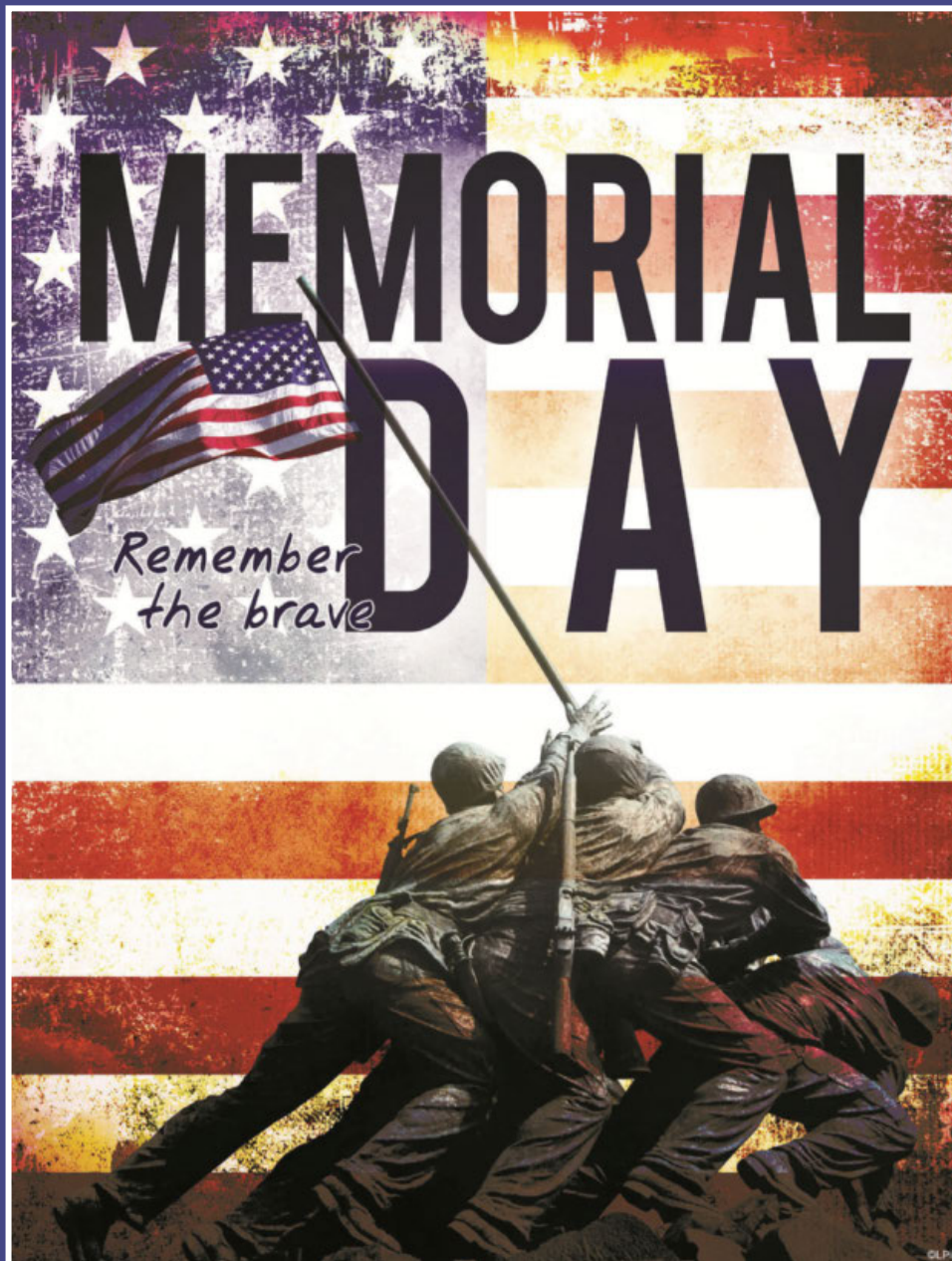

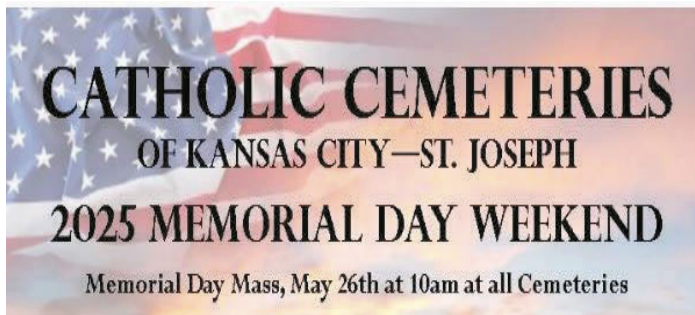
Blood Drive ~ May 27

Meditating Moments



Some days I feel like running away to some secluded spot where there is no internet, cell phone coverage, television, radio, or print news coverage. I am exhausted from all the social media banter and

my mind is overwhelmed with trying to discern fact from fiction, truth from lies. As a society it appears that we find comfort in hearing/reading words that agree and support our preconceived ideas.

