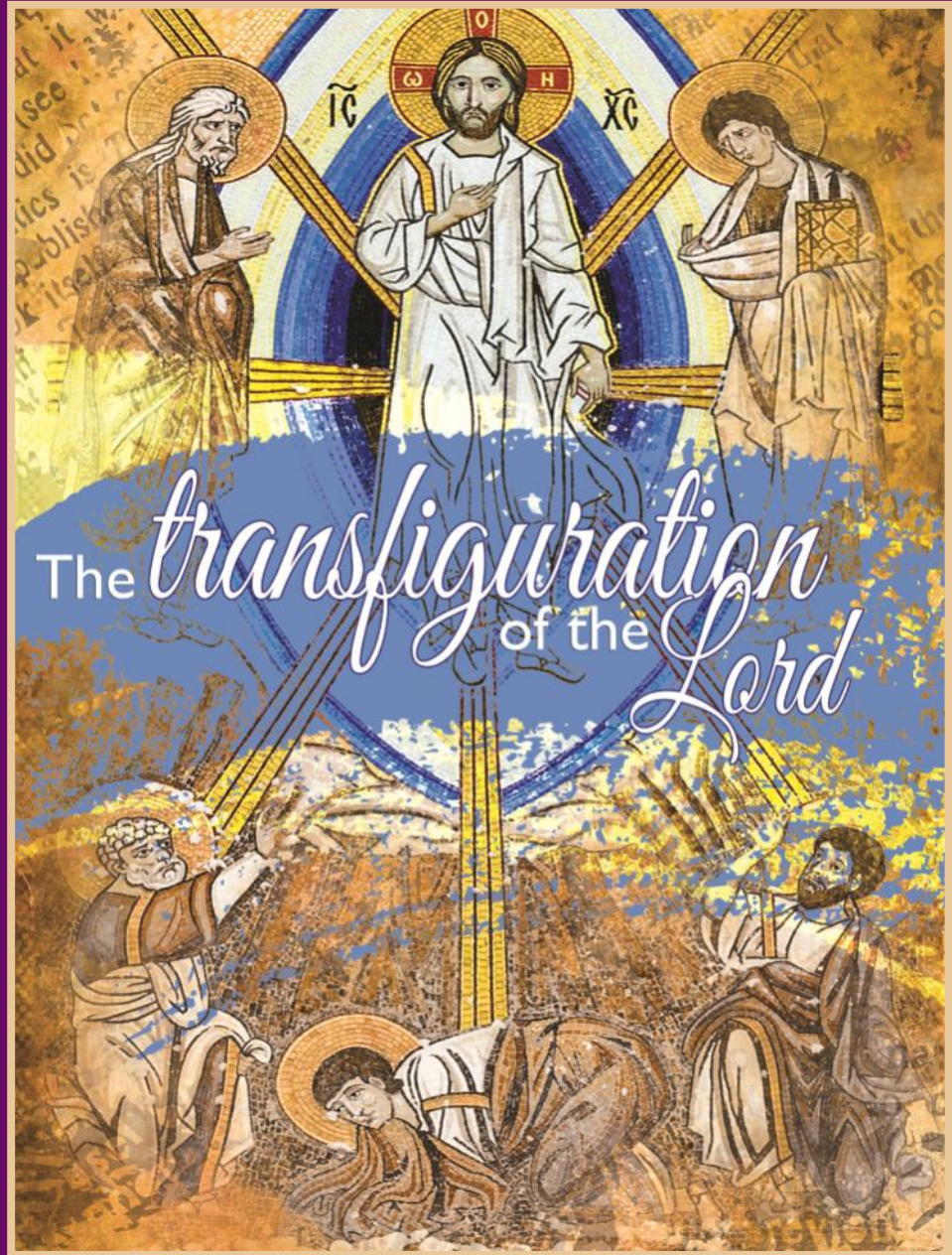

From the Pastor's Pen

Is there anything unchangeable in this world or in this life? What about rocks. Any change? Rocks have existed in our world for millions of years. It seems they don't change. But who knows? Was there a change at the time of the "Big Bang"? Probably. But in the world as we know it today change is a way of being. What is significant is that human beings change daily. Fingernails and hair keep growing. The aging process is on-going. Our minds change all the time as we experience daily life. The significant question for us as believers is: "Do we change in our spiritual life? Does our relationship with God change?" The obvious answer is "yes." That's why the celebration of the Transfiguration of the Lord is so crucial.

When Jesus took Peter, James, and John to the top of the mountain (in reality a high hill) what was the purpose? What was the meaning? Their experience on the mountain was a lesson in discipleship. The apostles came face to face with the glory of the Lord. The appearance of Jesus changed as he appeared to be surrounded by a bright light. That light was a symbol. It was, in truth, a glimpse of glory. How did it change Peter, James, and John? They saw the goal of discipleship: to be in the presence, the glory of God. All the frustrations, all the grief, all the sufferings in this life could be endured with that goal in mind: living in the glory, the perfect happiness of God. They only need faith and perseverance.

So we, disciples of Jesus today, are invited to come up the mountain as part of our Lenten journey. We won't experience the life-changing presence of the glorified Lord as did those apostles. But we are taught the same lesson Jesus taught them: perseverance in faith, even in the midst of trials and hurt and doubts, will bring us to glory, to a peace and joy so great we cannot even imagine it. Our Lenten change? To grow in trust as we reflect on the mountain-top experience of Peter, James, and John, made easier for us with the scene pictured for us behind our altar. It takes faith, a decision, and action that mold us in that effort. Let's embrace the challenge.

