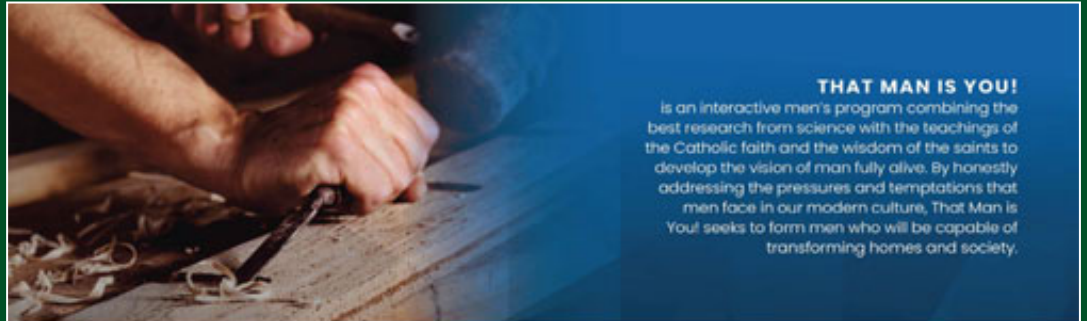

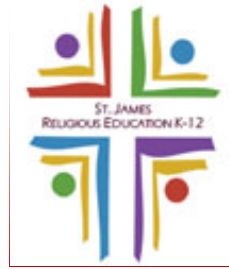

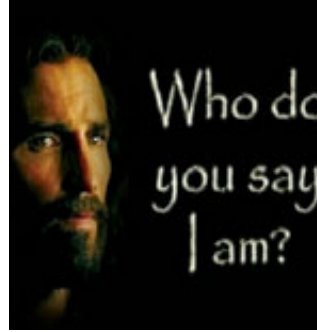

**Come And See
What We're All About**

Someone is Watching and Wondering



In last Sunday's reading from Matthew's gospel, Jesus asked the disciples: "Who do you say I am?" Was Jesus asking for affirmation of himself, or was he questioning the disciples as to their understanding? Only Peter seems to have the right answer: "You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God."

Score one for Peter, but how did Peter understand what it meant to be "the Messiah." The reading this week seems to indicate that although expressing the correct words, his understanding was limited. Most Jews, at that time, believed the Messiah would be a warrior king, like David, who would inflict harm, even death, on the enemies of Israel, bring Israel into a time of great power, and punish fellow Jews who were unfaithful to the law. I think that may have been Peter's thinking also as he appears in the next few verses, unable to accept that Jesus must suffer and die. Jesus' rebuke, however, "Get behind me Satan" seems harsh and out of character.

Reflecting on Jesus' strong statement to Peter presents a reminder to me that I am called to surrender to God's will, even when it appears to lead me to pain, suffering, rejection or even death. My way, my wants, my desires do not necessarily reflect the will of God but perhaps my egotistical need to be in control. Peter, in effect, is denying the will of God. He cannot let go of his belief and understanding of a messiah. Looking further, however, Jesus doesn't tell Peter to get lost, to leave his presence. Instead Jesus instructs Peter to stand behind him, to follow him, allowing Jesus to lead the way, and to accept God's will. Jesus instructs the disciples to take up their crosses, and follow; to lose in order to win; to become little in order to grow and make a difference. Following Jesus is not easy, it requires giving of myself in love, trusting in the presence of the Holy Spirit, with the assurance of God's love. God's ways, God's time, and God's plans for each of us are beyond human understanding. Taking up my cross is struggling through misfortune, pain, suffering, and disappointment, and knowing Jesus suffers with me.

One final thought, regarding Jesus' rebuke of Peter's denial of the truth; Jesus doesn't punish Peter. Jesus forgives, saying in essence: "Peter, let's try this again. Follow me, learn from me, be open to the Father's will, suffer with me, for what you will receive is beyond even your wildest imagination." When Peter finally assumed leadership following the resurrection, he did just that. He accepted God's will, and did the best he could to love and serve.

Who do you say Jesus is? Do you live what you say?

**Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary
September 8**



The Church has celebrated Mary's birth since at least the sixth century. A September birth was chosen because the Eastern Church begins its Church year with September. The September 8 date helped determine the date for the feast of the Immaculate Conception on December 8.

Scripture does not give an account of Mary's birth. However, the apocryphal Protoevangelium of James fills in the gap. This work has no historical value, but it does reflect the development of Christian piety. According to this account, Anna and Joachim are infertile but pray for a child. They receive the promise of a child who will advance God's plan of salvation for the world. Such a story, like many biblical counterparts, stresses the special presence of God in Mary's life from the beginning.

Saint Augustine connects Mary's birth with Jesus' saving work. He tells the earth to rejoice and shine forth in the light of her birth. "She is the flower of the field from whom bloomed the precious lily of the valley. Through her birth the nature inherited from our first parents is changed." The opening prayer at Mass speaks of the birth of Mary's Son as the dawn of our salvation, and asks for an increase of peace.