As a person steeped in Christian faith and investigative science, there are times when it is easier to find refuge in the past, or at least how I remember the good things of my past. I am reminded, however, that even my memories are somewhat distorted, trying to forget what is hard/too painful to remember (illness, grief, disappointments, struggles, unfilled dreams, bad choices, betrayal, and lost relationships). Yet, I know my life is a giant mosaic of good and bad, sin and forgiveness, loss and discovery, truth and lies. The question becomes, what directs my discernment and decisions? What voices do I listen to? How do I live my life in fidelity to the "Golden thread" which winds through years of experiences, successes, failures, disappointments, wonder, discovery, and joy? Although the answer seems to be straightforward, the path is twisted and turning, uphill and down. There is no time to cling to my inner voices of grandiosity, ego, self-interest, and laziness. I must leave wounds and rage behind. My emotions must be filtered by constraint. I cannot mistake sentimentality and piety for genuine empathy and devotion. As one little boy told me many years ago: "listen to the angel on your shoulder and not the devil on the other shoulder, who gets you into trouble." a very wise seven year old. All too often I listen to my obsession for having the correct answer, to which others just need to listen and pay attention. Moving forward, I desire to listen and surrender to the voice of Jesus; letting go of those voices which support my ego, prejudices, and desires. In striving to live faithful to the gospel, I realize that listening to other voices is important, but of primary importance is following God's voice. Mindful awareness is important for discernment and decision making, however, I believe that eternal truths are found in listening to the voice of the Holy Spirit that resides quietly but powerfully in my heart. Only God's voice is life giving. Eternal truths are God given, not generated by human ego and self interest. I must "Be still and know, listen to God's voice."

ST. JAMES PASTORAL COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES MONDAY, MAY 12, 2025

The Pastoral Council April meeting was called to order at 7:03pm. by Chairperson Joan Peluso. Council Members present were Fr. Mike Roach, Eddie Baker, Phil Baumert, Kevin Casel, Yvette Lopez, Joan Peluso, Sherri Porterfield, Jeff Ridder and Corrine Sebranek. To begin the meeting Kevin Casel shared a spiritual reading written by Pope Francis with the group.

Old Business:

Chairperson Joan Peluso shared with the Council that currently only one person has been discerned as a new member of next year's Council. There are still two more new members that need to be discerned to replace outgoing current members and to serve for the next four years. She also shared that Jay Meacham will not be able to lead the Council's upcoming August retreat this year as he has another commitment. No decisions were made concerning ideas for a new retreat leader. It was decided to wait until our new pastor arrives to discuss future retreat plans.

The Council discussed information received from various ministry leaders that will be placed in the bulletin throughout the summer months. Plans for a Fall Ministry Fair were not discussed.

New Business:

Fr. Mike told the Council about our new pastor, Fr. Lac Phan. Fr. Lac is currently serving at St. Francis Xavier in St. Joseph. He is a priest with the Precious Blood order and will arrive to become the pastor of St. James on July 1st.

The Council held elections for Chairperson, Vice-Chairperson and Secretary who comprise the Executive Committee.

Current Chairperson Peluso shared from the Council By-laws how the election should be completed and the personal qualities that these leaders should exemplify in being considered for office. The following members were elected for the 2025-26 year: Chairperson, Eddie Baker; Vice-Chairperson, Joan Peluso; and Secretary, Kevin Casel.

Sherri Porterfield introduced our new Director of Liturgy and Music, Sam Fleming. Sam told the Council a little about himself and the Council members introduced themselves and told Sam about their involvement in the parish. Sam has extensive experience as a church music director and is currently finishing his doctoral degree in music at the University of Kansas. He is married and has three sons. He expressed his excitement to be here at St. James.

The Council welcomed Sam, thanked him for accepting this important job and expressed how blessed we were to have him here.

Closing:

Fr. Mike led the Council in prayer and the Council prayed the "Our Father" together. The meeting concluded at 7:57pm.

The Council will be on summer break and will begin meeting again on Monday, August 11th. Parishioners are always welcome at the meetings. Beginning in August, please contact new Chairperson Eddie Baker or Fr. Lac if you would like to attend.
