

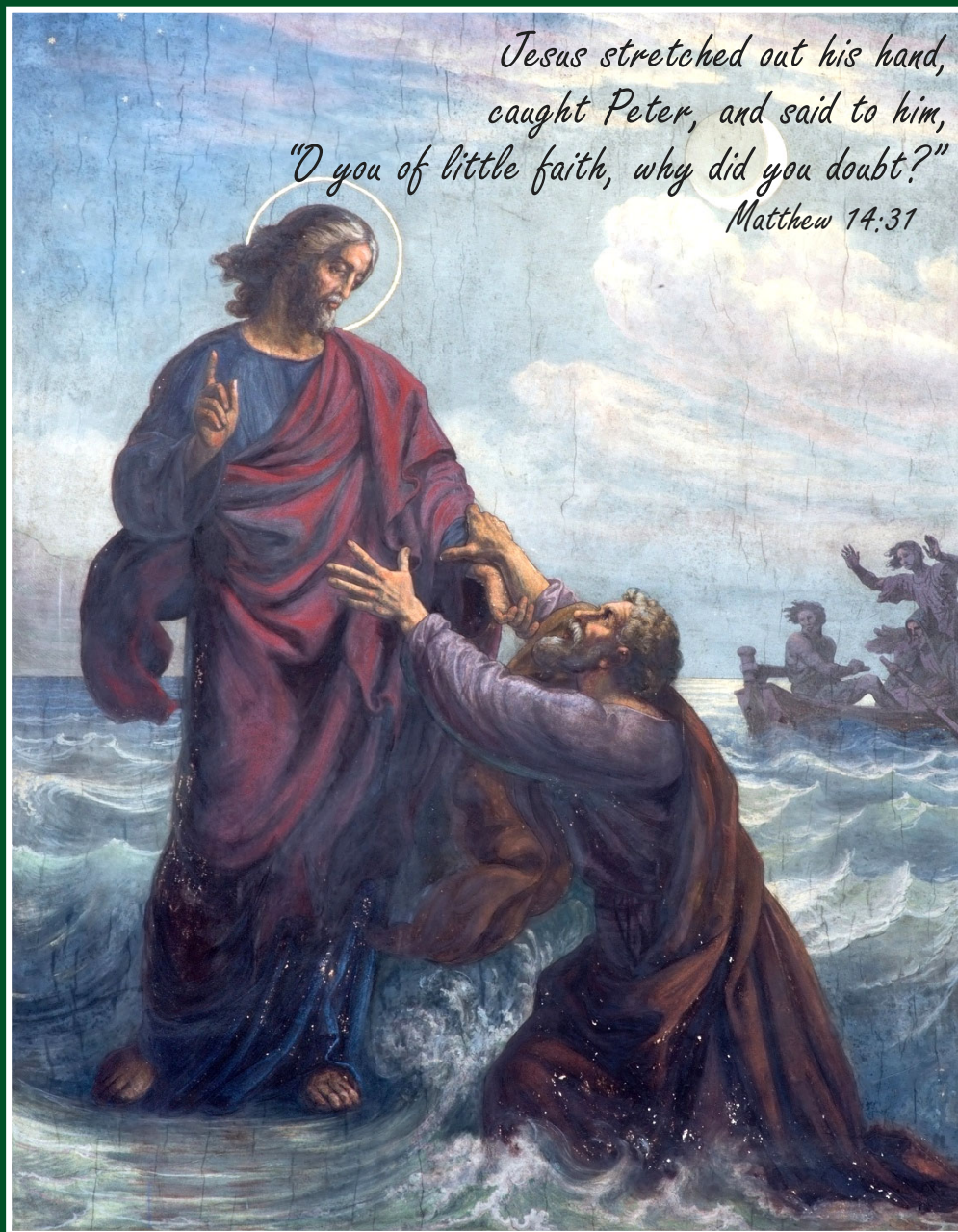

From the Pastor's Pen

An article appeared in the July/August issue of America magazine: "Latino Catholics Are Leaving the Church: What Can Be Done to Welcome Them Back?" Since we have a good number of Latino/Latina Catholics in our parish, the words of this article should be of concern to us. Are they leaving the Catholic Church in our area? If so, why is this happening?

