New Safety Ministry Announced



St. James is taking steps to ensure the safety of all who attend our weekend Masses. Last year the Pastoral Council created the Emergency Assist Ministry to provide first aid for anyone in need. We are now implementing another ministry for the safety of our parishioners.

We are pleased to announce that we are now training POINT OF CONTACT (POC) Ministers.

The POC Ministry will provide one person at each weekend Mass who will function as the person to contact whenever emergency situations arise such as Fire Alarms or Tornado Sirens. This person will direct volunteers to strategic points to assist in evacuations of the sanctuary if the situation warrants it along with other tasks.

WE NEED VOLUNTEERS

Some people have been asked to be POC ministers and they have agreed. We need more. In order to get this ministry operating we need quite a few more volunteers. If you can keep calm in most situations and can effectively lead others during what could be chaotic times then we want to hear from you. We will not schedule a POC minister more often than once per month. Therefore we feel we need about twenty-five trained ministers.

These highlights help answer the question raised by the evening's theme: Who is my neighbor?

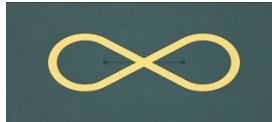

Someone is Watching and Wondering



When Moses encountered God in the burning bush he asked, What is your name? God's reply: "I AM." What a strange reply;

God's name is **I AM**. What does this mean? If asked, who God is, most people will reply with descriptive words such as truth, creator, spirit, life-giving, patient, kind, benevolent, gracious, forgiving, infinite, alpha and omega, incomprehensible, loving. Perhaps you might describe God with a different word or phrase, but can you give God a name? Are we to simply understand God, the I AM, as the eternal existence; the initiator of all that is or ever will be? What, where, and how do I encounter such an existence, the Great I AM? I frequently ask this question of individuals walking their faith journey toward initiation into the Church, and I also re-ask the question following their reception of the sacraments of initiation. Each person's answer is unique and evolving with time, place, experiences, and relationships. I do not believe there is a universally correct answer, there is no way or need to define or "Find God." There is, however, a deep need to "Behold God," to experience and to share God, to become evangelists in thoughts, words, and actions.

There are so many ways I behold God. Upon reflection my first response always seems to be, "I encounter God in the natural world." While that may appear limiting in scope to many (Is she some kind of "tree hugger"?), in my reality the gift of creation, all that God creates, is part of the natural world. There is nothing unnatural about mountains, rivers, seas, valleys or deserts. Plants and animals are natural as is all of humanity. Each person is one of God's beloved children. As such we are given special graces to care for not only one another but also for all the natural world. God gives each person gifts/talents to use for good. Some have the gift of healing, others of creating art and music. There are those who are builders and innovators; scientists developing improved methods for production of goods, searching for cures, and providing new knowledge of our universe. There are those who teach or lead. There are people providing services, preparing meals, shelters, companionship, and keeping our communities safe and clean. Where do I behold God, in all these.

My dad once told me that I was too independent and filled with wanderlust. His words have proved quite truthful. Not only am I filled with a desire to experience different places, but I am also filled with wonder as I experience new people, new situations, and new challenges. There is also significant truth in his description of me as "too independent." I find it so difficult to ask for help, and yet I have found God in the willingness of so many people to offer assistance when they perceive my needs. I am grateful to **Behold** God in every aspect of my life, even when I sin.
