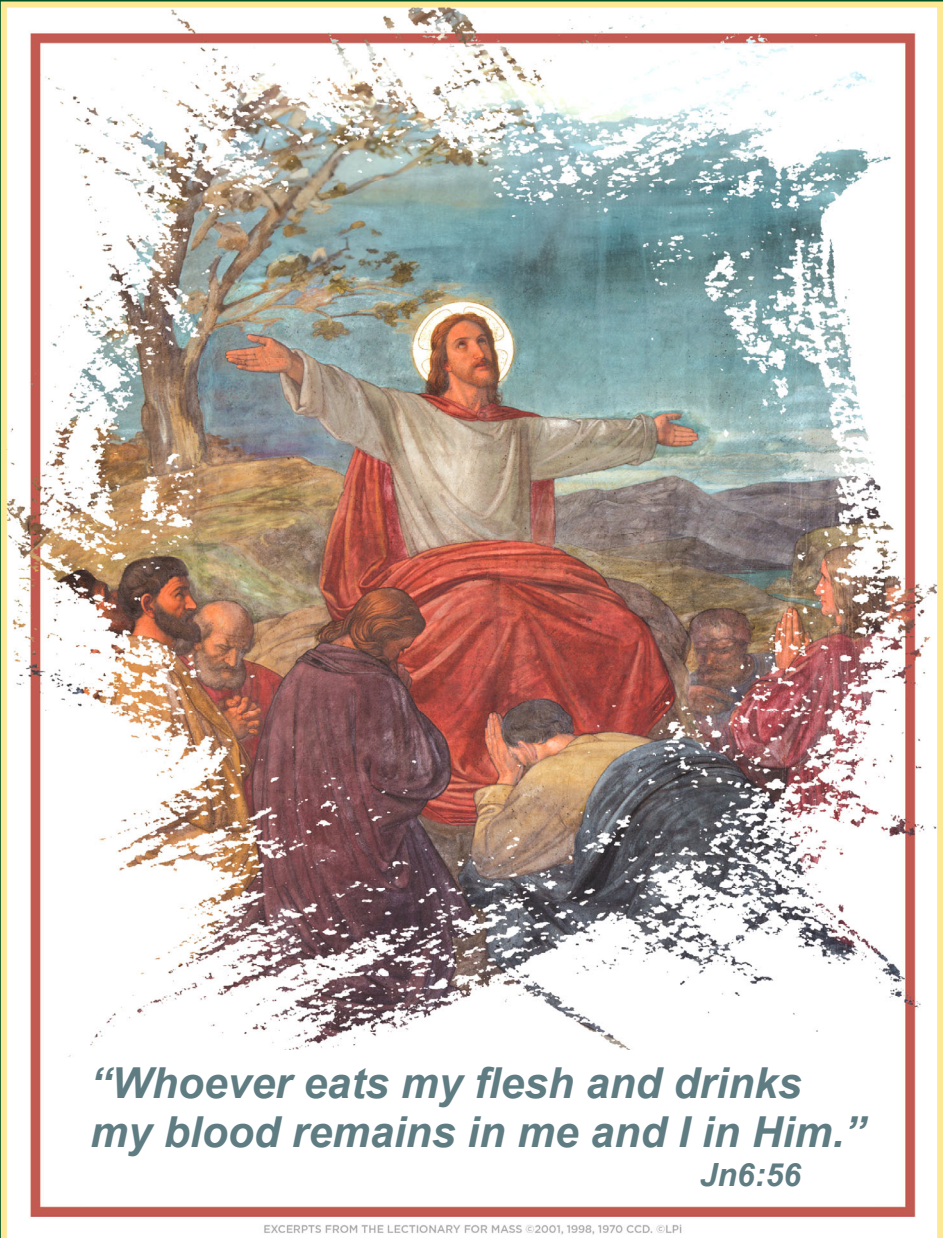

Someone is Watching and Wondering

BUT THE FRUIT OF THE SPIRIT IS LOVE JOY PEACE PATIENCE KINDNESS GOODNESS FAITHFULNESS GENTLENESS & SELF-CONTROL
Galatians 5:22-23

I recently found this image at “Upper Room Daily Devotional” which is taken from the Letter to the Galatians (5:22-23). Just prior to this quote in verses 19-21 we read “Now the works of the flesh are obvious: immorality, impurity, licentiousness, idolatry, sorcery, hatreds, rivalry, jealousy, outbursts of fury, acts of selfishness, dissensions, factions, occasions of

envy, drinking bouts, orgies and the like. I warn you, as I warned you before that those who do such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.” Fr. Richard Rohr wrote: “In contrast to every other kingdom that has been and ever will be, this kingdom belongs to the poor. . .to the peacemakers, the merciful, and those who hunger and thirst for God. . .those from the margins and the bottom rungs will be lifted up to places of honor. . .this kingdom knows no geographic boundaries, no political parties, no single language or culture. It advances not through power and might, but through acts of love and joy and peace, missions of mercy and kindness and humility.”

