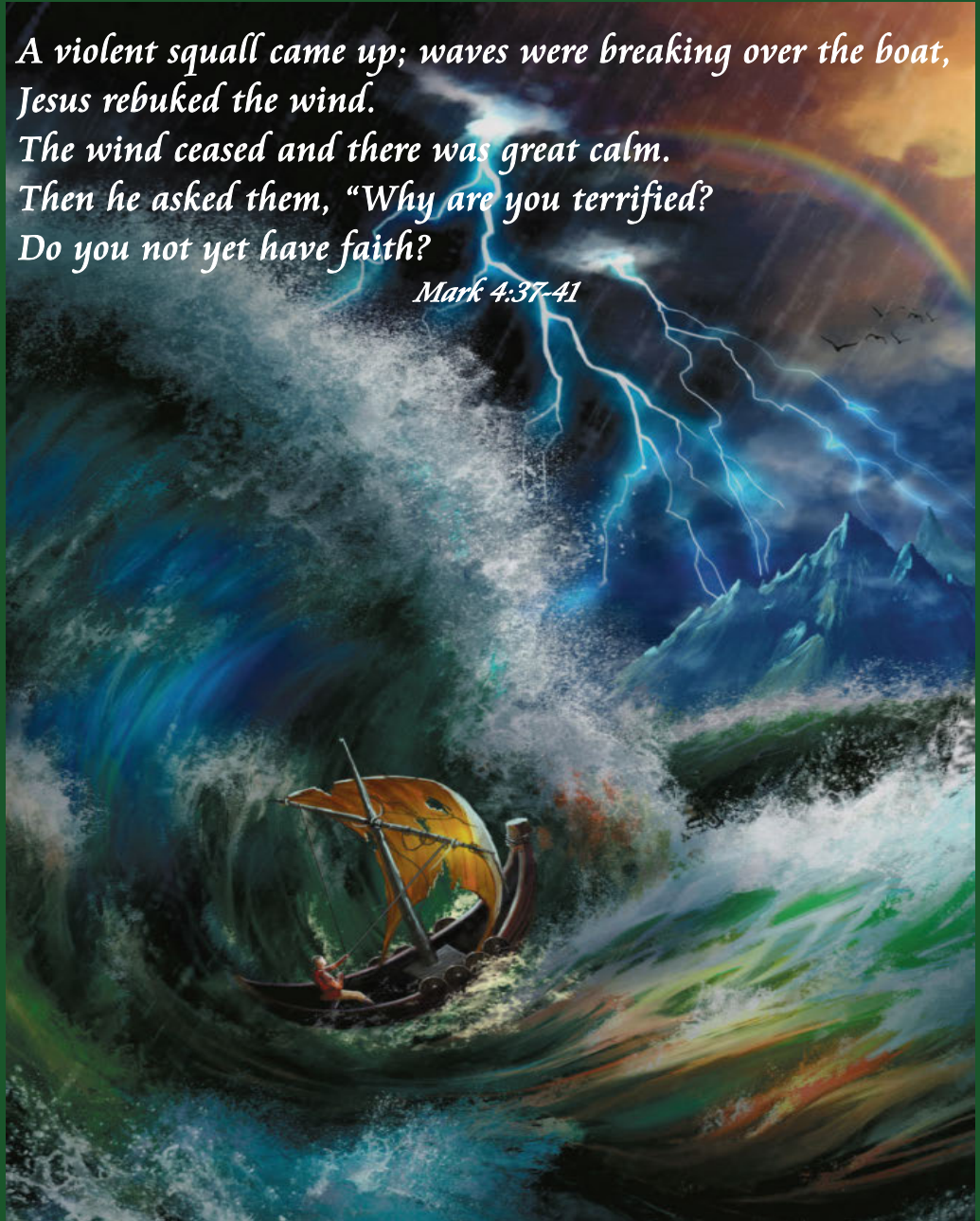

Someone is Watching and Wondering



“This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him” (Matthew 17:5b-6).

How many times I have read and heard these words spoken at the Transfiguration of Jesus, and so beautifully depicted in the mural which graces our worship space.