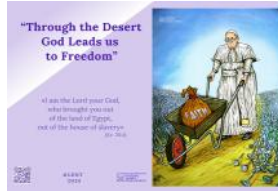

Someone is Watching and Wondering

Lent began on Ash Wednesday, and will conclude March 28, Holy Thursday. In his message, Pope Francis stated: "Lent is a time to free oneself from slavery and take action to free others suffering from the multiple forms of slavery that afflict the world." Even though baptism begins a process of liberation, "there remains in us an inexplicable longing for slavery. A kind of attraction to the **security of familiar things**, to the detriment of our freedom;" a slavery which "stifles dreams, blocks the view of heaven, makes it appear that this world, in which human dignity is trampled upon and authentic bonds are denied, can never change." As I read these words my thoughts immediately went to the daily news in which I am made aware of tragic human suffering caused by wars throughout our world, the plight of refugees and immigrants fleeing desperate living conditions, people who are victims of human trafficking, men, women and children forced to live on the streets, victims of domestic abuse, runaways, persons objectified by sexual abuse and rampant gun violence in the United States of America. All these people are victims of modern-day slavery, and perhaps have lost any sense of joy and love. The daily news brings into our homes a sense of hopelessness and despair. Although I feel their pain, it is from a distance, I cannot understand it. My sense of hopelessness, comes from my perceived inability to implement change. I pray and make monetary donations, yet I do not know how to bring about true peace and dignity to so many who are suffering unimaginable horror. Reading Pope Francis' message (*Through the Desert God Leads us to Freedom*), forced me to question myself.

Can I continue to allow myself to remain under "the rule of Pharaoh," which makes me weary and indifferent, divided, and polluted? Do I cling to the idols of familiarity? Am I attached to money, ideas, traditions, or knowledge without wisdom?

How has the slavery of familiarity taken hold of my life? Lent is a season of conversion, rediscovery of God's call, a time to pause, to seek, stay, and proclaim, to combat the deficit of hope that stifles dreams and leaves hearts frozen in despair. Lent is a time for reflection and discernment; am I ready for Lent; ready for a refocus of my lifestyle? All things are possible with God!

Your Pastoral Council Asks You Not To Give Up Anything For Lent This Year!

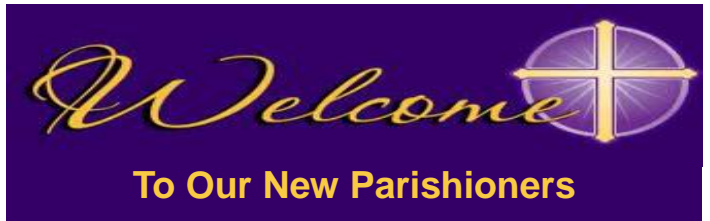

She will be glad to answer your questions and/or can provide information about any of the VA benefits and/or services and also to help individuals in areas such as applying for federal and state benefits.

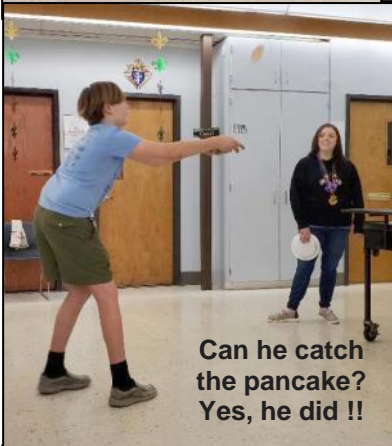

Did You Know?

The goal of Lent is to build new virtues or good habits in our lives through prayer, fasting and/or almsgiving. By doing this we are learning to live a life in which we honor, glorify and thank God for the sacrifice of His Son, Jesus. This week let's talk about prayer. Prayer is simply talking and listening to God. Your prayers don't have to be perfect. Just talk and express your concerns, your hopes and dreams, your needs. After all, prayer helps to build a personal relationship between you and God. Prayer can take many forms as you will see in the ideas below.

1. Take 15 or 30 minutes each day in quiet time by yourself to pray. Get a notebook and write a letter to God each day thanking Him for all His blessings and telling him your concerns and needs.
2. Read about the virtue of and pray for humility. Seek out opportunities to humble yourself in your relationship with others by giving someone else credit or recognition throughout each day.
3. Take some time to read the daily Mass Scripture readings each day. Read Bishop Robert Barron's thoughts each day for better understanding at www.wordonfire.org. There's also a link on this website to the daily readings.
4. Go to Eucharistic Adoration each week on Tuesday and/or Thursday in the chapel. You can make a short visit or try to stay for an hour.
5. Forgive those who have offended you and pray for those who have hurt you.
6. Go to Mass every day. Invite someone who doesn't regularly attend Mass to come to church with you one day during the week.
7. Make a conscious decision before work, chores or study to offer up whatever you are doing in love to God. Do these with joy, not grumbling or griping.
8. Give thanks daily for the trials in your life with the confidence that God will turn them to good.
9. Continually look for the big and small blessings in your life. Keep a gratitude journal.

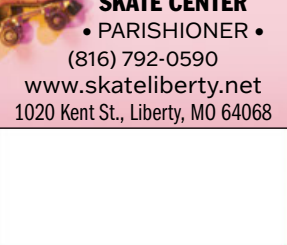