The word *ekklesia* (church) was used during Jesus’ time to refer to the assembled people of God. People, called from sin, and the old ways of doing things in the world, into community, participating together as outward signs of God’s kingdom. To me, therefore, it seems that the purpose of church and the sacraments is to glimpse and point others in the direction of the fullness of God’s kingdom. Perhaps the kingdom is like serving at St. Mary’s food kitchen, or St. James place. Perhaps the kingdom is found helping at a homeless shelter, nursing home, Harvester’s food pantry, or journeying with an individual facing personal demons, family crisis, loss of a loved one, illness, or loneliness. Perhaps a glimpse of the kingdom is found in lifting another in prayer, listening, and engaging in nonviolent /defensive conservation. Perhaps the kingdom is found in continuing our journey of faith.

There are many people who are searching for a church, a community of believers who are welcoming and sharing; a community willing to share their faith, traditions, and mission. As the Director of Adult Initiation, I believe St. James is such a community, and I invite you or someone you know to begin a new journey of worship, service, and mission with me and my team. Where ever you are at this moment, we will walk with you towards discovering how you are being called into God’s kingdom and perhaps full initiation into the Roman Catholic faith tradition. We gather every Sunday (except Christmas and Easter) at 9:00am, in the parish office conference room, to share our communal journey. Join us, imperfect people in an imperfect world doing our best to be outward signs of God’s grace, mercy, and love.

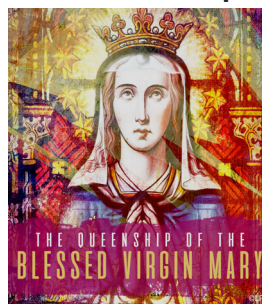

Depolarizing Ourselves

The first steps toward civil engagement

An Introductory Workshop for Faith Communities

For people of faith, who understand that civil discourse begins in recognizing the image of God in our conversational partner. Mutual respect, not agreement, is an essential key to a healthy discussion. This workshop addresses how each of us may inadvertently be complicit in or possibly even encourage polarization.

What you will experience?

Depolarizing Ourselves is a 90-minute workshop designed to help lessen the effects of polarization when you encounter them in your conversations. We can have healthy disagreements over issues or philosophy. We must resist seeing larger groups of ordinary people on the other side of our own politics as enemies.

Who Can Attend?

Anyone interested in examining their own inner polarization

- ◆ Those who wish to become more aware of their own "inner polarizer"
- ◆ Suggestions for how to interact without demonizing, dismissing, or stereotyping large swaths of the population.

In our current political climate, much of our conflict stems not from healthy disagreement over policies, issues, or philosophy. It's created by emotional, rancor-escalating, and highly polarizing conversations that we have with others. This workshop will help you reframe how you view the other side in the face of disagreements around politics, or any other subject. Successfully "taming" our inner polarizer starts with recognizing our tendencies to make harmful generalizations about the other side. This requires acknowledging how we often attribute negative intent and motivations to the other side without first trying to understand them.

Religious Education 2024/2025 Year

The first day of classes for all RE programs will be in September!

Registrations are now underway for PreK-7th grade RE, First Sacraments, Confirmation, and Camino. Thank you to those who have already registered!

As our parish transitions to the new Confirmation age being guided by The Way initiative, it is important your child is attending a religious education program from Kindergarten on. For those students who are incoming 5th, 6th, and 7th grade, you will be some of the first teens to receive Confirmation at the younger age and the next couple of years will be focused on preparation for this sacrament with you.

Families with 2nd graders or older and who intend for the child to receive first sacraments this year, your child must be enrolled in a religious education program AND First Sacrament preparation. Please note – these are two separate enrollments. School families will only need to enroll in First Sacraments.

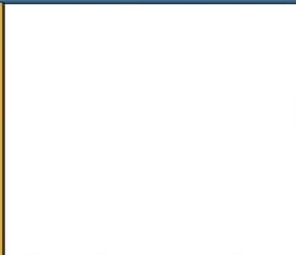

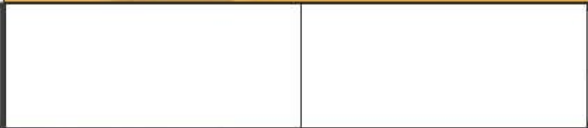