Two week ago, however, this was the image I saw during the concert given to us by the Liberty Community Chorus, an ecumenical group which brings both music and beautiful prayer experiences to our community. As I listened to their voices raised in song, and witnessed this natural illumination, I felt that God was speaking directly to me: “I have given you this gift, my Son, listen to Him, trust His words, follow Him, even if you do not understand where He is leading you.” I felt my heart soaring with the music, giving praise to God, and strengthening my desire to be bathed in God's glorious light, light radiating from Jesus and illuminating everything and everyone willing to lift their faces to Him. I realized how anxious I often become at trivial matters but also how peaceful I feel when I open myself to His love. Jesus, I desire to be with you. I desire to walk in your light. I desire your love and forgiveness. I desire to do God's will.

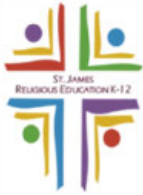
Sunday, June 9th, thanks to the work and dedication of Danny Baker, we at St. James had the opportunity to once again participate in prayer through music. Chant Clair lead us in worship at the 10:30 Mass followed by the beautiful, spirit filled music of our own Liberty Chorus. For me, beautiful music not only lifts my soul but also brings me to a heightened sense of worship and prayer. I do not have a particular exceptional voice, but I cannot attend Mass without joining our cantors, choir, and congregation in lifting my voice to God in song. I found myself also lifting my voice (in a soft whisper) as the Liberty Community Chorus sang. I felt part of a much greater community of voices lifting voices to God, remembering once again, the angels who at the birth of Jesus proclaimed: “Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace to those on whom his favor rests” (Luke: 2:14). The above image which I took during the Liberty Community Chorus' gift of music, reminded me that God's glory also rests on me. I am one of God's beloved children, never forgotten, always loved, and always forgiven. God simply asks that I open myself to an honest relationship; one shown through love, mercy, and forgiveness offered to my fellow brothers and sisters. I believe God continues to admonish me to recognize and listen to Jesus, the beloved Son as I strive to do God's will caring for and forgiving others.

The Nativity of St. John the Baptist Monday, June 24



John the Baptist was a contemporary of Christ who was known for evangelization and his baptizing of Jesus Christ. When Jesus came to him to be baptized, John recognized him and said, "It is I who need baptism from you."

He was born through the intercession of God to Zachariah and Elizabeth, who was otherwise too old to bear children. According to scriptures, the Angel Gabriel visited Elizabeth and Zachariah to tell them they would have a son and that they should name him John. Zachariah was skeptical and for this he was rendered mute until the time his son was born and named John, in fulfillment of God's will.

When Elizabeth was pregnant with John, she was visited by Mary, and John leapt in her womb. This revealed to Elizabeth that the child Mary carried was to be the Son of God.

Saints Peter and Paul Feast Day June 29



These two saints are the founders of the See of Rome, through their preaching, ministry and martyrdom there.

Peter, who was named Simon, was a fisherman of Galilee. Jesus gave him the name Cephas (Petrus in Latin), which means

'Rock', because he was to become the rock upon which Christ would build His Church.

St. Paul was the Apostle of the Gentiles. His letters are included in the writings of the New Testament, and through them we learn much about his life and the faith of the early Church.

In the year 395, St. Augustine of Hippo said of Saints Peter and Paul: "Both apostles share the same feast day, for these two were one; and even though they suffered on different days, they were as one. Peter went first, and Paul followed. And so we celebrate this day made holy for us by the apostles' blood.



Religious freedom allows the Church, and all religious communities, to live out their faith in public and to serve the good of all.

Respect for Sacred Spaces

Pray that all people of faith would be free to gather in houses of worship without fear.

The very nature of a sacred space is that it is set apart from other spaces as a place to seek communion with the divine and thus should be treated with respect. In a pluralistic society such as ours, respect for sacred spaces is especially vital for the sake of civil peace, which is part of the common good.

In recent years, a wave of vandalism and arson has hit Catholic churches and statues. There have been over 320 attacks so far, and that number steadily continues to grow. Christians are not alone in defending their sacred spaces.

