

# Someone is Watching and Wondering



In Lewis Carroll's book. Alice in Wonderland. there is a scene in which Alice meets a great caterpillar, smoking a water pipe. When Alice asks the caterpillar directions to go home, the caterpillar responds: "Who are you?" Alice, confused gives her name and repeats the request for direction, yet the caterpillar persists with the question, "Who are

you?" Indeed, this is a question that touches something deep within me. Of course I would answer with my name; perhaps explain who my parents were, or list other family members; I might answer with my job title, ministry goals, belief system, or role as parent and grandchildren. I am confident, however, that my words would not satisfy the caterpillar because my descriptions are superficial and do not approach the essence of who I am. What motivates or drives my decisions? Where do I place my trust? What masks do I wear for particular situations? Why do I always try to cover up feelings, hide emotions, or resist speaking honestly? Do I believe that I am loved and cherished as the unique individual God created me to be? Who am I? What is the meaning of my existence? Where will my life journey lead? Have I learned to walk humbly with Jesus or do I persist following my own stubbornly chosen paths?

There are days when I believe I can answer these questions honestly and sincerely. There are other days, however, when it is so much easier to put on a mask of complacency or indifference. Sometimes my mask is protective and defensive. Other times my mask cracks and I am vulnerable, feeling pain, rejection, betrayal, and deep hurt. I think it is those times of vulnerability when I most strongly feel the presence of God; the assurance that I am not alone, that I am loved: I can trust God to comfort and console, guide and direct, encourage and sustain. These are times when I begin to realize who I am. I am so much more than Sandy, daughter, mother, grandmother, leader, educator, and so forth. I am God's beloved child. God will not hurt or harm me. God wants me to live as Jesus taught: loving, forgiving, healing brokenness, never giving up on myself or others, walking always in truths revealed by Jesus in the gospels. Who am I? I am safe as God's beloved child!

#### The Queenship of the Blessed Virgin Mary August 22




August 22 is the Feast of the Queenship of the Blessed Virgin Mary, a day when we celebrate Mary as the Queen of Heaven and Earth.

The Catholic teaching on this subject is expressed in the papal encyclical *Ad Caeli Reginam*, issued by Pope Pius XII in 1984. It states

that Mary is called Queen of Heaven because her son, Jesus Christ, is the king of Israel and heavenly king of the universe.

Her queenship is a share in Jesus' kingship. We can also recall that in the Old Testament the mother of the king has great influence in court.
