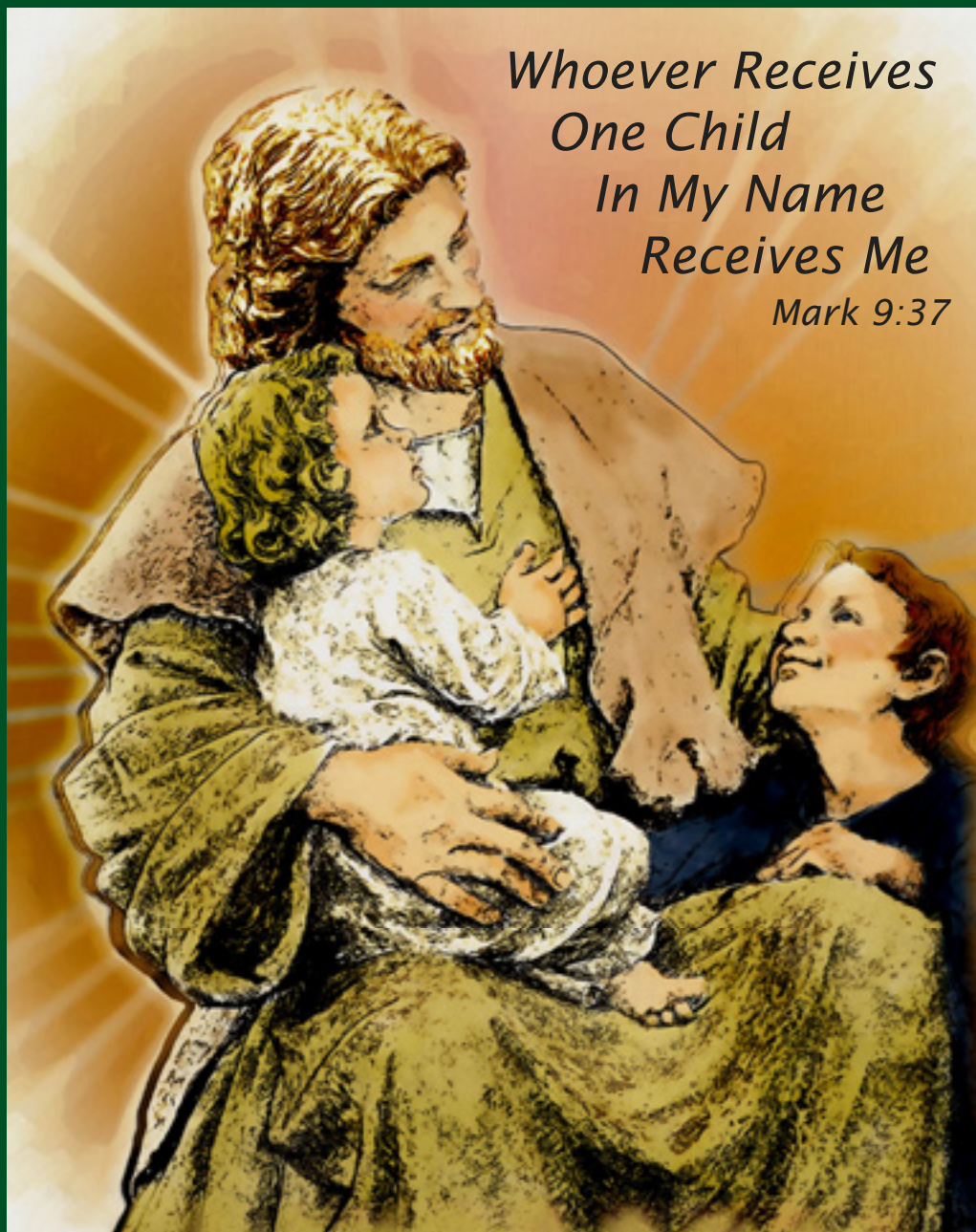

## From the Pastor's Pen

A history-making event took place in our Catholic Church family last year with the meeting of a synod in Rome, October 4-28, 2023, with 365 participants. They sat at round tables in the assembly hall, a very visible symbol that all at the table were equals in the discussions. Those at the table included the Pope himself, Cardinals, bishops, priests, Sisters, lay men and women. Recall that in preparation for the Synod, listening sessions were held around the world in parishes and meeting places. All were invited to these sessions, all invited to speak, all invited to share their reflections. The minutes from these sessions were sent to the diocese, and then to the national bishop's conference, and then to continental places and finally to Rome. A select group spent much time going through all the data and coming up with a synthesis. That synthesis statement was in the hands of all the participants at the first Synod meeting in Rome. Some of the conclusions of the discussions include: new ministerial for the laity, increase of lay participation in decision-making; processes to evaluate the performance of bishops; and dealing with controversial issues in the Church. The discussions were rooted in the Sacred Scripture, Tradition, and the teachings of the Second Vatican Council.

Now a second session of the Synod will take place, beginning next week on October 2, and concluding on October 27. The same format will be used. On-going discussion will focus on how to be a synodal church in mission. Preceding the second session, local churches have carried out their work through the Bishops' Conferences. They seek to put a style of synodality into practice. Comments have been received from international sources. A document is being prepared called the "Instrumentum Laboris" which will be a guide for the participants at the second session.

