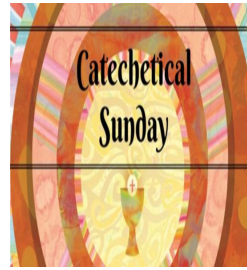
Mission Statement

Someone is Watching and Wondering



Recently, a good friend of mine, Mary Elizabeth, lost her decades long battle with cancer. She had been a colleague of mine, an amazing art teacher, and someone with whom I shared tears, challenges, and hearty laughter. Her daughter, Marina and my grandson Michael were born the same year and have also remained friends, even though their lives have taken them in different directions and to different places. At Mary Beth's visitation I was reunited with other colleagues, friends and her extended family. We shared stories and remembrances, accompanied by laughter and tears.

For me, life seems to pass too quickly and I continue to encounter many people who struggle with daily living and others who always seem at peace, filled with joy, and gratitude for every moment of each day. I believe these people, regardless of religion or nonreligion, ethnicity, cultural setting, economic status, or country, are people of love who unselfishly give themselves to others with compassion, empathy, and honest concern. They are lifegiving, not life-draining people. They support and protect rather than use, objectify, and destroy the gifts of creation and humanity. Their joy comes in helping others climb out of dark places, overcome disappointments, grieve with love, and welcome each day with anticipation of what is possible.

I recently read that because we love someone or something, we grieve their passing, yet grief is that love which persists. I believe that grieving does not erase our pain but rather enlightens our ability to love, restoring life with the light and love of Jesus, often expressed through cherished relationships with one another through their abiding love, concern, and care. I have lost family members, close friends, and many wonderful members of my faith community. With each year I become one of the seniors; fewer and fewer acquaintances are older than I am. Yet I do not feel sad as I age, yes stiff and sore at times and even discouraged at my every growing need for assistance. Every day, however, there is something that fills me with joy. I feel closer to my constant companion, Jesus, but I also feel great peace accepting others, just as they are. Journeying with and encouraging them to discover their goodness and unique path toward loving service.

My friend Mary Beth's memory card had these words: "I'd like the memory of me to be a happy one. I'd like to leave an after glow of smiles when life is done. I'd like to leave an echo whispering softly down the ways; of happy times and laughing times and bright and sunny days. I'd like the tears of those who grieve, to dry before the sun; of happy memories that I leave when life is done." These words truly reflect her; a lady who was life-giving.


