PREPARING FOR DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY



In preparation for Divine Mercy Sunday, the Lord asked St. Faustina to make a Novena of Prayer from Good Friday to the following Saturday.

These nine days of prayer before Divine Mercy Sunday are like the nine days of prayer in the Upper Room before the day of Pentecost. For each of the nine days our Lord gave St. Faustina a different intention.

Each of us can make a Novena of Prayer for these intentions and others by praying the novena on pages 7 and 8 of this bulletin.

If you are on the St. James email list you will receive the Novena intentions and prayers for each day beginning on Good Friday.

A Special Promise of Mercy

Our Lord's promise to grant complete forgiveness of sins and punishment on the Feast of Mercy is recorded three times in the *Diary of St. Faustina*.

I want to grant a complete pardon to the souls that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion on the Feast of My mercy (*Diary* 1109).

Whoever approaches the Fountain of Life on this day will be granted complete forgiveness of sins and punishment (*Diary* 300).

The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion will obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment (*Diary* 699).

It's allowed for one to go to confession up to 20 days before or after Divine Mercy Sunday.

From the Pastor's Pen

This weekend, we begin a special week – Holy Week!

On this Palm Sunday, we reflect on Jesus' solemn entry into Jerusalem and we hear the Proclamation of the Gospel, the Passion of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Jesus enters Jerusalem, knowing that as the crowds welcomed Him and cheered with Him with 'Hosanna, Hosanna, the Son of David', that same crowd would yell 'Crucify Him' on Good Friday.

We celebrate the Passion, Death and Resurrection of Jesus this coming week.

Each evening of the Triduum (the three Sacred Days), we will re-enact the drama unfolding. On Holy Thursday, when we celebrate the Mass of the Lord's Supper, Jesus gives us His Body and Blood to renew the gift of Life within us, and we wash the feet of folks, just as Jesus washed the feet of the Apostles.

On Good Friday *there is "no Mass."* This is because technically, the Mass from Holy Thursday has not ended. We call upon the Prayers of all the Church and the world, and once again listen to the Passion of Jesus Christ, according to John. We then receive the Eucharist that was consecrated the night before. Then we exit in silence, to await the Easter Vigil, when we proclaim the Readings from Genesis and the creation of the world to the Proclamation of the Resurrection of Jesus from the Dead.

We renew our own Baptismal vows, and rejoice with the Baptism, Confirmation and reception into the Catholic Church of our newly Baptized and Confirmed who have received the gift of the Eucharist for the first time.

Our Church is once again renewed with New Life.

Come and join us each evening of the Triduum at 7:00pm.

Masses on Easter morning will be at 7:30, 9:30 And 11:30am. There is no 5:00pm Mass.

May this Holy Week and Triduum be a 'Blessed' time for your families, and may we know the Peace that Christ has in mind for all of us.

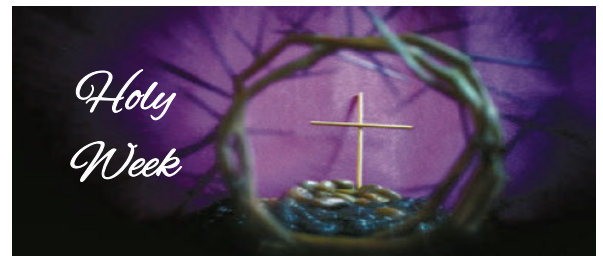

Someone is Watching and Wondering



We all know the story: "Hosannas" lead to "Crucify him!"

My thoughts today as our palm branches are blessed and we transition to Christ's pas-

sion, however, are drawn to the reality that not much has changed: Our celebrations and shouts of joy all too quickly turn to condemnation and scapegoating: "I'm not at fault, someone else is to blame; he/she made me act this way; we need to get rid of these people then everything will be great!" Sound familiar? Just look at social media and you will realize how prevalent these sentiments are in our culture. Read a newspaper, watch news reporting on your television, or listen to a "talk show." Even movies and TV shows meant for entertainment are filled with dissent and division. I think we humans exhibit dualistic natures. (By that I mean we have conflicting ideas and personalities within ourselves.) We jump between exhilaration and bitterness, community and separation, even love and hate. We see this in the crowds surrounding Jesus and we see it in our society. Where is my true community of oneness and unifying dependence created by God? Why am I so weak that I fail to have open dialogue, civil communication, while continuing to put up barriers to resolving differences? When will I embrace common ground, respect and care for others whatever their station in life, and willingly sacrifice to care for our amazing planet? When will I let go of my selfish, self-center wants and desires? Why can't I bury my ego once and for all? When will I finally surrender to Christ, my life and my love, learning to love as He loves?

