


Someone is Watching and Wondering



Last week I ended with these words: "I wonder, will my Lord judge me as a sheep or a goat?" Today I wish to address my personal follow-up to those words with this question: "What would I do if Jesus came for a visit?"

Knowing my nature, my Martha self, I am sure if I knew in advance I would clean my house, prepare a guest room with clean linens, make sure the lawn and gardens were in near perfect condition, plan, shop, and prepare a special meal, and set a somewhat formal table. Then I would shower, wash and fix my hair, dress for a special occasion, and perhaps even wear jewelry. I would greet Jesus with a smile, invite him to a comfortable chair, and offer him something to drink. Sitting at the table we would offer thanks to God, and I would make sure Jesus was the first to be served.

Conversely, what would I do if there was no advanced planning and Jesus simply knocked at my door? This time of year I would be wearing shorts, a comfortable tee shirt, and be barefoot. The house might be dusty, but relatively clean, and the outside lawn and gardens presentable. Perhaps I would be preparing a simple meal, reading, or enjoying a cooling drink. I want to believe that, even though his visit would be a surprise, I would recognize him, invite him into my home and offer hospitality. I think then my Mary personality would appear. I have such a desire to talk with Jesus, to listen to his words, to ask questions, and learn from him. Perhaps I would be embarrassed by my appearance, however, I know Jesus sees me both at my best and at my worst. I feel I would be less anxious over a surprise visit and perhaps more myself, stripped of the masks behind which I often hide.

How, however, would I answer his guestions about following his teachings (helping the poor, welcoming the stranger, giving of myself, my time and my treasure to others). What would Jesus think of all the "stuff" in my house, even the size of my house? Would he ask me to sell what I have and give to the needy? Would he ask me to leave everything and become his disciple, following where ever he leads? I don't know how I would answer him. What I do know, however, is that in some mystical way Jesus visits me everyday, wherever I am, and whatever I am doing. He guides me, encourages me, and helps me to take steps to live simply, to share his words, and shine his light for others in need. I realize that being a disciple of Jesus is a life-long journey of discovery, challenges, and change. Following rules is not enough, and certainly I am far from perfect, but each day, I feel gratitude for life. I feel blessed by his grace and embraced by his love. I think, perhaps, I am learning to love, as Jesus teaches, even in my solitude. I am learning to share the pain of others. I am learning to let go of personal wants and desires and seek his presence above all things. I believe I am learning the true meaning of the prayer he gave to us. I feel that at any and all times I can call "Abba, be with me, come into my life and lead me. I love you!" Jesus will forever be with me.

Help Love INC Supply Hygiene Kits for Low Income Kids in Clay County

Children living in poverty often go back to school without the basic items needed to help them manage proper hygiene.

When we asked kids what they needed for back-toschool, they said they wanted to "look good" and "smell good." That is why we work with local school districts and area churches to provide low-income families with pre-assembled hygiene kits at the start of each school year. And the items aren't those tiny, hotel size products. They are full sized hygiene items.

How You Can Help

First, encourage your friends to collect the items, placing them in one-gallon freezer bags (one of each item per bag for a total of six items in a bag. We will need an equal number of boy and girl bags.

The clear freezer bags will help us identify which bags are for the boys and which are for the girls. We need a total of 600 kits.

Here are the items the kids will need:

Toothpaste (2.5-5 oz)

Toothbrushes (adult)

Body Wash (12-18 oz, men's and women's) (avoid larger sizes)

Shampoo (men's and women's) (you can substitute a "3-in-1" for a wash and a shampoo) Bar Soap (bath size)

Deodorant (1.5-2.5 oz stick (men's and women's)

Second, you can send donations to help Love INC purchase the colorful, nylon, string-tie gym bags that make up the "kits." Because we purchase the bags in bulk, they only cost us about \$1 each. We will need 600 bags. When the bags are distributed, the kids will be able to select the color of bag they like best, and then the freezer bag kit will be placed inside the nylon bag and given to the child.

Third, you can help us distribute the bags. If you can help, let us know and we will let you know where and when, typically the first or second week of August. We already have confirmations from the Liberty School District and the Kearney School District.

Please bring the completed bags to Love INC no later than Wednesday, July 24.

You can bring the bags any Monday through Thursday between 10am and 3pm, or by appointment by calling (816) 994-6927.

St. Benedict Feast Day - July 11



On July 11, we celebrate the feast of Saint Benedict of Nursia, the sixth -century abbot who gave Christian monasticism its lasting foundation in Western Europe.

He was born in Italy during the year 486. As a young man he spent

three years in solitude, facing and overcoming severe temptations through prayer and asceticism. Only after doing so, did he have the confidence to emerge as an organizer of monastic communities. His first monasteries were established in the Anio valley outside Subiaco, Italy.

St. Benedict was also the patron saint of Pope Benedict XVI's pontificate. In a 2005 general audience, the Pope said St. Benedict was a "powerful reminder of the indispensable Christian roots" of Europe. He cited the monk's instruction to "prefer nothing to the love of Christ," and asked his intercession "to help us keep Christ firmly at the heart of our lives."