Statistics help us to understand the state of affairs, The Pew Research Center Study documents the issue. Approximately 43% of Latinos are Catholic, down from 67% in 2010. Some of those who have left the Church find a new home in Evangelical churches. In most instances, those who come to an Evangelical church say that they feel at home there and find a sense of belonging. One member who left the Catholic Church explained: "It was a lot of little things that added up. But if I had to say one thing, it would be the rigidity and lack of acceptance." He said that an apostolic church with upbeat music drew the family in. The family appreciated the friendly, community-oriented events. A very strict pastor was assigned to his former Catholic parish. "The pastor was an authoritarian figure who was not open to questions. He felt unqualified and unworthy to participate in certain activities." Another man commented: "I didn't need to be lectured; I needed to be hugged." Many Latinos simply do not feel welcomed in Catholic churches. "In order to be accepted you almost have to renounce your culture."

The article states that disaffiliated Latinos now make up 30% of all Latinos in the United States, triple the number from 12 years ago, about half of these under 30. Why aren't they affiliated? Some say their parents were not religious. Others had a bad experience with organized religion. Some say they are simply not interested. Some were turned off by certain Catholic teaching. This might apply just as well to people of all cultures,

The bottom line is that we need to make sure that we respect and honor our Catholic brothers and sisters of all cultures, all races, all ages. We need to treat every person who comes through our door with great dignity and welcome.

Someone is Watching and Wondering



When did we become so divisive? This is a question I often think about? Most of us witness or experience divisiveness in families, the work place, the

United States, the world, between religious groups, among Christians, and yes even in our Catholic Church, parishes, and schools. The divisions seem to evolve not simply from a difference in opinions, but from a need to be **"RIGHT"**. For me, this presents great frustration and disappointment. I often feel helpless, thinking I cannot make a difference. There does not appear to be answers or solutions. What has happened to open discussion, a willingness to listen to diverse voices, experiences, ideas, a desire for consensus, and building bridges of compassion and hope? As people we are even divided over obvious realities: climate change, response to pandemics, health care and educational disparities, food and water shortages, existence of poverty, homelessness, hunger, and unjust treatment of the **"OTHERS"**. While we closely guard our individual freedom and rights, too often we fail to acknowledge the freedom, rights, and dignity of those with whom we feel no commonality. As these thoughts and feelings weigh me down, however, I think of Jesus!

For both political and religious leaders, for the rich and powerful, Jesus was one of the **"OTHERS"**. Jesus did not conform to accepted ideas of his time. Jesus embraced the will of his Father. He not only advocated for the poor and voiceless, he actively mingled with them. He shared meals, healed, blessed, and offered his love. He provided encouragement and hope. Jesus did not exclude anyone from his mercy, even those who openly criticized, belittled, rejected, and plotted to eliminate him; he prayed, "Father forgive them for they do not know [understand] what they do."

As I write these words, I realize that Jesus is speaking directly to me. He is calling me to share his mercy and compassion, calling me to be a healer, to offer hope, to embrace and name pain caused by others, to let go and forgive, to build bridges. Healing divisions is everyone's responsibility, but realistically it begins with **"ME"**; I must undergo inner conversion. Am I strong enough, do I believe in myself, do I allow myself to be true to who I am, or do I live in fear of rejection? Do I place God at the center of my being? Do I trust God enough to open myself to follow the path of Jesus? Is my moral integrity firmly rooted in Jesus' teachings, or do I still hold tightly to my egotistic concepts of right and wrong, good and evil, just and unjust. I know I need to be more responsive to a God-centered life. Shouldn't we try to end divisiveness together, following Jesus' lead!

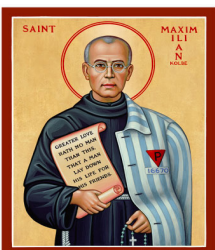

St. Maximilian Kolbe Feast Day August 14



St. Maximilian Kolbe, born January 8, 1894, in Poland, was a Polish Conventual Franciscan friar and a martyr in the German death Camp of Auschwitz during World War II.

He was very active in promoting the Immaculate Virgin Mary and is known as the Apostle of Consecration to Mary.

It is said during the last days of his life Kolbe led prayers to Our Lady with the prisoners. He died on August 14, 1941, and his remains were cremated on August 15, the same day as the Assumption of Mary feast day.

Kolbe was canonized as a saint by Pope John Paul II on October 10, 1982.

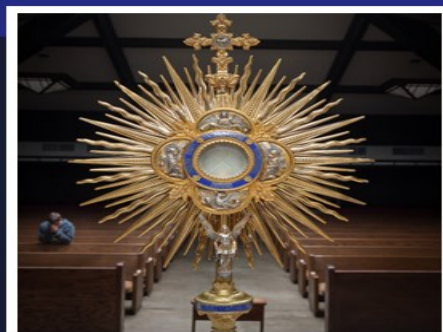