You may think: What does all this have to do with me or with this parish? You may ignore or disregard this great moment in the Church. I would ask that you keep an open mind and heart. Take an interest. Keep in touch with what is happening. We are the Church. We are the People of God. The way we worship affects others.

Pray for the participants at the second session.

My prayers are with all of you.

## Someone is Watching and Wondering



Although many people have written about going through a dark night of the soul, including St. Mother Teresa, *Dark Night of the Soul* was originally the title of a poem

written by St. John of the Cross, a Spanish Catholic priest, mystic and Carmelite friar of *converso* origin who lived from 1542 until 1591. St. John of the Cross, in his treatise and commentary entitled *Dark Night*, described the dark night of the soul, as a stage of passive, final, and complete purification, marked by confusion, helplessness, stagnation of will, and a sense of the withdrawal of God's presence; a period of "unselfing" and surrender to the hidden purposes of God's divine will.

There have been periods throughout my life, when I felt as though I was experiencing a dark night of my existence. I felt confused, helpless, stagnant, and a sense that God was on vacation, abandoning me. I never doubted God's existence, but I did not feel God's divine presence holding me up and guiding me through the darkness. During one of these dark periods, I left the church community, in which I had worshiped my entire life, for fifteen years, and tried to find meaning and answers to my many "Whys?" through rational reasoning. I now know that God's spirit, love, and grace lead me to return to a faith community, specifically to St. James Catholic Church. In my search, coming to St. James did not feel like a blessing, but rather my attempt to find answers and direction. Instead I found a family of faith; so many people who supported me and gave me strength to persevere, fall in love with Jesus, and trust in the goodness and mercy of God. Jesus' time in prayer in the Garden of Gethsemane before his arrest, became for me an assurance that I can trust God and eventually be lead into the light of forgiveness, mercy, salvation, hope, joy, inner peace, and love. Although at times I still pray that God will remove my cup of suffering and pain, I also pray that I will have the strength to accept God's will. I pray that can and will surrender to the divine will, like Jesus and Mary, allowing God's care and mercy to flow through me.

I do not feel that I have passed through my final dark night. I do not sense that I have passed through my final purification nor completely surrendered to God's will. You might say, even at seventy-five years of age I am still a "work in progress." There are yet many paths to surrender. I also believe I am capable of functioning as God's instrument, especially in my encounters and relationships with others. Possibly I will experience other dark nights, but I know that God does not go on vacations of abandonment. God is always present, calling me to God's loving embrace. The big question is "Will I try to hide inside my self-centeredness, or will I fall lovingly into God's presence?"

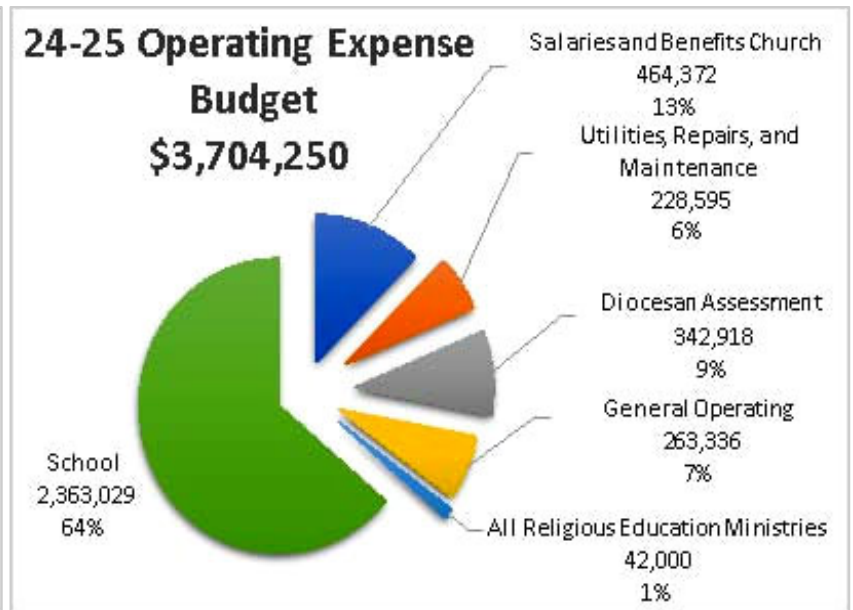
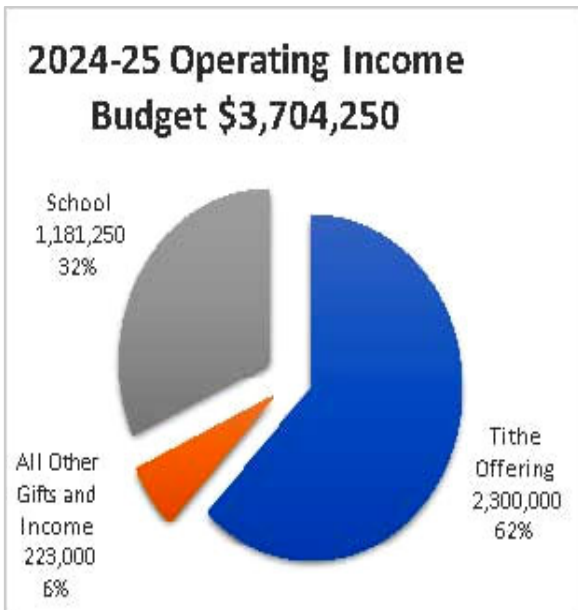
### Operating Income and Expense