Today, as I enter once again into this most holy and sacred week, my fervent prayer is to let go and let God control/guide my thoughts, wants, desires, and actions. When I feel like hiding within myself, may God lead me to fear not and to begin the hard work to become a faithful and faith-filled Catholic Christian. Jesus help me to respond to your call. Help me to praise without turning to condemnation. Give me the strength and courage to go where I am called. Help me turn from personal pain and hurt to forgiveness. Allow me to see you in others, embrace your love, feel your mercy, and share your glory with my brothers and sisters. Help me Lord to feel you within my heart, to hear your voice, and walk with those in darkness leading them into your light. Lord I cannot do anything without you. I desire to sing Hosannah without "Crucify Him." My prayer is to love and serve as you taught. I am tired of trying to live and act on my own. I love you and desire you.

THE NOVENA TO THE DIVINE MERCY

Jesus asked that the Feast of the Divine Mercy be preceded by a Novena to the Divine Mercy which would begin on Good Friday. He gave St. Faustina an intention to pray for on each day of the Novena. In her diary, St. Faustina wrote that Jesus told her: "On each day of the novena you will bring to My heart a different group of souls and you will immerse them in this ocean of My mercy. On each day you will beg My Father, on the strength of My passion, for the graces for these souls."

FIRST DAY - GOOD FRIDAY - APRIL 18

Today bring to Me all mankind, especially all sinners, and immerse them in the ocean of My mercy.

Most Merciful Jesus, whose very nature it is to have compassion on us and to forgive us, do not look upon our sins but upon our trust which we place in Your infinite goodness. Receive us all into the abode of Your Most Compassionate Heart, and never let us escape from It. We beg this of You by Your love which unites You to the Father and the Holy Spirit.

Eternal Father, turn Your merciful gaze upon all mankind and especially upon poor sinners, all enfolded in the Most Compassionate Heart of Jesus. For the sake of His sorrowful Passion show us Your mercy, that we may praise the omnipotence of Your mercy for ever and ever. Amen.

SECOND DAY - HOLY SATURDAY - APRIL 19

Today bring to Me the souls of priests and religious, and immerse them in My unfathomable mercy.

Most Merciful Jesus, from whom comes all that is good, increase Your grace in men and women consecrated to Your service, that they may perform worthy works of mercy; and that all who see them may glorify the Father of Mercy who is in heaven.

Eternal Father, turn Your merciful gaze upon the company of chosen ones in Your vineyard upon the souls of priests and religious; and endow them with the strength of Your blessing. For the love of the Heart of Your Son in which they are enfolded, impart to them Your power and light, that they may be able to guide others in the way of salvation and with one voice sing praise to Your boundless mercy for ages without end. Amen.

THIRD DAY - EASTER SUNDAY - APRIL 20

Today bring to Me all devout and faithful souls, and immerse them in the ocean of My mercy.

Most Merciful Jesus, from the treasury of Your mercy, You impart Your graces in great abundance to each and all. Receive us into the abode of Your Most Compassionate Heart and never let us escape from It. We beg this grace of You by that most wondrous love for the heavenly Father with which Your Heart burns so fiercely.

Eternal Father, turn Your merciful gaze upon faithful souls, as upon the inheritance of Your Son. For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, grant them Your blessing and surround them with Your constant protection.

Thus may they never fail in love or lose the treasure of the holy faith, but rather, with all the hosts of Angels and Saints, may they glorify Your boundless mercy for endless ages. Amen.

FOURTH DAY - MONDAY - APRIL 21

Today bring to Me those who do not believe in God and those who do not yet know Me.

Most compassionate Jesus, You are the Light of the whole world. Receive into the abode of Your Most Compassionate Heart the souls of those who do not believe in God and of those who as yet do not know You. Let the rays of Your grace enlighten them that they, too, together with us, may extol Your wonderful mercy; and do not let them escape from the abode which is Your Most Compassionate Heart.

Eternal Father, turn Your merciful gaze upon the souls of those who do not believe in You, and of those who as yet do not know You, but who are enclosed in the Most Compassionate Heart of Jesus. Draw them to the light of the Gospel. These souls do not know what great happiness it is to love You. Grant that they, too, may extol the generosity of Your mercy for endless ages. Amen.

FIFTH DAY - TUESDAY - APRIL 22

Today bring to Me the souls of those who have separated themselves from the Church.

Most Merciful Jesus, Goodness Itself, You do not refuse light to those who seek it of You. Receive into the abode of Your Most Compassionate Heart the souls of those who have separated themselves from Your Church. Draw them by Your light into the unity of the Church, and do not let them escape from the abode of Your Most Compassionate Heart; but bring it about that they, too, come to glorify the generosity of Your mercy.

Eternal Father, turn Your merciful gaze upon the souls of those who have separated themselves from Your Son's Church, who have squandered Your blessings and misused Your graces by obstinately persisting in their errors. Do not look upon their errors, but upon the love of Your own Son and upon His bitter Passion, which He underwent for their sake, since they, too, are enclosed in His Most Compassionate Heart. Bring it about that they also may glorify Your great mercy for endless ages. Amen.

SIXTH DAY - WEDNESDAY - APRIL 23

Today bring to Me the meek and humble souls and the souls of little children, and immerse them in my mercy.