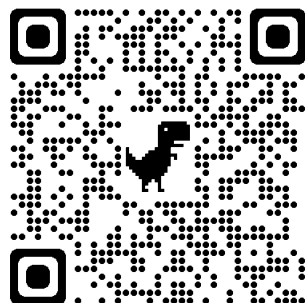
Terrorist attacks against Israel and ensuing outbreak of war caused antisemitic incidents in the U.S. to skyrocket, including shocking displays of open hatred, with acts of anti-Muslim hatred committed as well.

There is no greater threat to religious liberty than for one's house of worship to become a place of danger, and the country sadly finds itself in a place where that danger is real.

We Catholics can express our solidarity with the whole human family by working to build a culture where all houses of worship are treated with respect.

This week the focus is on the importance of preserving the essential right of religious freedom, both now and in the future, for Catholics and all people of faith.

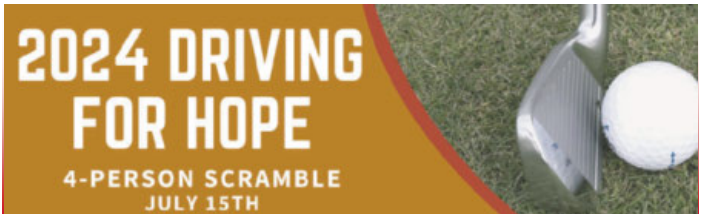
Military Outreach Ministry

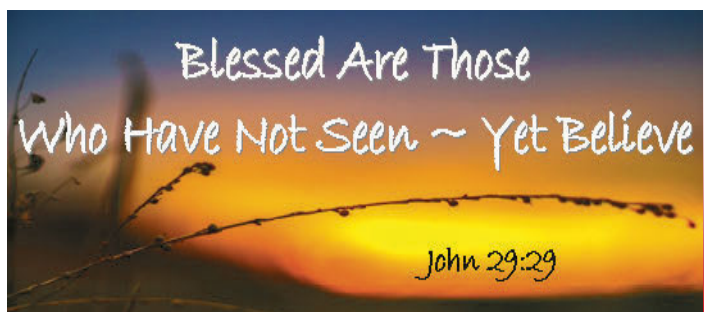

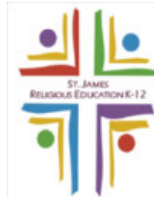

Confirmation

The 2024-2025 Confirmation Program is open to those in 8th and 9th grades or older.

Parents AND Sponsors will need to attend an informational meeting on Sunday, August 18th, 2024, at either 9:15am or 6:00pm. This meeting is for parents and sponsors only and will last approximately one hour.

Confirmation Classes will meet on the 1st and 3rd Sundays of the month beginning in September. (Exceptions to these dates are the service day on Saturday, November 30, 2024 and the retreat January 17-18, 2025). An official detailed schedule will be emailed to families after they have registered.

Please begin to discern your teen's sponsor now. A sponsor is someone that will walk with the teen through their journey towards Confirmation. The sponsor must be at least 16 years old and a Confirmed, active, participating Catholic. Information on choosing a sponsor can be found on the St. James website. Please note, there will be sessions/experiences on the schedule in which the sponsor will need to attend with the teen.

Teens will also need to choose a Confirmation Saint. We choose a Saint at Confirmation as someone to look up to and emulate. More information on choosing a Saint will be shared at the first class and can be found on the St. James website.

All communication regarding Confirmation will take place through Email and the Remind app. Once you have completed the registration, you will be added to the email list. To join the Remind group, text "@stj-confirm" to 81010. Parents are responsible for checking their email on a weekly basis for Confirmation updates.

This year's Confirmation fee is \$75. Cost includes a retreat fee. Arrangements and scholarships will be available. Finances will not prevent any student from preparing for/receiving the Sacrament.

Dates for Confirmation are Wednesday, February 26th, 2025 and Friday, March 21st, 2025, both at 7pm (more details will be shared at a later date).

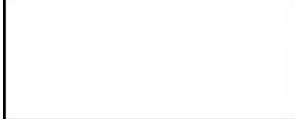

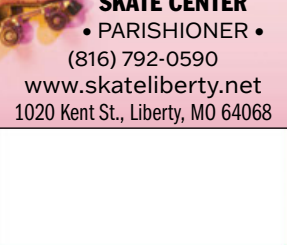
