country and other more prosperous nations. In my own family, I never went away from the table hungry, but I was expected to eat all the food on my plate. Waste was not an option in our household.

Recently there was an article on the Internet about food waste. It showed a picture of a large dumpster filled with packages of food, still edible, which had passed the expiration date. Such a scene is not unusual. In this country it is estimated at 40 million tons of food, which represent 30% to 40% of the country's entire food supply as thrown away each year. It makes up about 22% of the total in landfills. The article states "Grocery stores account for about five million tons of that food, throwing away perfectly good produce and other edible goods every day, with 1.55 million tons in landfills. Most people don't realize that the food waste, once in a landfill, gives off gases like methane and carbon dioxide which contribute to overheating the planet.

How can this be? How can so much food be wasted when at the same time people are hungry and even starving? It's not only a human failure but a spiritual one as well. The gospel calls us to live the great law of love. If we truly care about the hurts and pains of our fellow sojourners because of hunger, we act. Yes, there is enough food to feed the hungry if we take care of our precious resources and eliminate greed and waste. Of course we don't want spoiled food that causes sickness. We just need to urge people to take on their plates only the amount that they can eat, and to urge food suppliers not to throw out food still edible. I just want to take this opportunity to thank all parishioners who donate food to the In As Much food bank and all of those who help serve at the food kitchens on the 4<sup>th</sup> weekend of each month. You see the needs of the hungry and assist with your service.

I know at some time every family has or will experience loss of some kind, and I know that no matter what the

loss, there is pain associated with letting go. Loss that involves the death of a family member or close friend, I believe, is the most difficult to bear. As I was thinking about the loss of my parents, grandparents, aunts, uncles, cousins, husbands, and dear friends I was also reminded of my vast and wonderful extended family.

I am beginning my 27th year as the Director of Christian Initiation at St. James. During these years we, as a parish, have welcomed more than 300 new members through reception of the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist. I think of these individuals as my "children in Christ." They and the sponsors who have voluntarily journeyed with them are not only friends but family. Throughout my tenure I have said goodbye to many who have either moved to different parts of the country, as well as giving others, who have been called from this life, to the loving embrace of God. I have watched some marry, welcome children, and send their children to college or to begin families of their own. I have also grieved with some over the loss of family members. Reflecting on these years, I feel blessed to have shared the lives of so many individuals, on their journey faith, and each will always have a special place in my heart. You might be thinking I am saying goodbye to this ministry. Not so, I am simply remembering what a fantastic journey this has been for me as I continue to welcome new men and women who have expressed a desire to grow in their faith. My family continues to grow.

When I became a Catholic at the Easter Vigil in 1995, my sponsor/godmother gave me a letter. In the letter she stated that we were now joined as "Sisters in Christ" and our bond was unbreakable by time or situation. I was very touched by her letter, and continue to thank God for bringing her into my life. She never had children, or a sister, is the last surviving member of her biological family, but remains filled with joy and the peace of Christ. She continues to help me find that same joy and peace, and is a reminder of how grace flows from God, through each of us, and that God's love is meant to be shared. To anyone reading this, who has allowed me to journey with you, please know how much I love you and how grateful I am that you are part of my life. We are eternally joined as family in Christ Jesus. Thank you for allowing me to be part of your family.