Most Merciful Jesus, You yourself have said, "Learn from Me for I am meek and humble of heart." Receive into the abode of Your Most Compassionate Heart all meek and humble souls and the souls of little children. These souls send all heaven into ecstasy and they are the heavenly Father's favorites. They are a sweet-smelling bouquet before the throne of God; God Himself takes delight in their fragrance. These souls have a permanent abode in Your Most Compassionate Heart, O Jesus, and they unceasingly sing out a hymn of love and mercy.

Eternal Father, turn Your merciful gaze upon meek souls, upon humble souls, and upon little children who are enfolded in the abode which is the Most Compassionate Heart of Jesus. These souls bear the closest resemblance to Your Son. Their fragrance rises from the earth and reaches Your very throne. Father of mercy and of all goodness, I beg You by the love You bear these souls and by the delight You take in them: Bless the whole world, that all souls together may sing out the praises of Your mercy for endless ages. Amen.

SEVENTH DAY - THURSDAY - APRIL 24

Today bring to Me the Souls who especially venerate and glorify My Mercy and immerse them in My mercy.

Most Merciful Jesus, whose Heart is Love Itself, receive into the abode of Your Most Compassionate Heart the souls of those who particularly extol and venerate the greatness of Your mercy. These souls are mighty with the very power of God Himself. In the midst of all afflictions and adversities they go forward, confident of Your mercy; and united to You, O Jesus, they carry all mankind on their shoulders. These souls will not be judged severely, but Your mercy will embrace them as they depart from this life.

Eternal Father, turn Your merciful gaze upon the souls who glorify and venerate Your greatest attribute, that of Your fathomless mercy, and who are enclosed in the Most Compassionate Heart of Jesus. These souls are a living Gospel; their hands are full of deeds of mercy, and their hearts, overflowing with joy, sing a canticle of mercy to You, O Most High! I beg You O God: Show them Your mercy according to the hope and trust they have placed in You. Let there be accomplished in them the promise of Jesus, who said to them that during their life, but especially at the hour of death, the souls who will venerate this fathomless mercy of His, He, Himself, will defend as His glory. Amen.

EIGHTH DAY - FRIDAY - APRIL 25

Today bring to Me the souls who are in the prison of purgatory, and immerse them in the abyss of My mercy.

Most Merciful Jesus, You Yourself have said that You desire mercy; so I bring into the abode of Your Most Compassionate Heart the souls in Purgatory, souls who are very dear to You, and yet, who must make retribution to Your justice. May the streams of Blood and Water which gushed forth from Your Heart put out the flames of Purgatory, that there, too, the power of Your mercy may be celebrated.

Eternal Father, turn Your merciful gaze upon the souls suffering in Purgatory, who are enfolded in the Most Compassionate Heart of Jesus. I beg You, by the sorrowful Passion of Jesus Your Son, and by all the bitterness with which His most sacred Soul was flooded: Manifest Your mercy to the souls who are under Your just scrutiny. Look upon them in no other way but only through the Wounds of Jesus, Your dearly beloved Son; for we firmly believe that there is no limit to Your goodness and compassion. Amen.

NINTH DAY - SATURDAY - APRIL 26

Today bring to Me the souls who have become lukewarm, and immerse them in the abyss of My mercy

Most compassionate Jesus, You are Compassion Itself. I bring lukewarm souls into the abode of Your Most Compassionate Heart. In this fire of Your pure love, let these tepid souls who, like corpses, filled You with such deep loathing, be once again set aflame. O Most Compassionate Jesus, exercise the omnipotence of Your mercy and draw them into the very ardor of Your love, and bestow upon them the gift of holy love, for nothing is beyond Your power.

Eternal Father, turn Your merciful gaze upon lukewarm souls who are nonetheless enfolded in the Most Compassionate Heart of Jesus. Father of Mercy, I beg You by the bitter Passion of Your Son and by His three-hour agony on the Cross: Let them, too, glorify the abyss of Your mercy. Amen.

On the large bead after each decade:

Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

On the 10 small beads of each decade:

For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

Conclude with:

Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, Have mercy on us and on the whole world. *(Three times)*

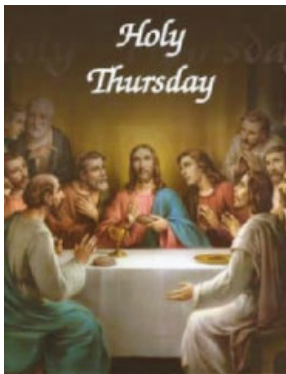

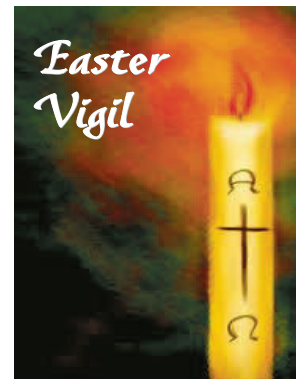

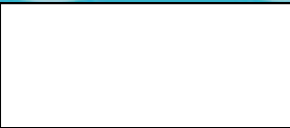
